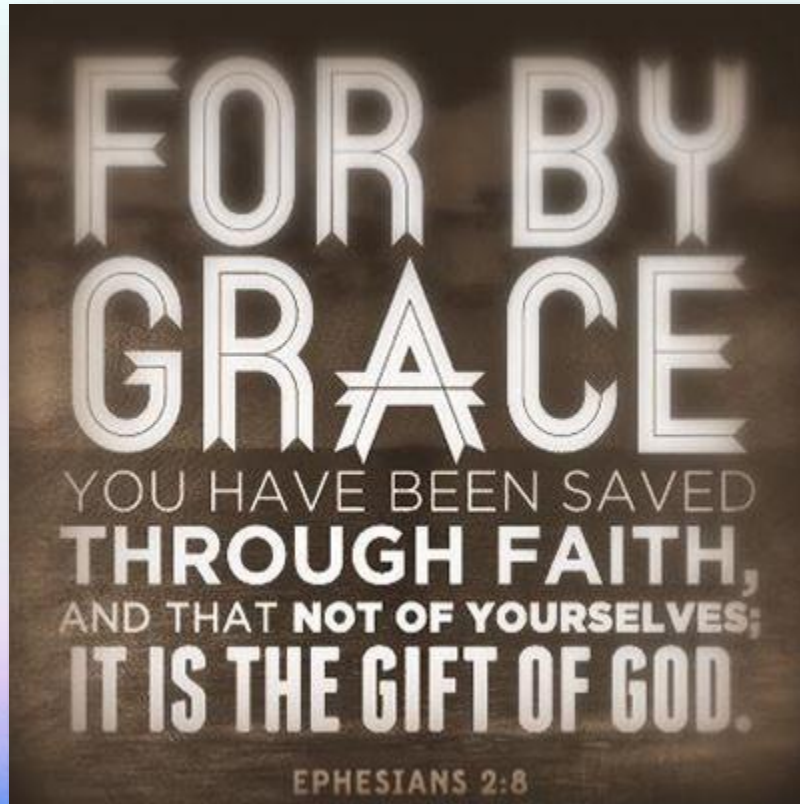

Finding Grace: Gods Favor



Two Steps

Finding Grace: Step 1: Gods Favor

Grace:

(Noun):

1. The exercise of love, kindness or goodwill; disposition to benefit or serve another
2. The divine favor towards man; the underserving kindness or forgiveness of God; divine love or pardon
3. Beauty, physical, intellectual or moral; easy elegance of manners

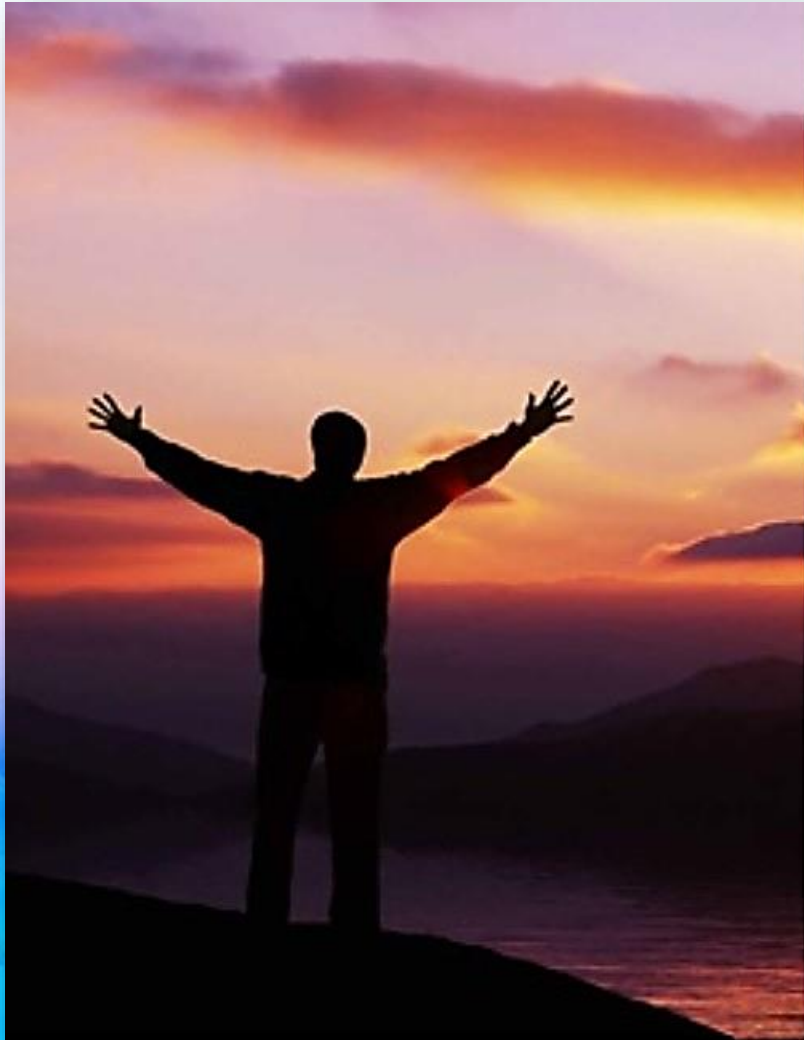

Genesis 6:8 ¶But Noah **found grace** in the eyes of the LORD.

Exodus 33:17 And the LORD said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that thou hast spoken: for thou hast **found grace** in my sight, and I know thee by name.

Ruth 2:10 Then she fell on her face, and bowed herself to the ground, and said unto him, Why have I **found grace** in thine eyes, that thou shouldest take knowledge of me, seeing I am a stranger?

How do we “find grace”



Jeremiah 29:13 And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with **all your heart.**

14 And **I will be found** of you, saith the LORD: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places

The opposite of Grace: Judgment

- IN HEAVEN'S EYES -

Deuteronomy 31:17 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and **I will hide my face from them**, ...

Leviticus 26:17 And **I will set my face against you**, and ye shall be slain before your enemies: they that hate you shall reign over you; and ye shall flee when none pursueth you.

Leviticus 20:3 And **I will set my face against that man**, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile my sanctuary, and to profane my holy name.

Deuteronomy 31:18 And **I will surely hide my face** in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

Finding Grace: Step 2: Gods Face



Psalms 5:5 The foolish shall not stand **in thy sight**: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.

Psalms 27:8 When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, **Thy face**, LORD, will I seek.

Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable **in thy sight**, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

Proverbs 3:4 So shalt thou find favour and good **understanding in the sight of God** and man.

2 Chronicles 7:14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, **and seek my face**, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Finding Grace: Step 3: A pure heart



Psalm 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

- Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart: **for they shall see God.**
- Job 33:26 He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and **he shall see his face** with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.
- Revelation 22:4 And they **shall see his face**; and his name shall be in their foreheads.

Finding Grace: Step 4: Humility



Luke 18:10 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

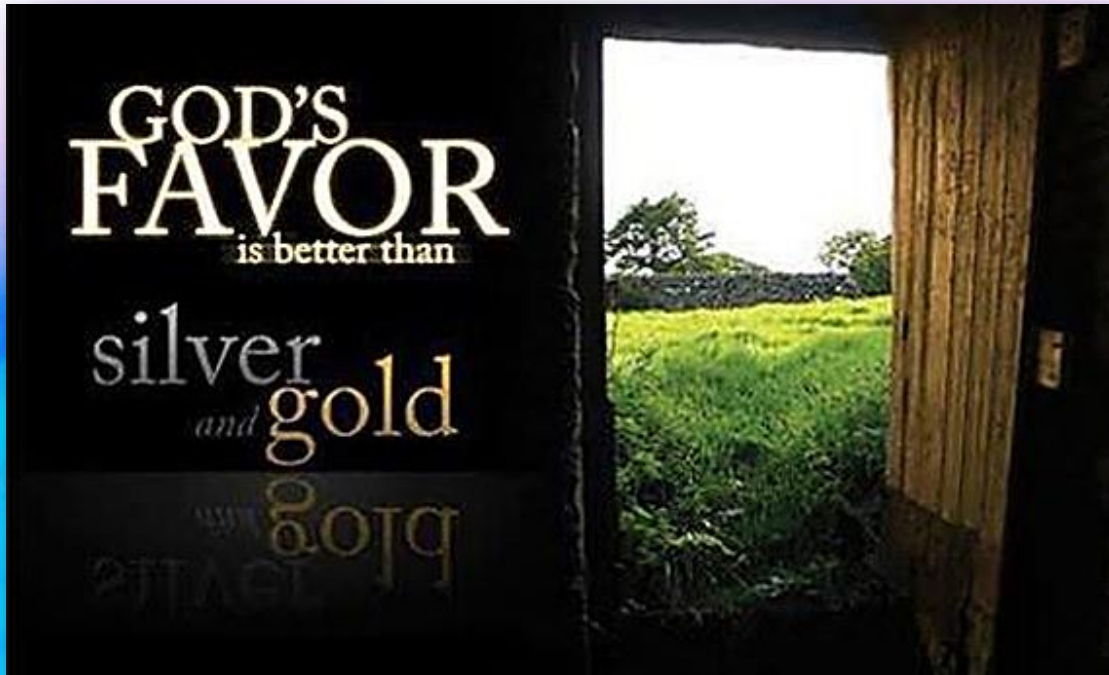
13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

James 4:6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

Finding Grace: Step 5: Knowledge of Him

2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,³ According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:



Knowing him leads to → Receiving Grace

Philippians 3:10 That **I may know him**, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

11 If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

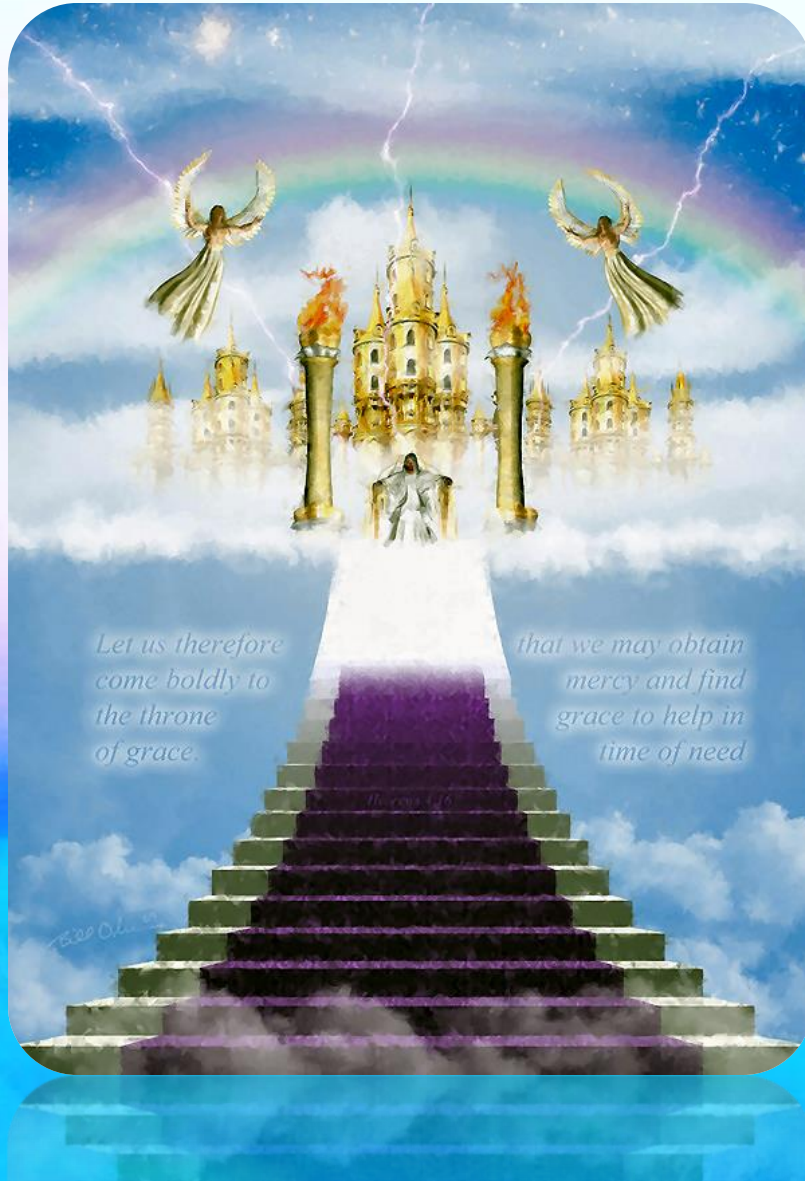
Finding Grace ...leads us on to perfection!
