

The first image




Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.


Naked, but not ashamed!



- Gen 2:23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.
- 24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- 25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

WHY ?

They could only “See Gods Glory”



- John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, **the glory as of the only begotten** of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- 1 Corinthians 11:7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as **he is the image and glory of God:** but the woman is the glory of the man.

The First Covering : *The Spirit of God*



- John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

The Second Covering: *Fig Leaves*



Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

Isaiah 30:1 ¶Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin:

The Fig leaves tried to cover the Body :But that was not enough!

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.



*Two Coverings were now required
One for the Body, & One for the soul!*

The Temporary Covering :Skin for the body

“Ore "is also Hebrew for : עור Skin


- Genesis 3:21 ¶Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.



The Temporary Covering: Blood for the Soul

ADAM: “The Red Man”,
“Ha DAM” The Blood

Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.



Life: Hebrew “Nephesh” Soul!

“Ore” : עור Skin

The Skin (Immune System) covered the
body

“Ha Dam” : דם Blood

the Blood was for the soul!

The Temporary Covering

- Leviticus 17:13 And whatsoever man there be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be eaten; **he shall even pour out the blood thereof, and cover it with dust.**
- 14 For it is the life of all flesh; the blood of it is for the life thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, **Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: for the life of all flesh is the blood** thereof: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off..



The Covering of perfection: The Glory of God



Exodus 40:34 ¶ Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and **the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.**

Ezekiel 1:27 And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about.


28 *As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD.*

- John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with **the glory which I had with thee** before the world was.

The Reflected Glory!



- Exodus 34:29 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that **Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.**
- Exodus 34:35 And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and **Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.**

The Direct Glory:




John 17:22 And the glory which thou gavest me **I have given them;** that they may be one, even as we are one:

Philippians 3:9 - And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:


What you can “see” is what you will be!

5 Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou?


6 This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground, as though he heard them not.

Romans 8:1 ¶There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
