- Moral choices can only be made if the choice is based on a knowledge of good and evil
- i.e. the ability to apply a value to the “goodness” of one decision over another
- A choice only exists when we are free to act or free to refrain from acting

We cannot change the past !



- This means we cannot make the “moral” choice to save the titanic from sinking

Adams Choice




- Genesis 2:19


- 2 Chronicles 1:

- 10 **Give me now wisdom and knowledge**, that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can judge this thy people, that is so great?

Gods answer to a good choice



- 11 And God said to Solomon, Because this was in thine heart, and thou hast not asked riches, wealth, or honour, nor the life of thine enemies, neither yet hast asked long life; but hast asked wisdom and knowledge for thyself, that thou mayest judge my people, over whom I have made thee king:
- 12 Wisdom and knowledge is granted unto thee; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honour, such as none of the kings have had that have been before thee, neither shall there any after thee have the like.



Are you leading or following ?




- The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Following , Not Leading




