A New Creation: Part 1: Born Again



John 1:13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.



The Old Man



Jeremiah 17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?

- Ephesians 4:22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
- 1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the **lust of the flesh**, and the **lust of the eyes**, and the **pride of life**, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

The Old Man



- Lust of the eyes
 - Looks good ?
 - Genesis 3:6 ¶ And when **the woman saw** that the tree was good for food,
- Lust of the flesh
 - Feels good ?
 - “**the tree was good** for food”,
- Pride of life
 - Is good ?
 - and a tree **to be desired to make one wise**

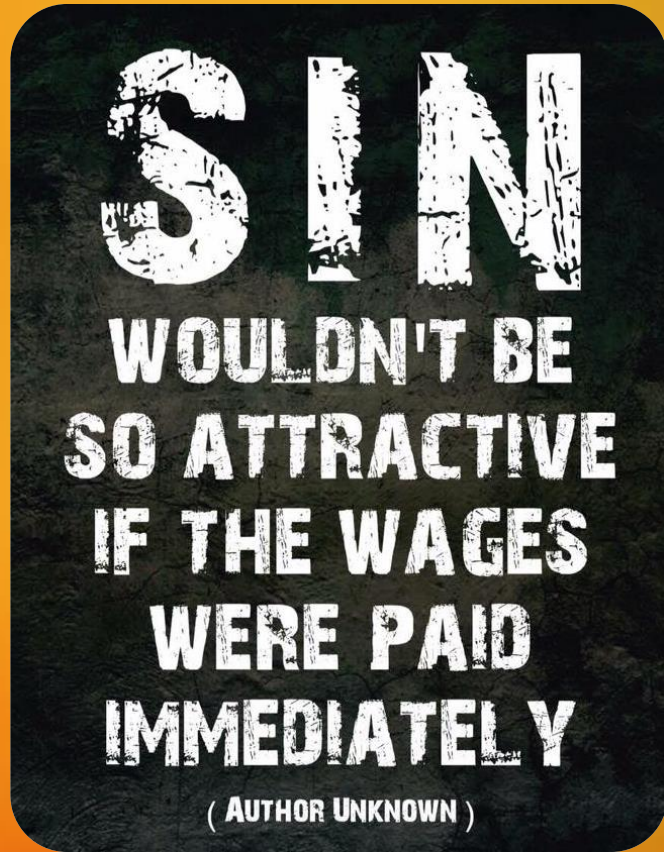
The Old Nature



Sense Knowledge(Tree Knowledge) to the flesh
Leads to Independent Judgment by the soul
-> Pride !

- James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
- 13 ¶Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:
- 14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away **of his own lust, and enticed.**
- 15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

The old nature leads to death! Of the body and soul!



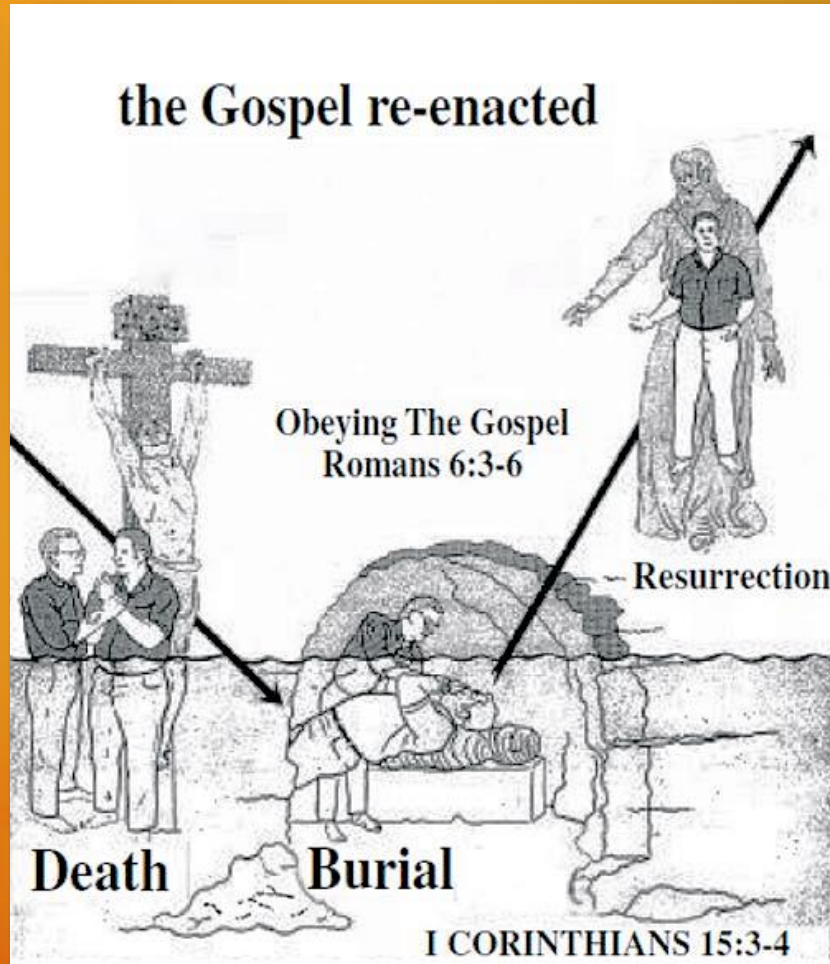
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die:
- Romans 7:24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

The Body MUST die!



- Romans 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- Romans 6:4 **Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death:** that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Baptism (Immersion) is the symbolic Death and burial of the “Old Man”



- Colossians 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.
 - 12 Having been put to death with him in baptism, by which you came to life again with him, through faith in the working of God, who made him come back from the dead.

Body and Soul



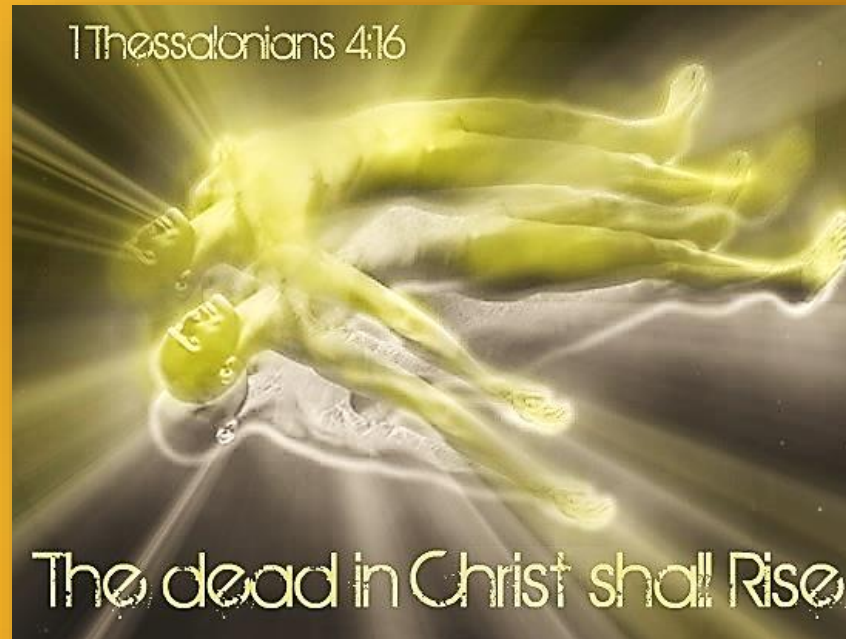
- Leviticus 16:21 And Aaron shall lay² both his hands upon the head of the live **goat (THE BODY/ FLESH)**, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and **shall send him away** by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness:

Crucify your “old man”



- Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

- Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.



But the Spirit CANNOT quicken
(make alive) the new man if the old
man is not dead

The Seed has to be planted! In order

1 Corinthians 15:29 Else what shall they do which are
baptized for the dead (*for their own death*), if the dead
rise not at all? why are they then baptized for the
dead?

THIS IS THE SALVATION REASON FOR BAPTISM!

Romans 6: 3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were
baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?

4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death:
that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory
of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

The Seed will not quicken, unless its planted! (DIES)

- 1 Corinthians 15:35 ¶ But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?
- **36 Thou fool, that which thou sowest is NOT QUICKENED, except it die: (planted by baptism in CHRIST)**
- 37 And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain:
- 38 But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

“Walking in Newness”



- Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should **walk in newness of life.**

Old things are passed away

*Just when the caterpillar thought its

- 2 Corinthians 5:17
Therefore if any man be
in Christ, **he is a new
creature**: old things are
passed away; behold, all
things are become new.

Born again



- John 3:1 ¶ There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:
- 2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.
- 3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.**
- 4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?
- 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.**
