

Founding of the Church



- Acts 2:1 ¶And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
- 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.
- 46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,
- 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.







Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:







The Power of God unto Salvation

The Good News! Salvation (Sozo) for the Soul



- 1 Peter 1:9 Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.
- 10 ¶Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:
- 11 Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.
- 12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

Filling the world with his message

THE WORK OF THE CHURCH



Acts 5:27 And when they had brought them, they set them before the council: and the high priest asked them, 28 Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this name? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us. 29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men. 30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. 31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. 32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

The Early Church: The Gifts (Miracles, Healing, Faith, Prophecy...)

Healing, Deliverance, Answers to prayers, come about in the New Testament church through channels. And each channel operates in a certain way.

- 1. Through Declarative Faith (Son-ship dominion).
- 2. Through prayer(supplications) and fasting (Covenantal).
- 3. Through Gods sovereign choice (The direct gift).
- 4. Through The Gifting of another (The indirect gift).
- 5. Through Gods Grace Waiting patiently. (Spiritual Sufficiency)

The Faith requirements!

- (Son-ship dominion). Through Declarative Faith (requires Faith, and a deep spirit life)
- (Covenantal). Through prayer(supplications) and fasting (requires proportional faith).
- (The Direct Gift)Through Gods sovereign choice. (requires little faith).
- (The Indirect Gift). Through The Gifting of another. (requires no faith in the recipient, just desire).
- (Spiritual sufficiency) Through Gods Grace, Waiting patiently. (requires faith/Trust in God)
