Revelation 3:18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

The First Covering : **The Spirit of God**



- John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

The Symbol in the Old testament

- Psalms 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

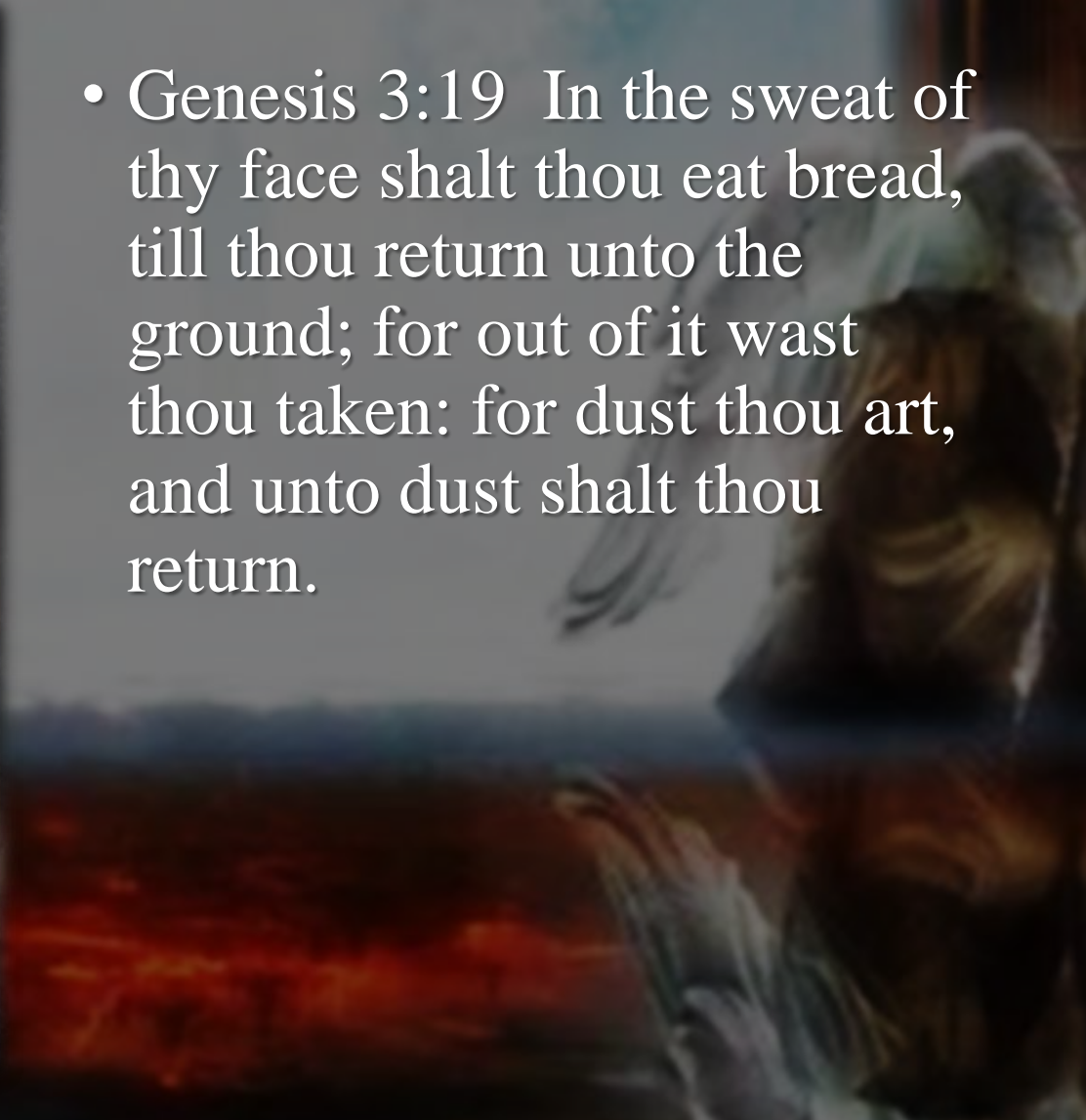
Another model

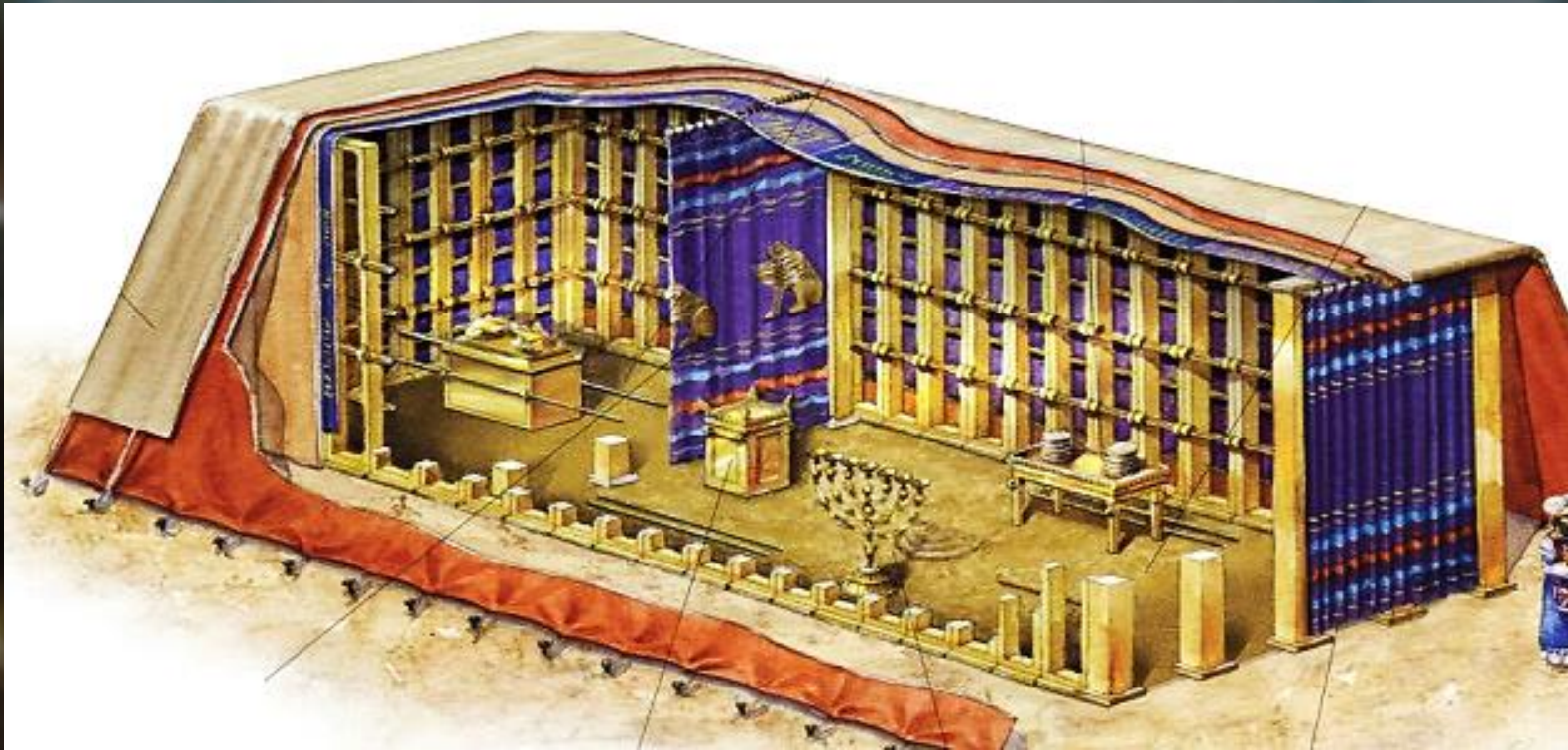


The great model

The Three Parts

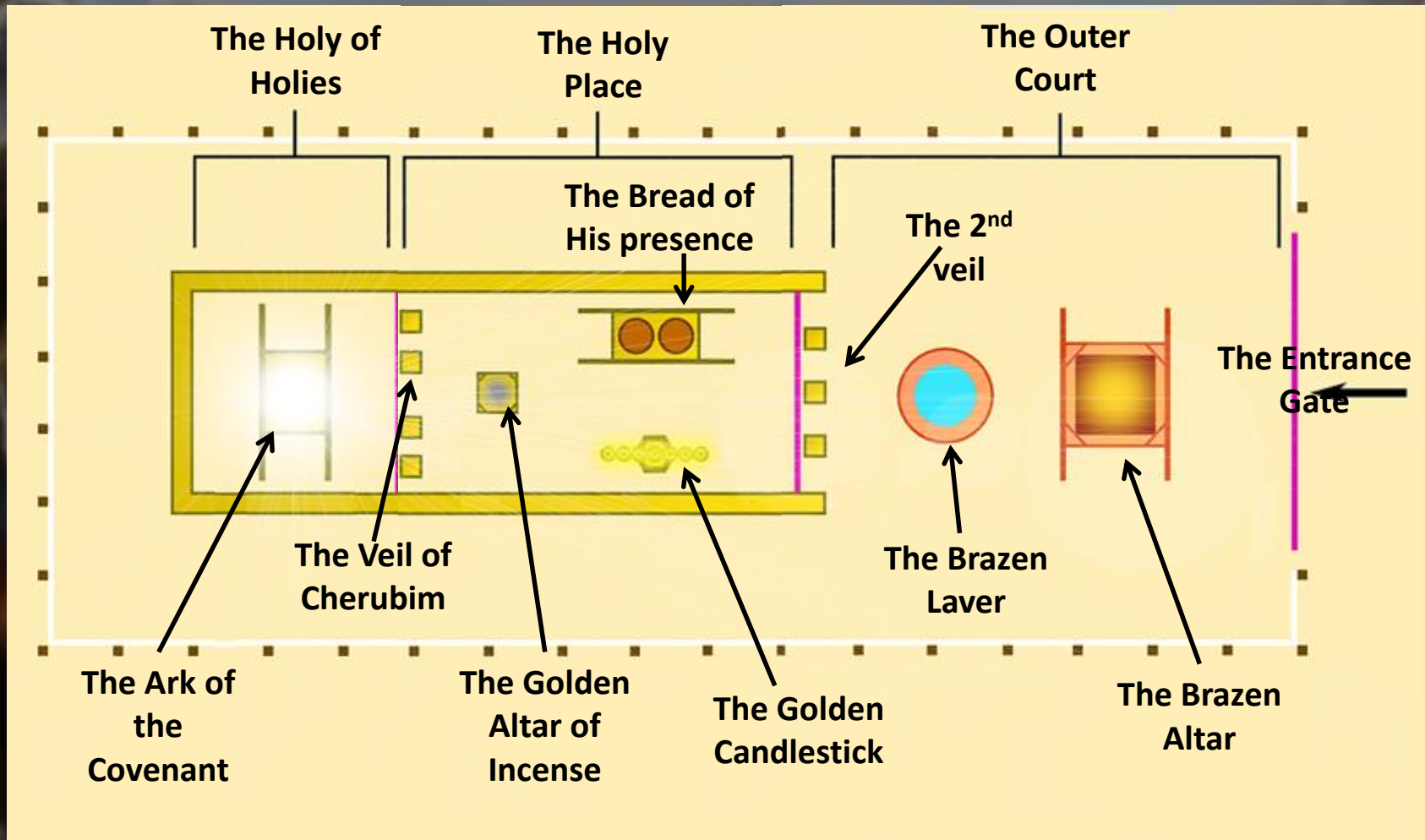


- 1. The Tabernacle

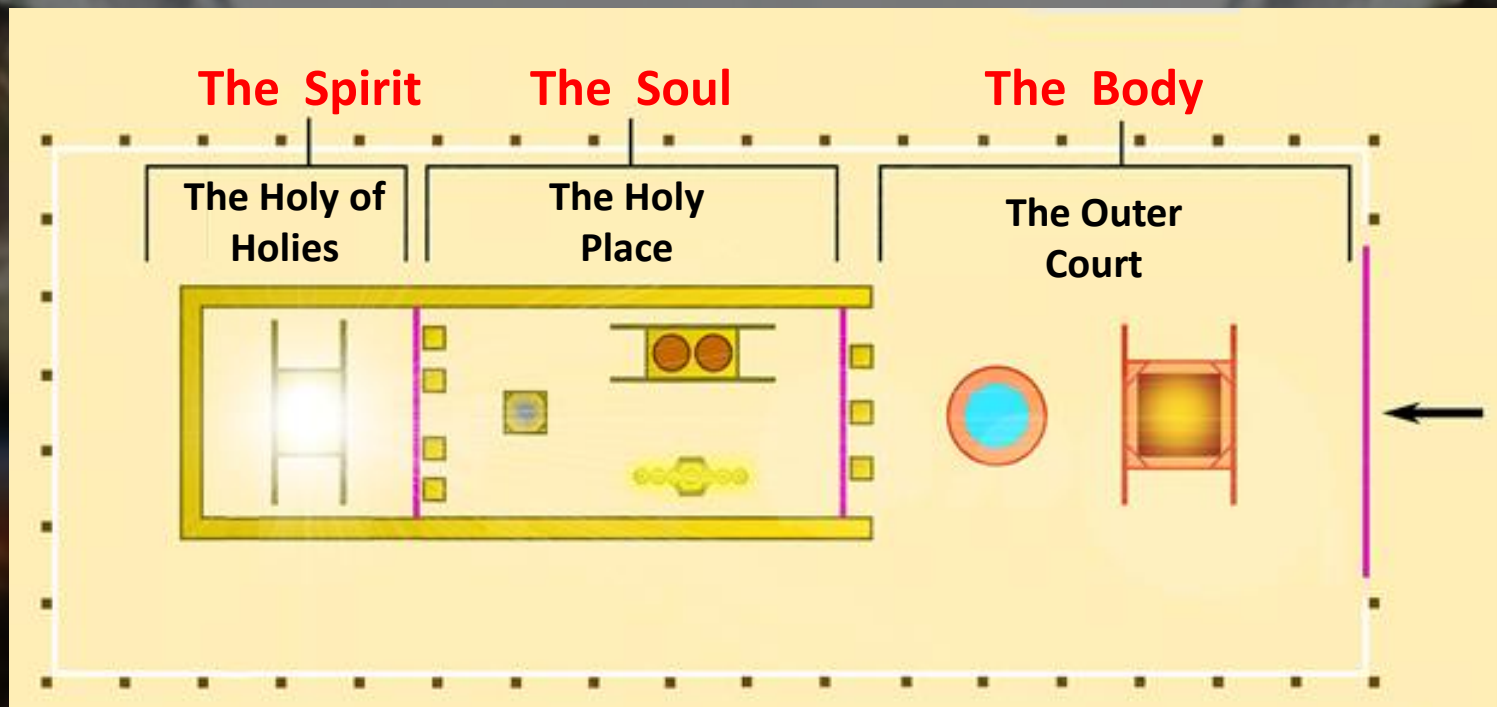
Built according to Gods plan

- Exodus 25:9 According to all that I shew thee, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it.

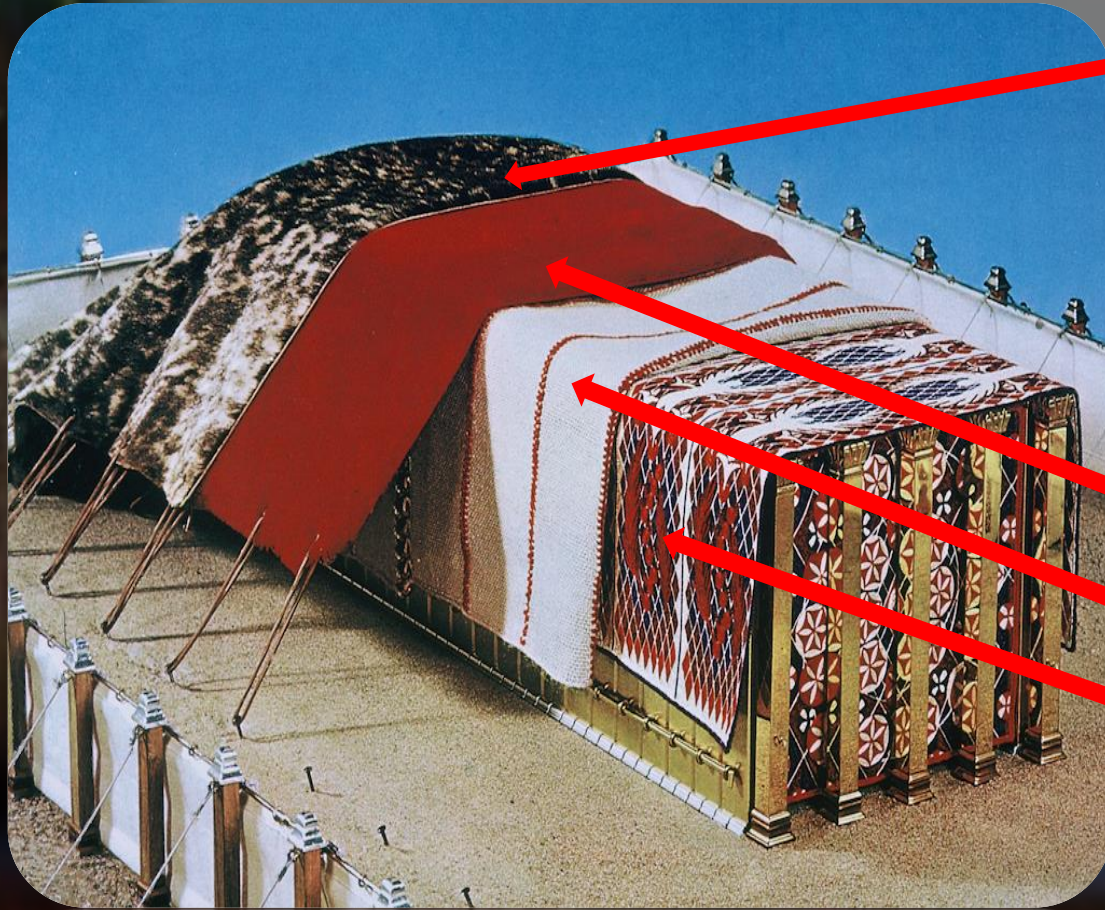


The Coverings: Spirit, Soul and Body

- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 ¶ And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body (*Your Temple/Tabernacle*) be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.



The Four Coverings



- Outer Covering
 - KJV Badger skins
 - (Porpoise skin) water proof
- Rams: Skin dyed Red.
- Goats hair
- Fine embroidered Linen

Outer Covering : The Flesh

Rams skin dyed Red : The Blood (Atonement)

Goats hair : The Sacrifice

Embroidered fine Linen : The Spirit (The righteousness of Christ)

The Daily Sacrifice “tamid”

For the “Sins of the Body”




The Daily Sacrifice was for a
“continual or perpetual”
sacrifice

- Numbers 28:24 After this manner ye shall offer daily, throughout the seven days, the meat of the sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: it shall be offered beside the **continual** burnt offering, and his drink offering.

The Daily Sacrifice



- Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,
- 27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
- Romans 12:1 ¶I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

- The daily sacrifice, Covering for “sins of the flesh”
 - The Passover for redemption/Covering of the Soul from Hell
 - Pentecost The sealing/Covering of the Soul by the Spirit
 - Atonement The Redemption of the Body
