# The New Covenant


But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is **the mediator of a better covenant**, which was established upon better promises. Hebrews 8:6

# The Order Of Creation

- God Creates Laws
- Laws Cause Actions
- The Actions are Transmitted  
(Mediated) by Agents

# Earth (physical matter) created Initially without physical laws !




- In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.
- Genesis 1:2

# That's why it was “Formless & Void”



- and **darkness** (chaos..disorder) was upon the face of the deep. Genesis 1:2

# The First Law..brought forth the first forces !



- And God said, Let there be light:
  - ...**and there was light (order).**
- Genesis 1:3
  - THE STRONG
  - THE WEAK
  - THE ELECTRO-MAGNETIC
  - GRAVITY
- **This creative act was light, but was also much more than “light” alone. It was the creation of “LIGHT” (the physical laws) that brought order.**
- **This has to be so, because the subsequent creative verses deal with other specific creative acts. This is the only verse that implies the fixing of the state of “formlessness”, mentioned in verse 2 !**

# Erev to Boker ; Evening to Morning



- 4 And God saw the **light (Order)**, that it was good: and God divided the **light (order)**, from the darkness (**chaos**).
- 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night.
- And the evening (**erev..chaos**) and, the **morning (boker..order)** were the first day. (evening to morning; chaos to order)

**Without law: (operational rules) → Means without structure**

**“without form and void”**

# Creation of the biological laws



- 23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.
- 24 ¶ And God said, Let the earth bring forth the **living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind:** and it was so.
- 25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and **every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind:** and God saw that it was good

Gods biological laws, state that evolution into a different species (kind) is impossible

- 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: **for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.**




# The reasons for laws

- Physical laws give physical things, structure and form, and the ability to function or operate.



- It is the law of gravity that holds the earth in orbit around the sun, that keeps the atmosphere from leaving the planet.. It is necessary for physical life !
- **When a building collapses or a tunnel caves in .. The same law that is necessary for Life.. Can bring death when not carefully respected**



# Paul says that the law was “ordained” by angels (Spiritual) mediators, to Moses, the (human) mediator of the old covenant



- The chariots of God are twenty thousand, **even thousands of angels**: the Lord is among them, **as in Sinai, in the holy place**.

# 613 Mitzvot or 613 Commandments

(Hebrew: תרי"ג מצוות )

- Judaism, teaches that the Torah contains 613 mitzvot (Hebrew for "commandments," from mitzvah - מצוה -- "precept", from צוה, tzavah- "command").
- According to tradition, of these 613 commandments, 248 are mitzvot aseh ("positive commandments" commands to perform certain actions) and 365 are mitzvot lo taaseh ("negative commandments" commands to abstain from certain actions). Three-hundred and sixty-five corresponded to the number of days in a year and 248 was believed by ancient Hebrews to be the number of bones and significant organs in the human body.

# 613 Mitzvot or 613 Commandments

(Hebrew: תרי"ג מצוות )



- 38 Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the **fringe of the borders** a ribband of blue:
- 39 And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and **remember all the commandments of the LORD**, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:
- Numbers 15

This is called a tallit. It is a prayer shawl. Men and boys wear it to pray.



# “The law of Moses”

- For the law was **given by Moses**, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.
- John 1:17

And it came to pass, when **Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book**, until they were finished, Deuteronomy 31:24

# The mediator has authority on how the law is Transmitted !

- Matthew 19:5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?
- 6 Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
- 7 They say unto him, Why did **Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement**, and to put her away?
- 8 He saith unto them, **Moses** because of the hardness of your hearts **suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so.**




- Numbers 15:36 And all the congregation brought him without the camp, and stoned him with stones, and he died; as the LORD commanded Moses.

# But the mediators did not, could not ? show mercy

- 15 And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, **It is enough, stay now thine hand.** And the angel of the LORD stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 18: **Then the angel of the LORD** commanded Gad to say to David, that David should go up, and set up an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 27: And the LORD **commanded the angel**; and he put up his sword again into the sheath thereof.

# The human mediators also failed


# Temporary supports



# Satisfying the requirement



¶ Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and **bring his blood within the veil**, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:

# God makes plain that the Mosaic covenant is temporary !



- Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make **a new covenant** with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

# Paul explains



- 7 For **if that first covenant had been faultless**, then should no place have been sought for the second.
- 8 **For finding fault with them**, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

The law's purpose was to expose sin (old covenant).  
Jesus purpose was to defeat sin (new covenant).

# “Weak thru the Flesh “




- 10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; **I will put my laws into their mind,** and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:
- Hebrews 8

The Mosaic Law is weak because it is dependent on man's ability

# Purpose of new covenant

- For God sent not his Son into the world **to condemn the world**; but that the world through him might be saved.

# In his own words !

# “Nor the will of man”

- Hebrews chapter 9
- 7 But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people:
- 8 ¶The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:
- 9 Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that **could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience;**

¶For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year **continually** make the comers thereunto perfect.

Yom kippur was the only time when the High Priest could enter the Holy of Holies **and call upon the name of YHVH** to offer blood sacrifice for the sins of the people. This “Life for a Life” principle is the foundation of the sacrificial system and marked the great day of intercession made by the high priest on behalf of Israel.
