


## Part 2 The Blood of Sprinkling

# Atonement : Covering



Leviticus 17:11 For the **life (Nephesh SOUL)** of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an **atonement (COVERING)** for the soul.

**The Blood is the Covering for the Soul !**

# Behold the Lamb of God


## Sins “Taken” not covered



John 1:29 ¶The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

Hebrews 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: 14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 10:4 **For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.**

# His Blood Given



Isaiah 53:12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he **hath poured out his soul unto death:** and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

# The Sevenfold Sprinkling



Leviticus 4:6 And the priest shall dip his finger in the blood, and sprinkle of **the blood seven times before the LORD**, before the vail of the sanctuary.

Leviticus 4:17 And the priest shall dip his finger in some of the blood, and **sprinkle it seven times before the LORD**, even before the vail.

Leviticus 16:14 And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall **he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.**

Leviticus 16:19 And **he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times**, and cleanse it, and hallow it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel.

Numbers 19:4 And Eleazar the priest shall take of her blood with his finger, and **sprinkle of her blood directly before the tabernacle of the congregation seven times:**

Hematidrosis is a condition in which capillary blood vessels that feed the sweat glands rupture, causing them to exude blood, occurring under conditions of extreme physical or emotional stress.<sup>[4]</sup> Severe mental anxiety activates the sympathetic nervous system to invoke the stress-fight or flight reaction to such a degree as to cause hemorrhage of the vessels supplying the sweat glands into the ducts of the sweat glands.<sup>[5]</sup> It has been suggested that acute fear and extreme stress can cause hematidrosis.<sup>[6]</sup>

# The Blood from his head(4)





- Psalms 22:16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: **they pierced my hands and my feet.**


# The Blood From His Side (7)



John 19:34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there **out blood** and water.



# The Sevenfold Sprinkling Sanctification (4)




Hebrews 13:12 Wherefore Jesus also, that **he might sanctify the people with his own blood**, suffered without the gate.




## Healing (6)
