Daniel 10:14 Now *I am come to make thee understand* what shall befall thy people in the latter days: for yet the vision is for many days.


The Great Tribulation

The Prophecy


The Prophet Jeremiah






The Timing of the Judgment






To make an end to sin

- Chatta'ah = "Sin offering"

The Rebellion has not occurred...Yet







The 360 day year!



- Genesis 7:11 ¶In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, *in the second month*, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.
- Genesis 8:3 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the *hundred and fifty days* the waters were abated.
- 4 ¶And the ark rested in the *seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month,* upon the mountains of Ararat.

The 360 day year!

Ancient China

The ancient Chinese had a 360-day year.¹²⁻¹⁴ They also changed this to a $365\frac{1}{4}$ -day year, calling the additional days *Khe-ying*.

Velikovsky¹ goes on to discuss the calendar reforms made at "the end of the eighth or the beginning of the seventh century B. C.". For example, Diogenes Laertius wrote in "Life of Thales," "He was the first to determine the Sun's course from solstice to solstice...He is said to have discovered the seasons of the year and to have divided it into 365 days...the first to predict eclipses of the Sun and to fix the solstices."¹⁵ It is odd that this seventh century B. C. sage would be the first to fix the seasons. Why wouldn't it have been done earlier?

Our investigation has established that the records of these ancient civilizations record the occurrence of a 360-day year consisting of 12 months with 30 days per month. There is no evidence that they interpolated days anywhere in these various periods. Further, there is no evidence in the Bible anywhere that hours or days were to be inserted to make the month agree with the year. The addition of days was clearly a later (seventh century) change where 5 or 5¼ days were added to the calendar. Investigators acknowledge that sometime in the seventh or eighth century B. C. the old 360-day year calendar was modified.²³ Indeed, the scientific writings of these ancient civilizations describe detailed astronomical observations and detailed religious and civil activities based around a 360-day year. Why would they record such obviously different information on these ancient skies unless they were truly different than those we observe in times after the seventh century B. C.? Why would *all* of these civilizations–in some cases separated by many thousands of miles–record the exact same error?

Ancient Egyptian Astronomy - 360 Day Year / 30 Day Month



365.2421897 days = 1 Tropical Year **29.5305891** days = 1 Synodic Month In ancient Egyptian astronomy we find complex mythological stories indicating that once in a distant era the Earth possessed an ideal 360 day year. And that also the Moon possessed an exacting 30 day Synodic month. Such cosmic harmony though was however broken at some point, leading to a great reconfiguration.

As a result, the orbital periods of both celestial bodies were transformed to their present values (left). Now concerning the Earth year in particular the ancient Egyptians had developed a mythological tale to account for an increase of five extra days: each new day being the birth of a new god (Osiris, Isis, Seth, Nephthys, Horus the Elder). Myth aside however, in terms of strict astronomical observations the ancient Egyptians were not so simple as to miss the fact, that the Earth year was closer to 365.25 days than 365 days.


The Decrees! Cyrus The Great!






The first part fulfilled!.



- 69 sevens is 483 years (69 x 7= 483 years).
- The Jewish (and Babylonian) calendars used a 360-day year; 69 weeks of 360-day years totals 173,880 days.

The 1st commandment to restore and build Jerusalem was given by Artaxerxes Longimanus on March 14, 445 b.c






- Here are the calculations.
- March 14th, 445 B.C. to March 14th, 32 A.D. is 476 years.
- (1 B.C. to 1 A.D. is one year, There is no year zero)
- 476 years x 365 days per year = 173,740 days
- Add for leap years = 116 days (Leap years do not occur in century years unless divisible by 400 [therefore, we must add three less leap years in four centuries])
- March 14th to April 6th = 24 days
- total = 173,880

Other evidence



- Tiberius Caesar succeeded to ruler of the empire after the death of Caesar Augustus on August 19th 14 AD
