





But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousness are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Isa 64 verse 6

In the flesh he had always been Naked !



- The fact is, he was Naked(in the body) even before he sinned, he just was not conscious of it, which allowed God (after all it is his definition!) to

pronounce his creation perfect His nakedness was apparent to God well before he sinned, the creation at no time was ever greater than the creator

Baby Adam: or who is the greatest



- Matthew 18:1 At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?
- Matthew 18:2 And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

Perfect Faith Towards God


- 1. *Absolute belief in his goodness.*

forever all those whom he is making holy.





To walk with God




- Hebrews 11:6 **But without faith it is impossible to please him:** for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

New Testament Definition



Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Struggling Over Perfection



- Hebrews 12:2 **Looking unto Jesus** the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

- The same things that caused Adam to lose Faith. Instead of looking to God he looked with new eyes at himself. And now saw that he was naked.


The Truth !



Genesis 17:1 ¶ And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, **and be thou perfect.**

Belief in Gods commands and practicing them are sufficient to make us Literally perfect

Obey Me !



- Romans 4:17 ¶(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.
- The act of allowing Gods ultimate plan for a savior to be worked through him resulted in Gods pronouncement/definition of “perfection “ being allowed to stand without question

Gods Love




- Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
