


LAODICEA: THE LUKEWARM CHURCH

- 8 For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, **that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life:**
- 9 But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead:
- 8 Brothers and sisters, we want you to know about the hard times we suffered in Asia Minor. We were having a lot of trouble. It was far more than we could stand. We even thought we were going to die.
- 9 **In fact, in our hearts we felt as if we were under the sentence of death.** But that happened so that we would not depend on ourselves but on God. He raises the dead to life. 10 God has saved us from deadly dangers. And he will continue to do it. We have put our hope in him. He will continue to save us.

- 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.



AND THE FLAME SHALL NOT CONSUME YOU.






- Romans 8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,
