The three kinds of Sin

Acts 2:38 "Peter said unto them, Repent, and let each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

The Three Sins

1. Sins against the body



1 Corinthians 6:18 Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication **sinneth against his own body.**

Galatians 5:19 Now **the works of the flesh** are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

Drugs, Gluttony, Drunkenness, illicit sex, smoking, etc.....

The Three Sins

2. Sins against your brother or sister



Leviticus 6:2 If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbour in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath deceived his neighbor;

False witness, stealing
Covetousness, hatred, murder, etc.

The Three Sins

3. Sins against God



Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Judges 10:13 Yet ye have forsaken me, and served other gods: wherefore I will deliver you no more.

Idolatry, Pride, Unbelief, Blasphemy, breaking ceremonial law etc

Old testament

Sin against the body:



- No forgiveness if deliberate
- Leviticus 20:10 ¶ And the man that committeth adultery with another man's wife, even he that committeth adultery with his neighbour's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.

Old testament

Tresspass against your brother



Leviticus 6:6 And he shall bring his **trespass offering** unto the LORD, a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest:

7 And the priest shall make an atonement for him before the LORD: and **it shall be forgiven him for any thing of all that he hath done in trespassing therein.**

Old testament Sins against God



- No forgiveness if deliberate
- Hebrews 10:28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy **under two or three witnesses:**

New Testament

The Water & The Blood

Covering for the Soul = The Blood (Old Testament) The Spirit (New Testament)

Washing for the Body = The Water

Baptism washes away the Sins of the flesh!

Acts 22:16 Ananias told Saul, "Arise, and be baptized, and ***wash away your sins***, calling on the name of the Lord."

Three sins, three witnesses



- 1 John 5:8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, **the Spirit**, and **the water**, and **the blood**: and these three agree in one.

Sins against the body are Forgiven by;

Baptism: for the remission(cleansing of sin)

Cornelius the Gentile

- Acts 11:13 And he shewed us how he had seen an angel in his house, which stood and said unto him, Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter;
- 14 Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved.



Start of the Journey: Baptized/Washed!

- **Washing by the Water** Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and **our bodies washed** with pure water.



The ONE baptism!

"Born of water" does not stand alone here, but rather inseparable with "and spirit". Just as "raining cats and dogs" refers to one rain, or "this item is our bread and butter" refers to one mainstay item, "water and the spirit" refers to one birth.

The Cloud = The Spirit

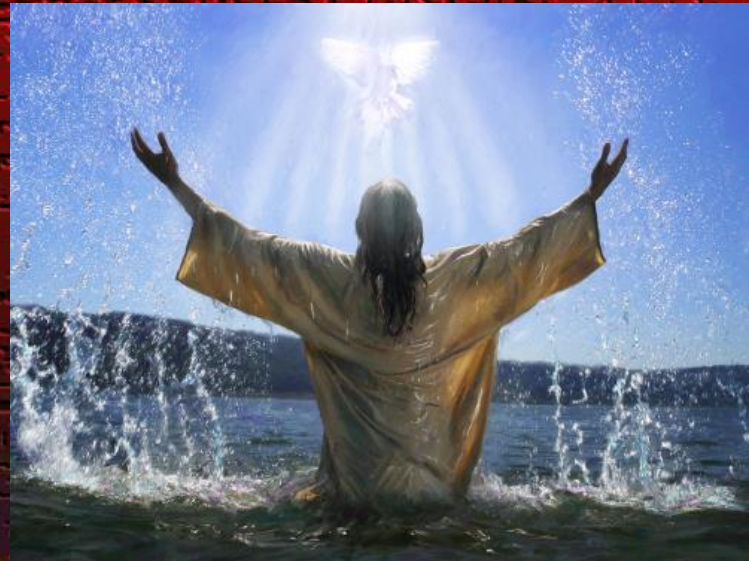
The Sea = The Water

- John 13:10 Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean....

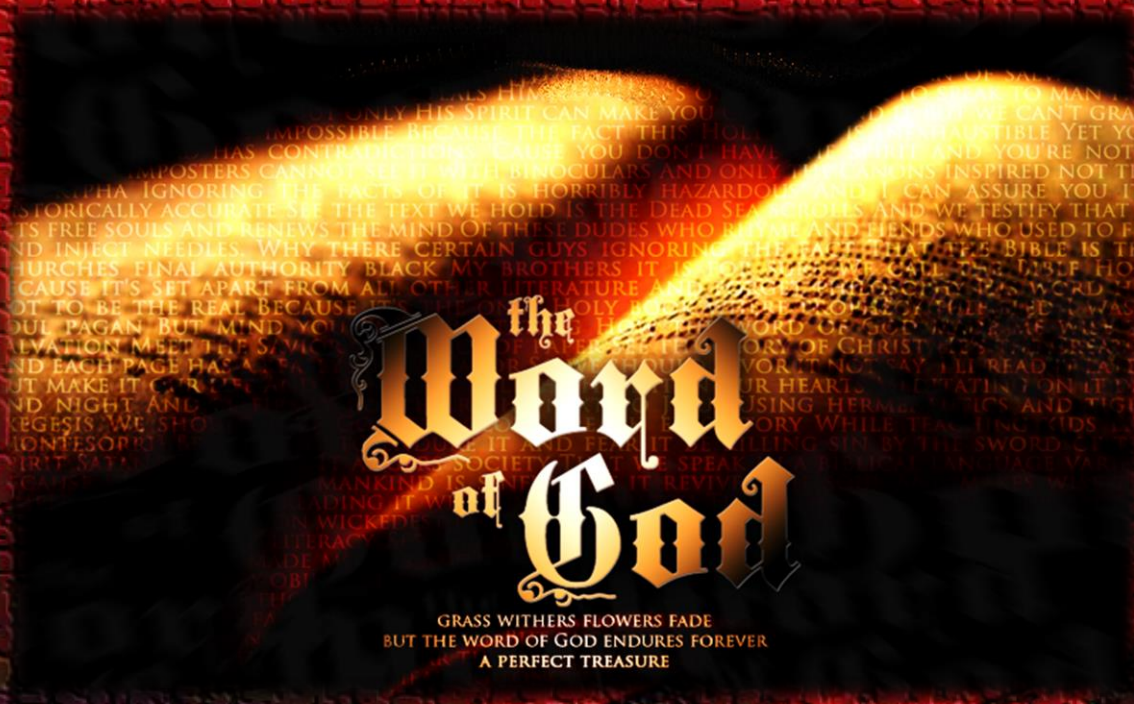


Washing the feet during the journey Keeps you clean.....

- John 13:10 Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean....
- John 13:16 Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?
- 7 Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter.

The WORD is the water for the feet!

- Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,



No CondemnationWalk



- Romans 8:1 ¶ There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- Washed/ Baptized by the Water/Blood
- Washed there feet By walking in the word!

Blasphemy

- Matthew 12:32 And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, **it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.**



The Soul is Sealed!




- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby **ye are sealed** unto the day of redemption.
- But what happens to the Body ? If we do not get baptised? Or have not let the word wash us?

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: 28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

THE DESTRUCTION OF the BODY



To deliver such an one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

—1 Corinthians 5:5

1 Corinthians 5:5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh (THE BODY), that the spirit (SOUL) may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

THE DESTRUCTION OF THE BODY (Strong meat)

Now the word "deliver" in verse 20, paradidomimeans to hand over, to give over, to commit. Or the best translation to get the sense here, to abandon...to abandon, hands off is the idea, to remove protection and abandon someone to Satan. It is the same word in Acts 15:26 that the Authorized version translates "hazarded." Because it intends to convey the idea of being exposed to great danger, to be out from under any insulation, any protection, any shelter and given over totally to Satan.
