

The Weapons: The Wind




- Ezekiel 37:1 ¶The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,
- 2 And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, there were very many in the open valley; and, lo, they were very dry.
- 3 And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord GOD, thou knowest.
- 4 Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

The Ruach HaKodesh




- Ezekiel 37:5 Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:
- 6 And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- 7 So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.
- 8 And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but there was no breath in them.
- 9 Then said he unto me, Prophesy unto the wind, prophesy, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.
- 10 So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army

- Genesis 8:1 ¶And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind(RUACH) to pass over the earth, and the waters assuaged;
- Exodus 14:21 ¶And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind(RUACH) all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

The Weapon that feeds



- Numbers 11:31 ¶And there went forth a wind(RUACH) from the LORD, and brought quails from the sea, and let them fall by the camp, as it were a day's journey on this side, and as it were a day's journey on the other side, round about the camp, and as it were two cubits high upon the face of the earth.
 - that day, and all that night, and all the next day, and they gathered the quails: he that gathered least gathered ten homers: and they spread them all abroad for themselves round about the camp.


The battle for the atmosphere

Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:




Protecting the Atmosphere

- 22 He took not away the pillar of the cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, from before the people.




Filling the House




- Acts 2:1 ¶And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

The Weapon of the covering





Binding the Strong Man




STRONGMAN
