
The Kingdom by Works



- Matthew 8:2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.
- 3 And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- 4 And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, **and offer the gift that Moses commanded,** for a testimony unto them.

Matthew 16:27 For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall **reward every man according to his works.**

The Kingdom of Heaven fulfils the law



Matthew 5:20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye **shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.**

Matthew 5:18 For verily I say unto you, **Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.**

19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the **least in the kingdom of heaven:** but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

The Millennial Kingdom Fulfils the Law!


Matthew 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:

33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.


34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

The Vision of Ezekiel



Ezekiel 40:1 ¶ In the five and twentieth year of our captivity, in the beginning of the year, in the tenth day of the month, in the fourteenth year after that the city was smitten, in the selfsame day the hand of the LORD was upon me, and brought me thither.

2 In the visions of God brought he me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a very high mountain, by which was as the frame of a city on the south.

3 And he brought me thither, and, behold, there was a man, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

- 4 And the man said unto me, Son of man, behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears, and set thine heart upon all that I shall shew thee; for to the intent that I might shew them unto thee art thou brought hither: declare all that thou seest to the house of Israel.

Why Sacrifices and Offerings ?

- Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.
- Hebrews 9:26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Hebrews 9:28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

The First Covering

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul (Nephesh)

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

The Breath of Life is the word of God,

- John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Mans Covering: Fig Leaves



Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

Isaiah 30:1 ¶Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that **cover with a covering, but not of my spirit**, that they may add sin to sin:

- Leviticus 17:11 **For the life of the flesh is in the blood:** and I have given it to you upon the altar to **make an atonement for your souls:** for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul. **Life:** Hebrew “Nephesh” Soul!

2 Chronicles 29:22

So they killed the bullocks, and the priests received the blood, and sprinkled it on the altar: likewise, when they had killed the rams, they sprinkled the blood upon the altar: they killed also the lambs, and they sprinkled the blood upon the altar.

Hell: The literal place of Judgment



- 2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment

The Blood was the covering .. In death !

- For the life of a creature is in the blood, and I have given it to you to make atonement(A COVERING) for yourselves **ON THE ALTAR**; it is the blood that makes atonement for one's life. (Leviticus 17:11—NIV)



Not having received the promise!


- Hebrews 11:13 These all died in faith, **not having received the promises**, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
- 39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:
- 40 **God having provided some better thing for us**, that they without us should not be made perfect.

“The better thing”

- Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

23 ¶It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.


24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:



The redemption under the Law

- Christ's death was to end the law(the first testament) and through the blood cover those who died under it here is the proof
- Hebrews: 9:15 For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, so that, since a death has taken place **for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant**, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

“The better thing”



- Hebrews 12:24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.
