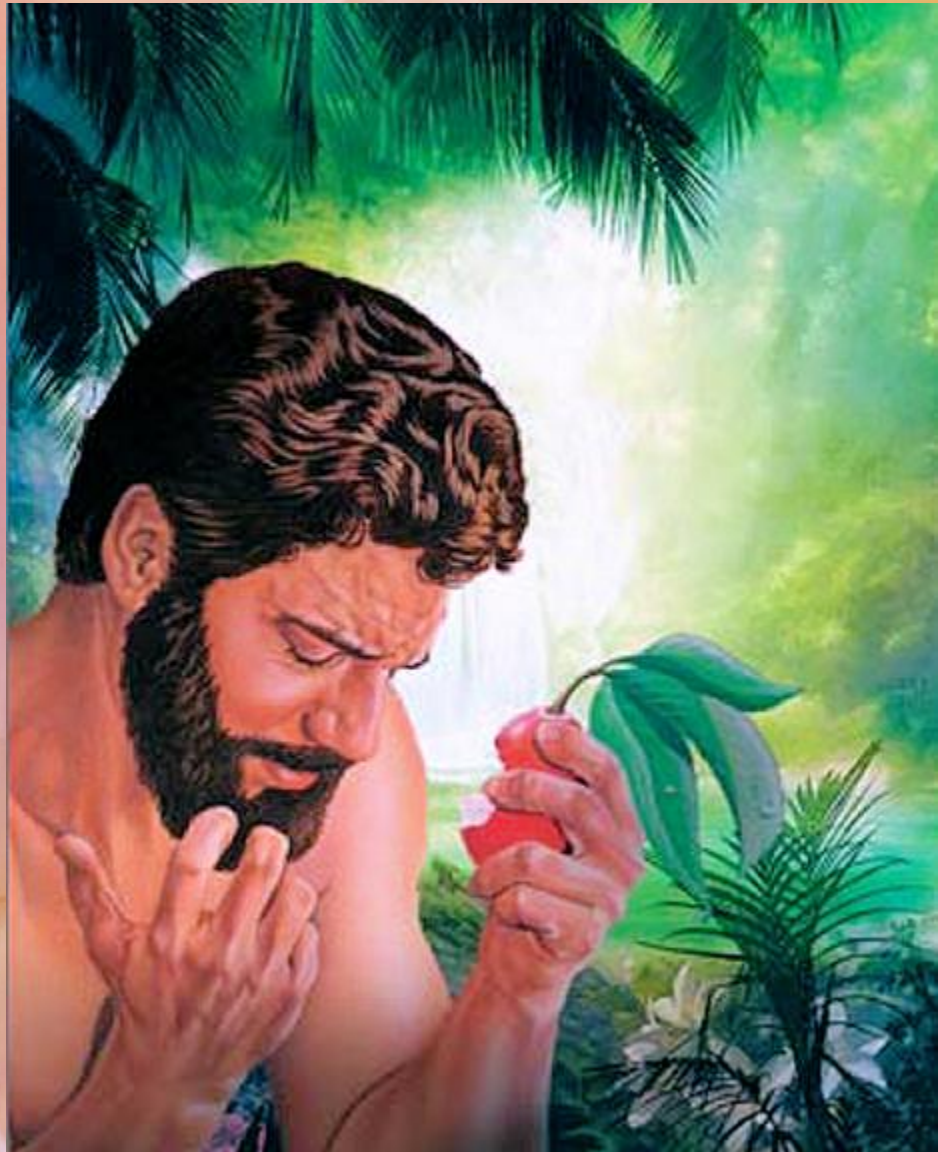
How Does God Speak ?



Hearing God's Voice

Communion: The Voice of the Lord

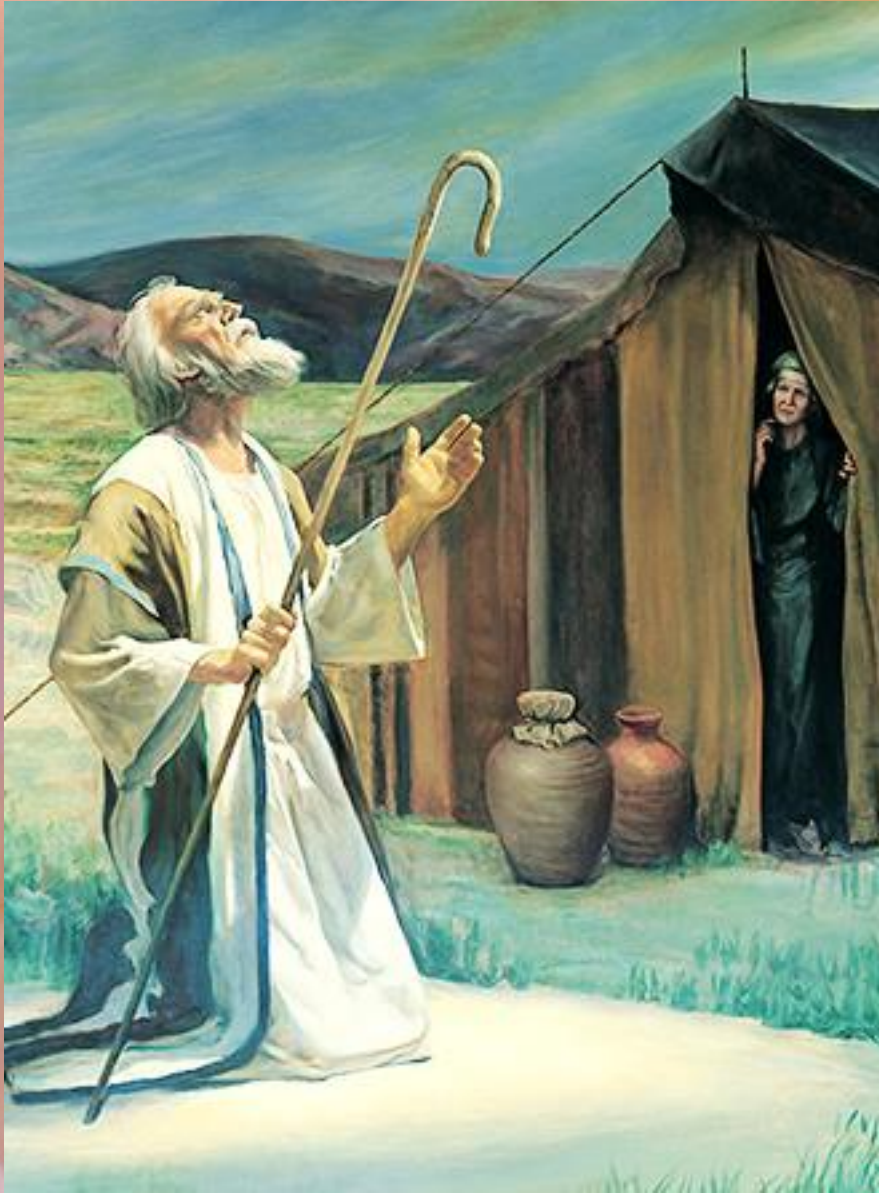


- Genesis 3:8 And they heard **the voice of the LORD God** walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Genesis 3:10 And he said, **I heard thy voice** in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

The Voice Speaks The Word

- John 1:1 ¶ **In the beginning was the Word**, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**.
- 4 In him was life; and **the life was the light of men**.
- 3 **All things were made by him**; and without him was not any thing made that was made.
- Genesis 1:1 ¶ **In the beginning God** created the heaven and the earth.
- 3 ¶ And God said, **Let there be light: and there was light**.

The Word In a Vision



- Genesis 15:1 ¶ After these things the **word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision**, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.
- 3 And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir.
- 4 And, behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.
- 5 And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.
- 6 **And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.**

God Spoke through three channels Dreams, Urim, Prophets



- 1 Samuel 28:6 And when Saul enquired of the LORD, the LORD answered him not, neither by **dreams**, nor by **Urim**, nor by **prophets**.
- 1 Samuel 28:7 ¶ Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit, that I **may go to her, and enquire of her**. And his servants said to him, Behold, there is a woman that hath a familiar spirit at Endor.

By Urim and Thummim



- Exodus 28:30 And thou shalt put in the breastplate of judgment the Urim and the Thummim; and they shall be upon Aaron's heart, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel upon his heart before the LORD continually.
- Leviticus 8:8 And he put the breastplate upon him: also he put in the breastplate the Urim and the Thummim.

By Urim and Thummim “Revelation’ & Truth

Numbers 27:21 And he shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall ask counsel for him **after the judgment of Urim** before the LORD: at his word shall they go out, and at his word they shall come in, both he, and all the children of Israel with him, even all the congregation.



God Speaks in Strange Ways



- Ezekiel 4:1 ¶Thou also, son of man, take thee a tile, and lay it before thee, and portray upon it the city, even Jerusalem:
- 2 And lay siege against it, and build a fort against it, and cast a mount against it; set the camp also against it, and set battering rams against it round about.
- 3 Moreover take thou unto thee an iron pan, and set it for a wall of iron between thee and the city: and set thy face against it, and it shall be besieged, and thou shalt lay siege against it. This shall be a sign to the house of Israel.
- 4 Lie thou also upon thy left side, and lay the iniquity of the house of Israel upon it: according to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon it thou shalt bear their iniquity.

God Speaks in Strange Ways

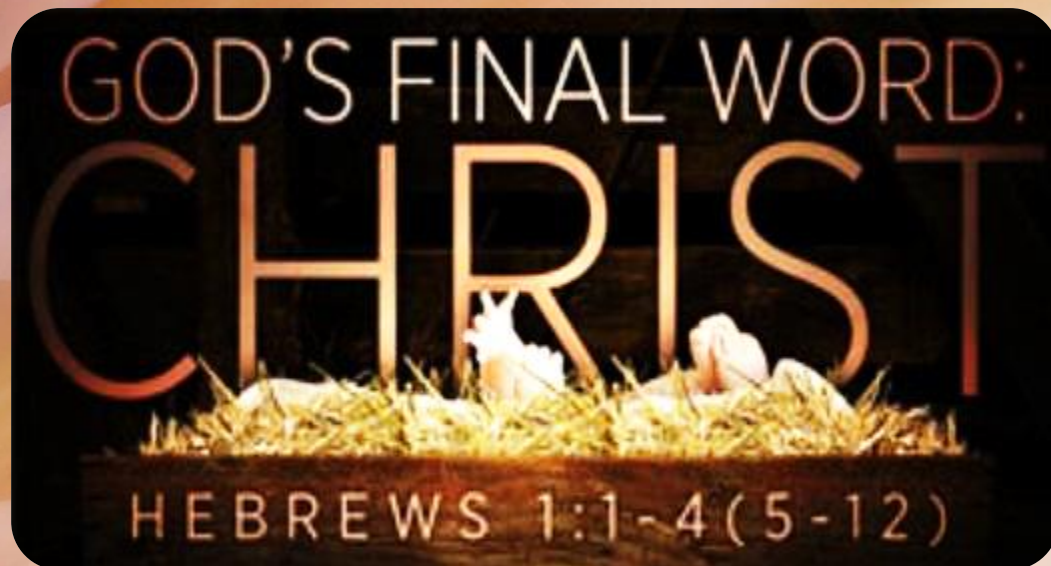


- Ezekiel 4:9 ¶ Take thou also unto thee wheat, and barley, and beans, and lentiles, and millet, and fitches, and put them in one vessel, and make thee bread thereof, according to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon thy side, three hundred and ninety days shalt thou eat thereof.


- 11 Thou shalt drink also water by measure, the sixth part of an hin: from time to time shalt thou drink.
- 12 And thou shalt eat it as barley cakes, and thou shalt bake it with dung that cometh out of man, in their sight.
- 13 And the LORD said, Even thus shall the children of Israel eat their defiled bread among the Gentiles, whither I will drive them.
- 10 And thy meat which thou shalt eat shall be by weight, twenty shekels a day: from time to time shalt thou eat it.

Ephesians 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

17 For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head;

Revelation 4:1 ¶After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

- 1 Samuel 23:9 And David knew that Saul secretly practised mischief against him; and he said to Abiathar the priest, Bring hither the ephod.
- 10 Then said David, O LORD God of Israel, thy servant hath certainly heard that Saul seeketh to come to Keilah, to destroy the city for my sake.
- 11 Will the men of Keilah deliver me up into his hand? will Saul come down, as thy servant hath heard? O LORD God of Israel, I beseech thee, tell thy servant. And the LORD said, He will come down.
- 12 Then said David, Will the men of Keilah deliver me and my men into the hand of Saul? And the LORD said, They will deliver thee up.
- 13 Then David and his men, which were about six hundred, arose and departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was escaped from Keilah; and he forbare to go forth.
