Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Prayer: (Greek) Proseuchomai



- Matthew 14:23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, **he was there alone.**

Hebrews 9:7 But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people:

Pray: (Greek) Erotao “ask”, “desire”



Matthew 3:15 And Jesus answering said unto him, **Suffer it to be so now:** for thus it becometh us **to fulfil all righteousness.** Then he suffered him.

- John 16:26 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:
- 27 For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.

Building a relationship



- Luke 10:39 And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.
- John 11:1 ¶Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.
- 2 (It was that Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.)

Why should we pray?

 - Part of prayer is returning that sovereignty so that he can act on our behalf



Returning the dominion

- Genesis 1:26 ¶And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion.....
- Luke 22:42 Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: **nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.**

Receiving from God

Isaiah 30:21 - And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This [is] the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

- Jeremiah 33:3 - **Call unto me, and I will answer** thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.
- John 16:13 - Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, **he will guide you into all truth:** for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, [that] shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

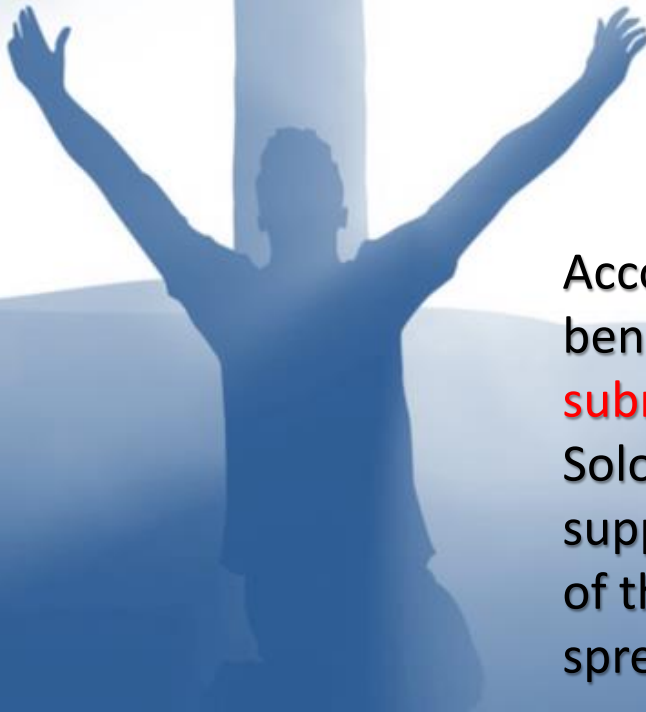
Types of Prayer

- *Supplication*
- *A prayer of “Intreaty and Humbling”*

1 Timothy 2:1 ¶I exhort therefore, that, first of all, *supplications*, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by *prayer and supplication* with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

According to the word history of supplication, it refers to a bending down and indicates *a bowing or kneeling in submission*. 1 Kings 8:34 states, "And it was so, that when Solomon had made an end of praying all this prayer and supplication unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD, *from kneeling on his knees* with his hands spread up to heaven

Romans 8:26 ¶ Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: *but the Spirit itself maketh intercession* for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

1 Corinthians 14:14 For if I pray in an unknown tongue, *my spirit prayeth*, but my understanding is unfruitful.

Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator (*Intercessor*) between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

True intercessory prayer, is only accomplished when praying in the Spirit. Because it's the Spirit that is the intercessor

Colossians 4:2 ¶ Continue in prayer, and watch in the same *with thanksgiving*;

1 Thessalonians 5:18 *In every thing give thanks*: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Ephesians 5:20 *Giving thanks always for all things* unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

Matthew 20:20 ¶ Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, *worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him.*

John 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the *true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth*: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

24 God is a Spirit: and *they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.*

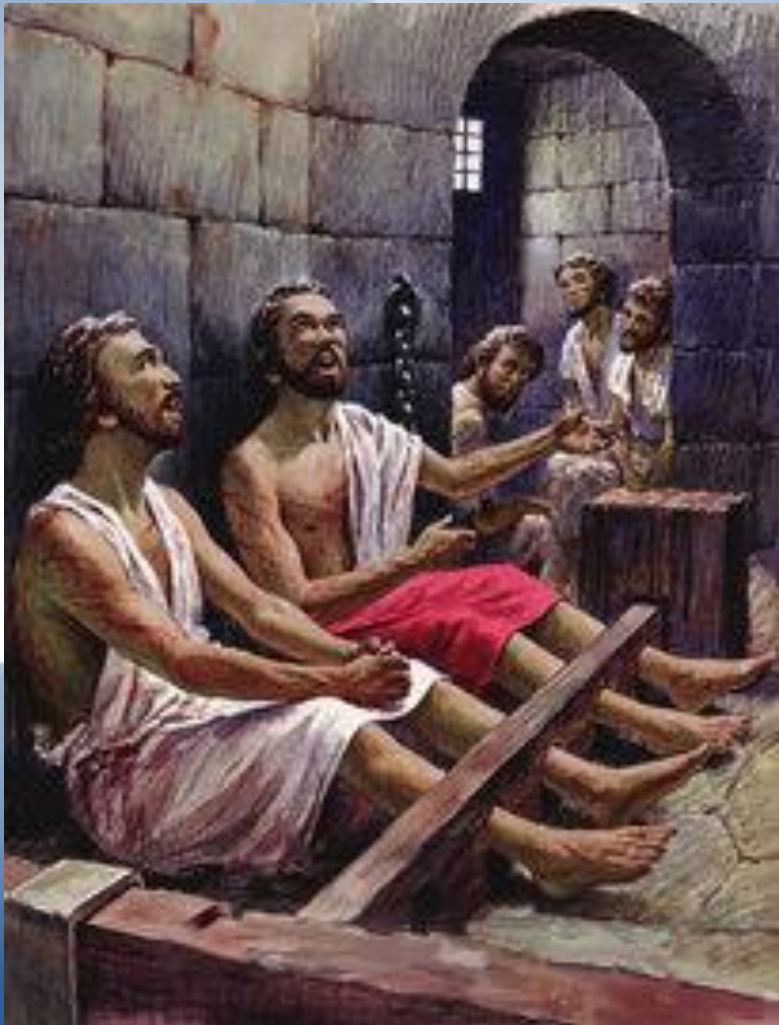

Acts 16:25 ¶ And at midnight Paul **and** Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.
