

The Judgment (Bema) Seat


- 2 Cor 5:10 For we must all appear before the *judgment seat* of Christ; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* body, according to that he hath done, whether *it be* good or bad.

What is the Bema Seat ?



The concept of the Bema Seat comes from the ancient Olympics, where a judge would sit on the Bema Seat at the finish line. The judge's purpose was to determine what position the runners came in-first, second, and so on-and then to give out the appropriate rewards. That is the imagery behind what is known as the Bema Seat.

The Bema Seat



- The Bema Seat judgment does not determine salvation. Rather, it is when believers must give an account of their lives to Christ. the Bema Seat is for believers whose salvation has already been **secured by faith in Jesus Christ**
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.


What the Bema Seat is not !



We should not focus on the Bema Seat as Christ judging our sins, but rather as God rewarding us according to our lives. Yes, we will surely have to give an account of our lives.

1 Corinthians 11:31 For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.

The Bema Seat




Romans 14:10-12 explains, "You, then, why do you judge your brother? Or why do you look down on your brother? For **we will all stand** before God's judgment seat(Bema Seat). It is written: "'As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will confess to God.'" So then, each of us will give an account of himself to God."

The Parable of the Talents



Matthew 29:14 ¶ For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.

17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.

18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

Your Christian Work





8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments

ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. 10 More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

11 Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is *great reward*.

1; To eat of the tree of Life



2; Free of the second death !




But by the grace of God I am what I am,

The Rewards:

3; Stone with a new Name !




- Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

The Rewards:

4; The morning Star, and Authority !



- Revelation 2:26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:
- 27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
- 28 And I will give him the morning star.

The Rewards:

5; Devine Identification !



Revelation 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

6; A new Name Given !

down from heaven



7; A Throne Given !



- Revelation 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

The Crowns: Diadems

1; The incorruptible crown



- 1 Corinthians 9:25 And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but **we an incorruptible.**

The Crowns: Diadems

2; The Crown of Life



- Revelation 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

The Crowns: Diadems

3; The Crown of Glory



- 1 Peter 5:2 Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;
- 3 Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock.
- 4 And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, **ye shall receive a crown of glory** that fadeth not away.

4; The Crown of Righteousness



- 2 Timothy 4:8

5; The Crown of Rejoicing

For Joyful Christians


The Throne Of Grace

The Law


- Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the **knowledge of sin.**




The Law

- Romans 5:18

Under Grace



- Romans 5::20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, **grace did much more abound:**
- 21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might **grace reign** through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.
