THE LAW

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Romans 8:3

Definition:

Law of Universal Gravitation

Every object in the Universe attracts every other object with a force directed along the line of centers for the two objects that is proportional to the product of their masses and inversely proportional to the square of the separation between the two objects.

 $\boldsymbol{F_g}$ is the gravitational force

M₁& M₂ are the masses of the two objects
r is the separation between the objects


G is the universal gravitational constant

Natural Law:

 A statement describing a relationship observed to be unchanging between phenomena for all cases in which the specified conditions are met

Law → Invariable : Unchanging

The Four Forces



- Scientists tell us that at present they know of four fundamental forces.
- Each force is derived from a fundamental law.
 That describes the way the force acts.
- Each force is transmitted or mediated by a particle

The Strong: Holds the nucleus of an atom together.....Particle: Gluon
The Weak: Holds the electrons around an atom.......Particle: Boson
The Electro-Magnetic: The agency of Light, & Heat..Particle: Photon
Gravity: Holds the planets, and stars together......Particle: Graviton

The order of the creation is that a

Law gives rise to a Force which requires a Mediator (Transmitter)


- Physical Laws define relations between physical objects;
- The relationships constitute forces, that operate on those objects
- The force operates by means of a mediator (particles) that carry or (mediate;) the force. (the mediator defines how the force actually operates)

Earth (physical matter) created Initially without physical laws!






First Light



- Genesis 1:3 ¶And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.
- 4 And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.
- 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

And God Said ... Let There Be Light

This was the moment of **first light** in the universe, between 240,000 and 300,000 years after the **Big Bang**, known as the Era of Recombination. The **first** time that photons could rest for a second, attached as electrons to atoms. It was at this point that the universe went from being totally opaque, to transparent. Nov 7, 2016

The First Law..brought forth the first forces!



- And God said, Let there be light:
 ...and there was light (order).
- Genesis 1:3
- THE STRONG
- THE WEAK
- THE ELECTRO-MAGNETIC
- GRAVITY
- This creative act was light, but was also much more than "light" alone. It was the creation of "LIGHT" (the physical laws) that brought order.
- This has to be so, because the subsequent creative verses deal with other specific creative acts. This is the only verse that implies the fixing of the state of "formlessness", mentioned in verse 2!

Erev to Boker; Evening to Morning



- 4 And God saw the light
 (Order), that it was good: and
 God divided the light (order),
 from the darkness (chaos).
- 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night.
- And the evening (erev..chaos)
 and, the morning (boker..order)
 were the first day. (evening to
 morning; chaos to order)

Without law: (operational rules) → Means without structure

"without form and void"

Creation of the biological laws



- 23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.
- 24 ¶And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.
- 25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good

Gods biological laws, state that evolution into a different species (kind) is impossible

The first spiritual law

- 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.




Physical laws are not merciful; and they cannot be ..they are laws!







Laws are by nature, impersonal and impartial



- Luke 13:1 ¶There were present at that season some that told him of the Galilaeans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices.
- 2 And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these Galilaeans were sinners above all the Galilaeans, because they suffered such things?
- 3 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

The reasons for laws

• Physical laws give physical things, structure and form, and the ability to function or operate.



• It is the law of gravity that holds the earth in orbit around the sun, that keeps the atmosphere from leaving the planet.. It is necessary for physical life!

 When a building collapses or a tunnel caves in .. The same law that is necessary for Life.. Can bring death when not carefully respected

The necessity of laws

 Spiritual laws give spiritual things structure and form, and rules that allow for function and operation




He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

The spiritual law is enforced!

The FORCE, of the law, is separation from God..first spiritual ..and then physical (death)



Paul says that the law was "ordained" by angels (Spiritual) mediators, to Moses, the (human)mediator of the old covenant




- The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.

- When the Most High divided the nations, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the nations according to the number of the angels of God.





The intended role of the spiritual mediators




- Psalms 82 Continued.....

The intended role of the human mediators




- Yet he sent prophets to them, to bring them again unto the LORD; (the way of the tree of life) and they testified against them: but they would not give ear.

Why did the old covenant fail?



- The observance and the true operation of the the Law, was given as "a way" back to the "Tree of Life"
- The spiritual Mediators ...were angels(cherubim) "to keep (guard..direct), the way of the tree of Life" Gen 3:24
- The human Mediator...was moses,
- "and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law"

"Because of the hardness of your heart"



• It only had one solution, DEATH

It Contained NO Mercy

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

Hebrews 10:28

Was this God's intent or desire?

- We see that when God deals directly; Judgement is tempered with mercy.
- And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great are his mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man. 1 Chronicles 21:13
- Genesis 4:13 ¶And Cain said unto the LORD, My punishment is greater than I can bear.
- 14 Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, that every one that findeth me shall slay me.
- 15 And the LORD said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And the LORD set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him. (the mark was to allow for the escape of judgement!)

But the mediators did not, could not? show mercy

- 15 And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 18: Then the angel of the LORD commanded Gad to say to David, that David should go up, and set up an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 27:And the LORD commanded the angel; and he put up his sword again into the sheath thereof.
- 1 Chronicles 21:15, 18, and 27


"Obey his voice"

The human mediators also failed

•Numbers 20:11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also. 12 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not,



to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

(Could no longer lead the "way")

8 He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so. Matthew 19

The law of gravity causes death!

- When someone dies because of a fall or building collapse, It does not make the Law bad. It is the same law that causes rain to fall
- It is necessary at this time, for the greater good that gravity exists!
- It cannot be abolished unless a better law can take its place, that did all the good things that gravity does, but without the inflexbilty that sometimes brings death!

The Law of God brings about death!




- For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.
- Romans 7:5

Is the law bad?

- Romans 7:7 ¶What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.
- 8 But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead.
- 9 For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.
- 10 And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death.

The range of the strong force!

- A force which can hold a nucleus together against the enormous forces of repulsion of the protons is strong indeed. However, it is not an inverse square force like the electromagnetic force and it has a very short range.
- Of the four forces it is by far the strongest, 10x100000000...0000...stronger than gravity, it only operates over the tiniest of distances..
- 1/10000000000 meters. The law of the strong force applies only over this tiny distance! This means that if you can get the smallest fraction awayit has NO POWER

The Strong Force





Range of the strong force!

• So when the atom was finally split(died), The power of the law that mediated the strong force was broken!, and enormous energy was released!


- Just like at the breaking of the strong force where enormous power is released,

The New Covenant



- 14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
 - 15 ¶And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

The New Covenant



But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. Hebrews 8:6

Why is the new covenant better than the old?

- Hebrews 2:14 ¶Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;
- 15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
- 16 For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.
- 17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.
- 18 For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted.

Like wise we must "die"

- Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- Romans 6:4

The New Laws

- There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
