## The Bride Of Christ Getting Ready Part 1




Revelation 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

## **Lesson Principles**




- The Wedding is arranged

- The bride must get dressed.

## The Marriage



- Matthew 22:2 The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son,
- Revelation 19:9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

## The Three C's



#### • Covenant: Ketubbah

 The Groom chooses a bride and negotiates a bride price. If the father and the bride agree

#### Consumation: Chuppah

- After payment of the bride price, and time to prepare the new living place. The Groom comes to consumate the marriage, and then takes the bride away
- Celebration: "Gamos" (greek)
  - The wedding feast is held at the grooms house

Marriage to the Jews of Jesus's day was a practical legal matter, established by contract and carried through by exacting procedure. The young man would come to the chosen girl's house with a covenant (a true legal agreement) giving the terms by which he would propose marriage. The most important being the price he was willing to pay for this bride.

i. The bride would chose her husband and her father would sign a legal covenant with him called a "ketubbah".

ii. Once this is signed the couple is 100% married but have not been intimate yet.

iii. Young children were often married, (arranged marriage) but did not consummate until of age.

### The "Daughter of Zion"



- Jeremiah 6:2 I have likened the daughter of Zion to a comely and delicate woman.
- Isaiah 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

#### The Betrothal(Engagement)



Zechariah 9:9 **[Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion**; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he **is just, and having salvation**; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Hosea 2:19 And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

#### The Betrothal: The Unamed Servant



 Genesis 24:3 And I will make thee swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that thou shalt not take a wife unto my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:

• 4 But thou shalt go unto my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife unto my son Isaac.

Genesis 15:2 ¶And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house is this Eliezer of Damascus?

#### The Helper who fetches the bride




Genesis 24:1 ¶And Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.


20 And Jacob served seven years for Rachel; and they seemed unto him but a few days, for the love he had to

## **Getting Ready!**



Luke 12:35 Be Ready for the Lord's Coming "Be dressed for service and keep your lamps burning,

36 as though you were waiting for your master to return from the wedding feast. Then you will be ready to open the door and let him in the moment he arrives and knocks.

37 The servants who are ready and waiting for his return will be rewarded. I tell you the truth, he himself will seat them, put on an apron, and serve them as they sit and eat!

38 He may come in the middle of the night or just before dawn, in the second or third watch. But whenever he comes, he will reward the servants who are ready.
