
DOMINION prayer

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:


15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Prayer must come from the Soul/Spirit





"Necessary faith"




Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Belief is the first step with God

"the measure of faith"

- Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

Every Man ? Because Faith is a Law



 Romans 3:27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith.

The Law of faith enables miracles




Matthew 9:2 And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith

But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. Matthew 9:29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. Matthew 15:28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt.


Luke 7:50 And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

The law of faith can work without "knowing Jesus"



- Matthew 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?
- 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.


But doubt & unbelief stops the Law of faith



John 20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

- Mark 6:5 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.
- 6 And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

The problem in using the law of faith <u>ALONE</u>, is that it depends on <u>YOUR</u> <u>FAITH</u> and how <u>much UNBELIEF</u> you have.



- Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.
- Matthew 21:21 Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If YE have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.

Faith is primarily a defensive weapon




• Ephesians 6:16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Faith alone can get you a miracle But there is a better way!




So what is the Answer?




 Luke 9:1 ¶Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

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
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Using Authority




• Mark 1:27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine is this? for with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits, and they do obey him.

These had the faith, but no authority!




- Acts 19:13 ¶Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.
- 14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so.

Receiving dominion and Authority



• Mark 13: 34 For the Son of man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

Using the authority, is using the WORD in command



 Matthew 8:9 For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.

Faith is the shield, The Authority(Command word) is the sword



 Luke 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

Luke 4:8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.


Receiving the power and authority



• Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.


2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

The Familial Prayer



So the "Lord's prayer", is exclusively a New Testament prayer valid only to those who because of Christ's death have become part of the heavenly family by being born again/ Jesus not only taught The Lord's Prayer to his disciples, but clearly demonstrated this when praying from his humanity as "The son", he almost exclusively refers to the divine nature as the "FATHER" more than 60 times in the New Testament. In fact Jesus only refers to God as God twice!

Only his brothers have the right!



Galatians 4:6 and because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

Hebrews 2:11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

Modes of Prayer To our Father/ or Against the devil

- Supplication
- Intercession/Spirit
- Thanksgiving
- Praise & Worship
- Submission
- Agreement
- Faith
- Sickness (our choices)

- Sickness (Sickness, spirit of infirmity)
- Demonic Possession

- These need Authority
- In other words the spirit(Sonship)

Does God Cause Sickness ?



1 John 3:8For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

- John 9:1 ¶And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth.
- 2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?
- 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
