

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.


The Man when first Created had No expiration date!

 - A Spirit





God not only changed the spoken language but he changed the DNA Language


A new expiration date!

 Romans 8:20 For the creature was made subject to vanity(decay); not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,

Psalms 8:5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.

- The psalm referred to the first "Adam"
- But because of the "confounding of the language", At this present time, it now only applied to Jesus Christ ... The second Adam / son of God.
- The truth is ...we, when born (sons of men) and are no longer just a "little lower" anymore.....

Review; The Fall of Mankind!




Progressively lower still!

- "In the day thou eatest of thou shalt surely die "


- Then we became subject to the bondage of decay and shortening of even the Fleshly life
- "yet his days shall be 120 years"

Why made Lower?



- Hebrews 2:8 Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him.
- 9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

Redemption of the body





Prefigured by Moses



- Exodus 34:27 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write thou these words:..... 28 ¶And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.
- 29 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.

Made lower for the purpose of Dying!



Numbers 27:12 ¶And the LORD said unto Moses, Get thee up into this mount Abarim, and see the land which I have given unto the children of Israel.

13 And when thou hast seen it, thou also shalt be gathered unto thy people, as Aaron thy brother was gathered.



1 Corinthians 15: 42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption: 43 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it

is raised in power:

44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

The full explanation



Romans 8:18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

20 For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,

21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

22 For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now.

The New Creation: Redemption of the Body

Romans 8:23 And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.



Created Not In Vain!

• Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.

The Redemption of the Sons



• 1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
