February Consecration

- **FULL FAST:** Drink only liquids (you establish the number of days).
- **GRADUAL FAST:** Abstain from all sweets and deserts the 1st week, then meats 2nd week, breads and carbohydrates the 3rd week, just fruits and vegetables last 6 days, just water the last day if you wish.
- **THE DANIEL FAST:** Eat no meat, no sweets and no bread. Drink water and juice. Eat fruits and vegetables.
- **3-DAY FAST:** This fast can be a Full Fast, Daniel Fast or give up at least one item of food.
- **PARTIAL FAST:** A partial fast is from 6:00 am to 3:00 pm or from sun up to sundown. You can select from three types of fasting — a Full Fast, Daniel Fast or give up at least one item of food.
- **CORPORATE FAST:** A fast done with a body of believers.
- Fast from food, and (???) Thursday of each week for the month of February. Have Corporate Prayer every Thursday for the rest of the month.

Consecration part 2

Exodus 28:2 And thou shalt make holy garments for Aaron thy brother for glory and for beauty.³ And thou shalt speak unto all that are wise hearted, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Drawing Near

ISAIAH 58:6 "Is not this the fast that I have chosen to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?"

Mark 2:20 But the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days.



Consecration starts with anointing



Leviticus 8:30 And Moses took of the **anointing oil, and of the blood** which was upon the altar, and sprinkled it upon Aaron, and **upon his garments**, and upon his sons, and upon his sons' garments with him; and sanctified Aaron, and his garments, and his sons, and his sons' garments with him.

The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them Genesis 3:21

Genesis 35:2 Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that were with him, Put away the strange gods **that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments:**

Zechariah 3:4 And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

Zechariah 3:3 Now Joshua **was clothed with filthy garments,** and stood before the angel. 4 And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, **Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.**

The Consecrated Garments



Exodus 28:4 And these are the garments which they shall make; a **breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle**: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Ephesians 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Approaching Boaz



Ruth 3:1 ¶Then Naomi her mother in law said unto her, My daughter, shall I not seek rest for thee, that it may be well with thee?

2 And now is not Boaz of our kindred, with whose maidens thou wast? Behold, he winnoweth barley to night in the threshingfloor.

3 **Wash thyself therefore, and anoint thee, and put thy raiment upon thee,** and get thee down to the floor: but make not thyself known unto the man, until he shall have done eating and drinking.

Drawing near to the King



Esther 4:16 Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which is not according to the law: and if I perish, I perish.

Dressing for the King!



- Esther 5:1 ¶Now it came to pass on the third day, that **Esther put on her royal apparel, and stood in the inner court of the king's house**, over against the king's house: and the king sat upon his royal throne in the royal house, over against the gate of the house.
- 2 And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, that she obtained favour in his sight: **and the king held out to Esther the golden sceptre** that was in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the sceptre.

The undergarment is Truth!

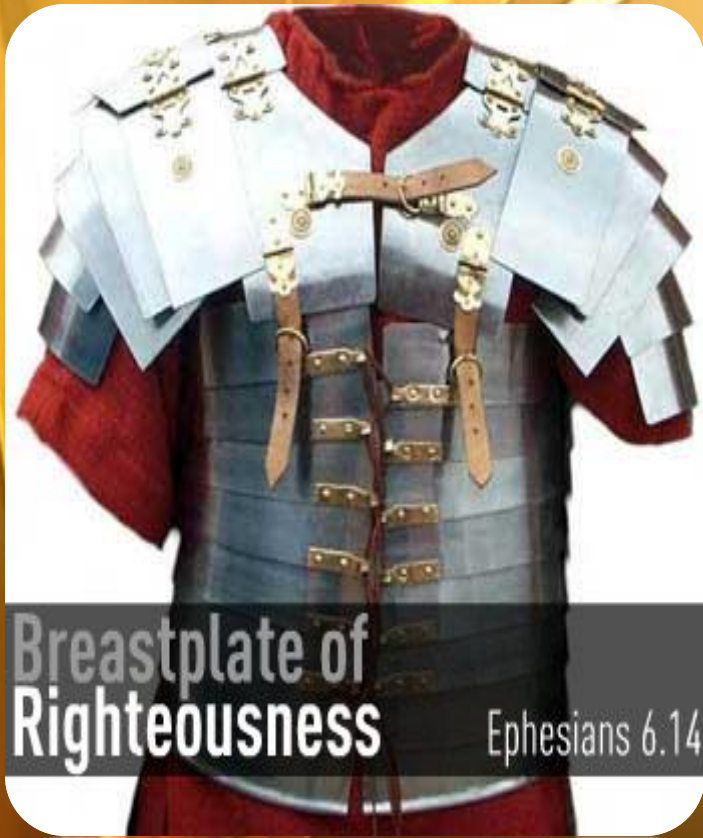


Ephesians 6:14 Stand therefore,

The Breastplate: His Righteousness



Romans 4:6 Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, **unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works,**

Philippians 3:9 ¶And be found in him, **not having mine own righteousness,** which is of the law, but that which is **through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:**

Hebrews 1:8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: **a scepter of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.**

The Oil of Anointing: The Spirit of Joy



- Psalms 45:7 Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee **with the oil of gladness(JOY)** above thy fellows.

8 All thy garments smell of myrrh, and aloes, and cassia, out of the ivory palaces, whereby they have made thee glad.

Matthew 6:17 But thou, when thou fastest, **anoint thine head**, and wash thy face; 18 That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.

The Consecrated Garments



Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, **the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness**; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
