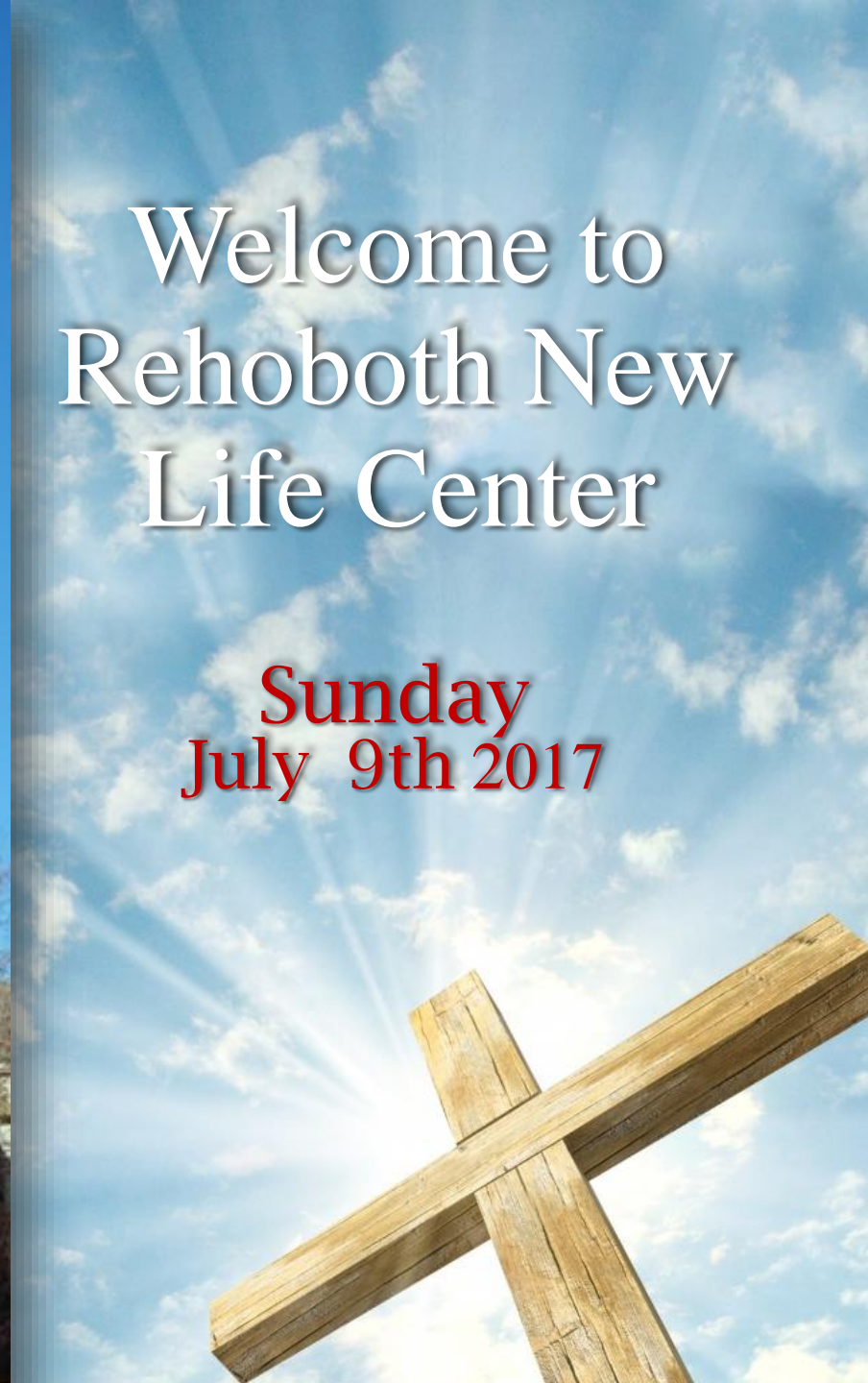

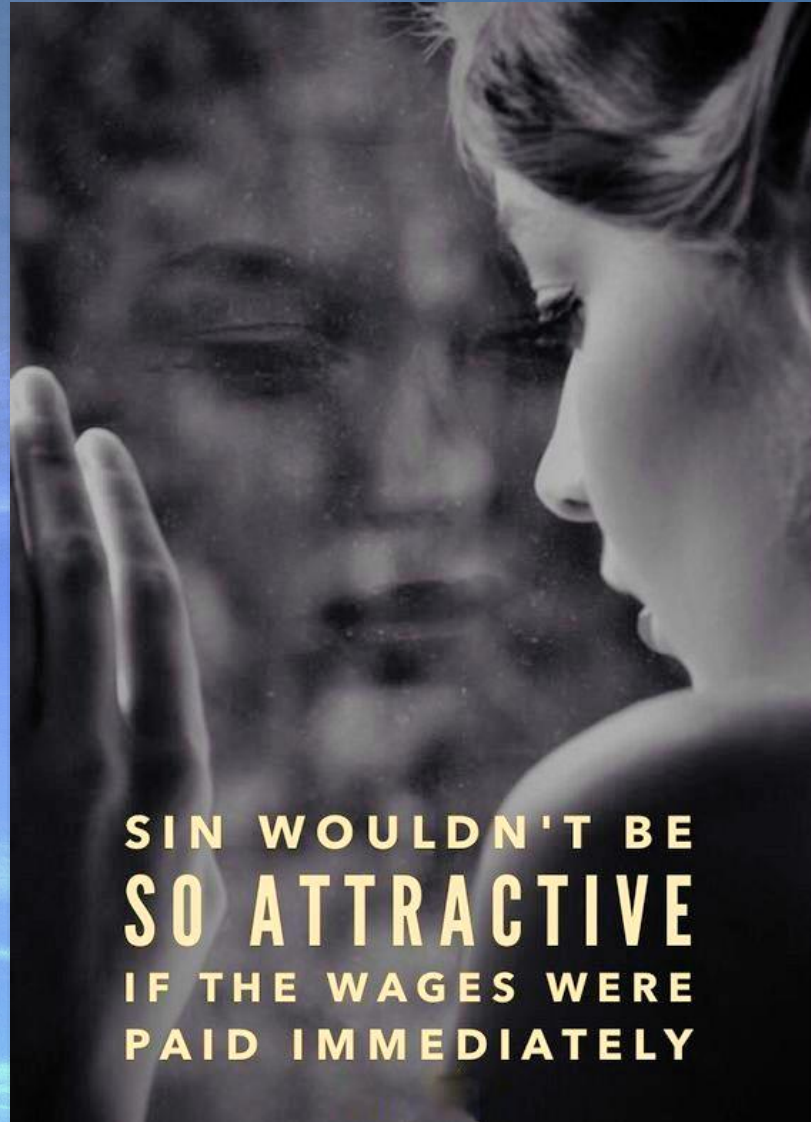

The Problem is Sin

Created In Gods Image



- Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, **in the image of God created he him**; male and female created he them.
- John 4:24 **God is a Spirit:** and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

God Created us in his image .. **The Spirit of man,** Namely **His SOUL !**

The Spiritual model Gods spirit Is our covering!

Isaiah 30:1 ¶Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; **and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit**, that they may add sin to sin:

Luke 3:38 Which was the son of Enos, which was the son of Seth, which was the son of Adam, **which was the son of God.**

Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. **Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.**



Created, Formed, Made...and



- **Created** “Bara” A Soul Being
- **Formed** “Yatsar” a Flesh Body
- **Made** “Asah” “a living soul(Fleshly being)” by the covering of the soul in the body by Gods spirit...A son of God

Deuteronomy 33:12....The beloved of the LORD shall dwell in safety by him; **and the LORD shall cover him** all the day long, and he shall dwell between his shoulders.

What was the covering ?



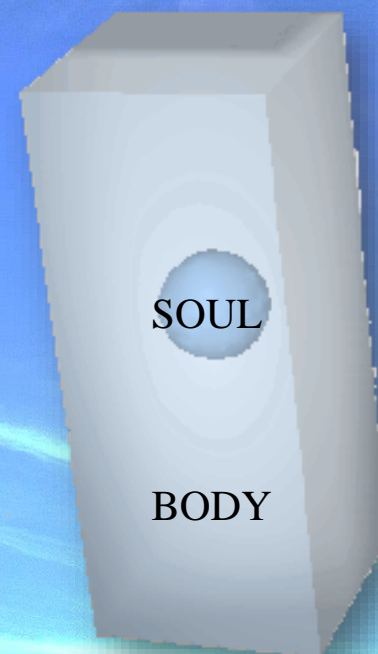
- Isaiah 30:1 ¶ Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, **but not of my spirit**, that they may add sin to sin:
- The covering was the spirit of God: the **“Shekinah Glory”**
- 1 Corinthians 6:17 But he that is joined unto the Lord **is one spirit.**

Adam & Eve Lose their covering :Death of the Spirit A Naked Soul

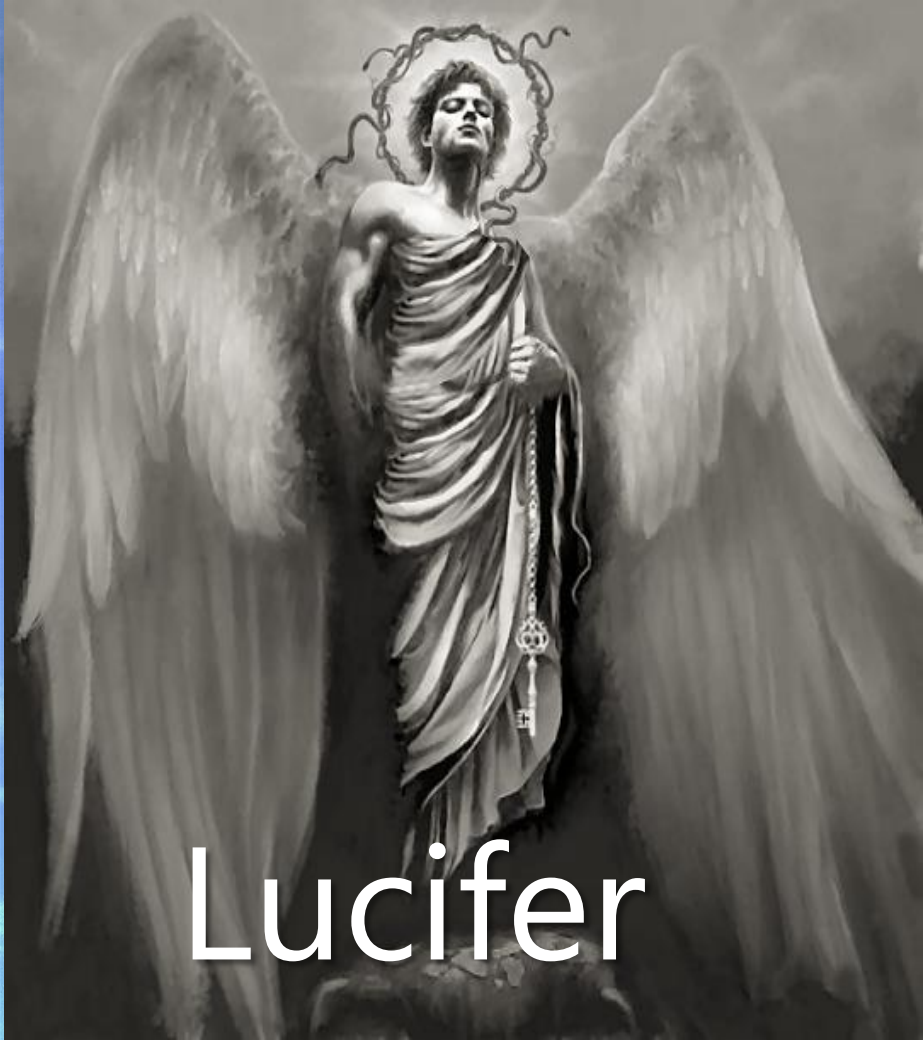


- Genesis 3:9 ¶And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?
- 10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, **because I was naked; and I hid myself.**
- 11 ¶And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

Death of the Spirit Covering



“Thou shalt worship the Lord thy

Lucifer

Romans 6:16 Know ye not,
that to whom **ye yield
yourselves servants to obey,
his servants ye are** to whom
ye obey; whether of sin
unto death, or of obedience
unto righteousness?

The body belongs to Satan!

He now wants your Soul!



- Of his original threefold nature that he had been created with, **Only the soul remained his!**
- Romans 7:22 For I delight in the law of God **after the inward man:**
- Ephesians 3:16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by **his Spirit in the inner man;**

- While the body still lived, it could stay there. Once the body died it could not stay in the physical realm, it had to go to the place of the grave.

The Body belongs to Satan...so must die

Romans 7:14 ¶For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I.

16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that it is good.

17 Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

19 For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.

20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

The Body Must Die



Genesis 3:22 ¶ And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, **lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:**

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

13 **For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.**

The reason for death



- Romans 8:20 **For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly,** but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,
- 21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
- 22 For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now.
- 23 And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, **waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.**

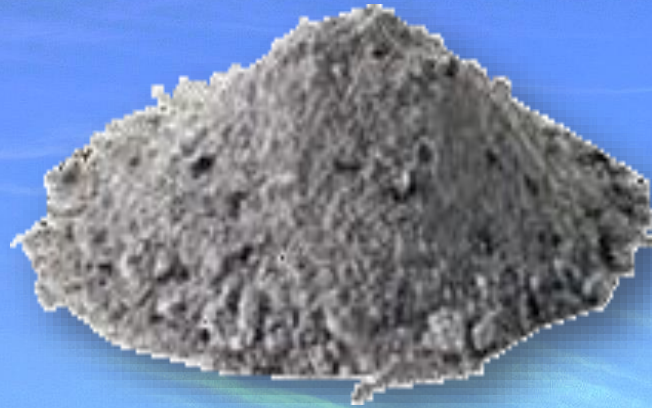
What the snake wanted

Genesis 3:14 ¶And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and **dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:**

Man cannot save himself



Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and **they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.**

The Laws of Perfection

- The Physical.....Orders Matter
- The BiologicalOrders Physical Life
- The Spiritual.....Orders Sentient Life

Psalms 19:7 The law of the LORD is perfect,
converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is
sure, making wise the simple.

We needed a Savior

- Man was going to now die
- The grave had become mans destiny
- Because the Laws God had created were there to keep things perfect.
- They removed imperfection from Gods Universe.

Why did God have to become man

Why could he not just make another spirit covering
?



- Genesis 2:1 ¶Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.
- 2 And on the seventh day **God ended his work which he had made;** and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.
- 3 And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it **he had rested from all his work which God created and made.**

“But God so loved the world”

- Another covering
 - Why could not God have immediately **created** another **spiritual** covering?
 - 1. Because he had given that power(sovereignty) of reproduction to “ADAM” son of God.
 - 2. He had “ceased” from “new” creative work

Why Salvation through Jesus Alone?



- 1 Peter 1:9 Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.
- “I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: **for if ye believe not that I am he**, ye shall die in your sins.”

John 6:69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

No other way



- John 11:42 And I knew that thou hearest me always:
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Matthew 26:39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, **if it be possible, let this cup pass from me:** nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

Because only Jesus/God had the true permanent covering !



- Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

John 16:7 ¶Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

To send the spirit covering



- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, **I will send him unto you.**
- Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, **into thy hands I commend my spirit:** and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

Why did God have to become man?

- 1. To reveal Gods true character and nature.
- 2. To enable the restoration of a spirit covering
- 3. To create new sons of God.
- 4. To restore dominion to the sons of God.
- 6. To be the perfect mediator until the redemption of the body.
- 7. To destroy the works of the devil.

Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, am the **LORD**; and **beside me there is no saviour.**

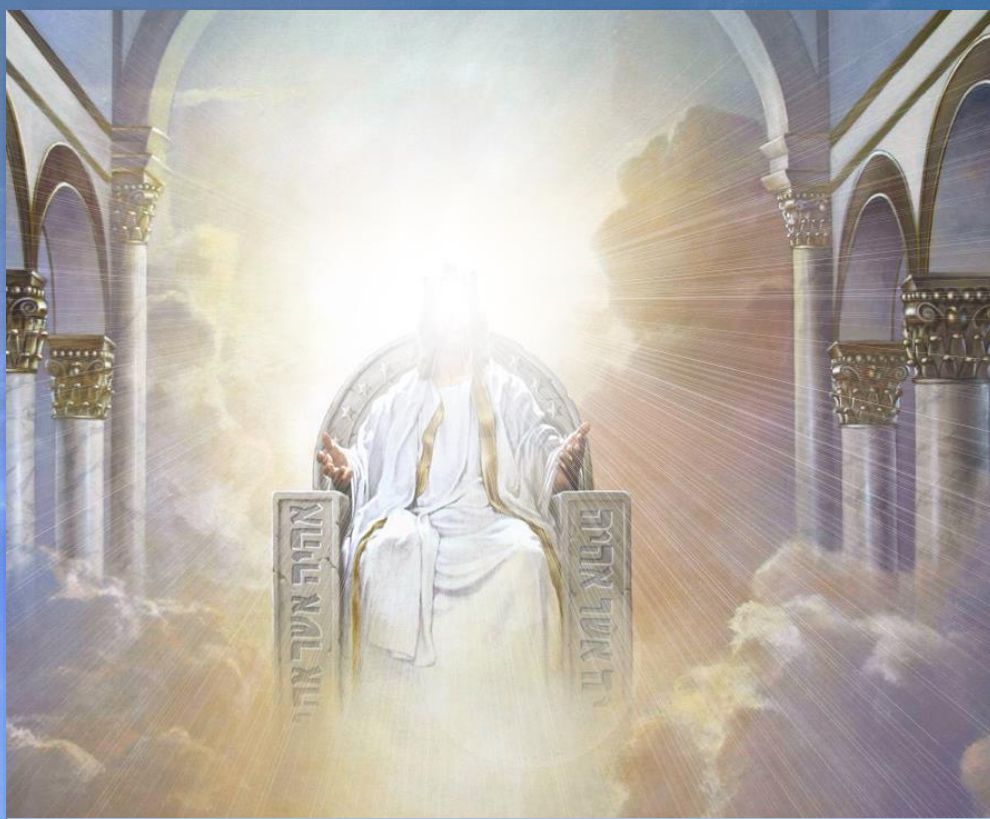
Luke 2:11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a **Saviour**, which is **Christ the Lord.**

2 Timothy 1:10 But is now made manifest **by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ**, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

Jesus Is Jehovah is Our Savior!

- John 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, **Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me,** Philip? he that hath **seen me hath seen the Father**; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?
- John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
- 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: **but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.**
- 18 ¶I will not leave you comfortless: **I will come to you.**

The Visible Image of The Invisible God



Revelation 4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and **ONE** sat on the throne.

- Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power...
- Colossians 1:19 For it pleased the Father **that in him(JESUS) should all fulness dwell;**
- Colossians 2:9 For **in him (JESUS)** dwelleth ALL the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

To be our mediator



1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

- Hebrews 9:15 ¶ And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.
- Hebrews 12:24 **And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant,** and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

The mercy seat: Propitiation



Jesus our mercy seat: propitiation

- John 20:11 But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, and looked into the sepulchre, 12 And seeth two angels in white sitting, **the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.**



The Grace Equation

Romans 5:13 For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law.
(NO LAW, SIN NOT IMPUTED !)

Romans 5:14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses,
(FROM ADAM MEN STILL DIED)

+

Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.
(Christ ENDS THE LAW for believers)

+

Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

IN CHRIST, **SIN IS NOT IMPUTED AND ALL MADE ALIVE = GRACE !**
