Walking In Light, Walking in Separation


• Knowledge of Him (Separated from Ignorance)

Separation(Sanctification) The Path to Holiness



- 1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:
- 1 Thessalonians 4:3 For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:
- 1 Thessalonians 4:4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 ¶But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:
- 1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.


Walking in Light is....

Opposites Holiness and the Profane. Holiness (Separated) Specially Unique, Profane (Common) unvalued




Becoming Holy



- Exodus 30:22 ¶Moreover the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 23 Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred shekels, and of sweet cinnamon half so much, even two hundred and fifty shekels, and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty shekels,
- 24 And of cassia five hundred shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary, and of oil olive an hin:
- 25 And thou shalt make it an oil of holy ointment, an ointment compound after the art of the apothecary: it shall be an holy anointing oil.

Becoming Holy Means Becoming Unique!



31 And thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil unto me throughout your generations.

• 32 Upon man's flesh shall it not be poured, neither shall ye make any other like it, after the composition of it: it is holy, and it shall be holy unto you.

33 Whosoever compoundeth any like it, or whosoever putteth any of it upon a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people.
