Corrie Ten Boom

Corrie Ten Boom with her two sisters and father were sent to the Nazi concentration camp, Ravensbruck. During this time she would hold secret Bible services for other prisoners. Later, Corrie was released on a clerical error when all women of her age group were sentenced to death, including her sister Betsie. Corrie eventually met one of the guards during a sermon and forgave him for his transgressions.



- [Rosa Parks](#) (1913 – 2005)

Rosa Louise McCauley was born in Tuskegee, Alabama, on February 4, 1913. Her ancestors included both Irish-Scottish lineage and also a great grandmother who was a slave. She attended local rural schools and after the age of 11 the Industrial School for Girls in Montgomery. However, she later had to opt out of school to look after her grandmother.



[Helen Keller](#) (1880-1968) Helen Keller An amazing women, who was born 27 June 1880 in Tusculum, Alabama. When she was only 19 months old, she experienced a severe childhood illness, which left her deaf and blind (only a very partial sight). For the first few years of her life. In her frustration to relate to her surroundings and those around her, she bit, kicked pinched and knocked out the front teeth of her extremely patient teacher. Despite this debilitating disability, she learned to read and write, and became the first deaf blind person to gain a bachelor degree. She campaigned on issues of social welfare, women's suffrage, disability rights and impressed many with her force of personality.

- 2 Corinthians 5:17
- Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Lamentations 3:22-23
- It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.

- **NOT CONDEMNED Romans 8:1** There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- **NOT DEBTORS 12** Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.
- **Romans 13:8** Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
- **NOT GUILTY- Colossians 2:14** Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross.

- Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath **MADE** us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

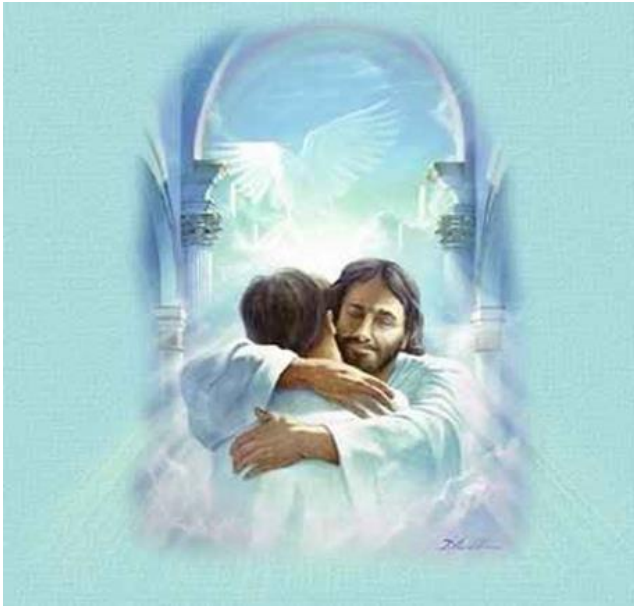
VICTORIOUS! — Romans 8:37
