



## The Fourth Appointment



• Leviticus 23:15 ¶And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete: 16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD. 17 Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

## Counting the "Omer": A measure of Grain



- Leviticus 23;9 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying
- 10 "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest. 11 He shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it. NLT translation

## Pentecost: First fruits of the living The wheat harvest



Romans 12:1 ¶I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy,


service.

wherever you live, bring two loaves of bread to be lifted up before the LORD as an offering. These loaves must be baked from three quarts of choice flour that contains yeast. They will be an offering to the LORD from the first of acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable Your crops. NLT Translation



## The Day of Mercy





## The Day of Mercy




• 1 Chronicles 21:16 And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders of Israel, who were clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.

## The Day of Mercy



- 1 Chronicles 21:18 ¶Then the angel of the LORD commanded Gad to say to David, that David should go up, and set up an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite. 19 And David went up at the saying of Gad, which he spake in the name of the LORD.
- 20 And Ornan turned back, and saw the angel; and his four sons with him hid themselves. Now Ornan was threshing wheat.

#### Law to Grace



Exodus 19:1 ¶In the third month, when the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came they into the wilderness of Sinai. 2 For they were departed from Rephidim, and were come to the desert of Sinai, and had pitched in the wilderness; and there Israel camped before the mount.

#### Law to Grace



The month of Nisan always has 30 days, the month of Iyar always has 29 days. So from the 14th of Nisan to the 30th is 17 days. Add the 29 days of the full month of Iyar, and you have a total of 46 days till mount Sinai. In Exodus 19, God told them to prepare for three days before coming up to the mount. That adds up to 49 days. On the 4th day of Sivan, Moses went up the mount to receive the Law, and God came down on the mount with fire and noise Just like on the day of Pentecost! 50 days from Passover



THE FEASTS SYMBOLIZED IN THE MENORAH




## A gentile is converted!


#### A Gentile bride?




Boaz: Strength, or in his strength

## Prepare for the meeting









## And under his wings!




- Psalm 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and **under his wings** shalt thou trust: his truth [shall be thy] shield and buckler.
