The Nature Of God: Father of Lights

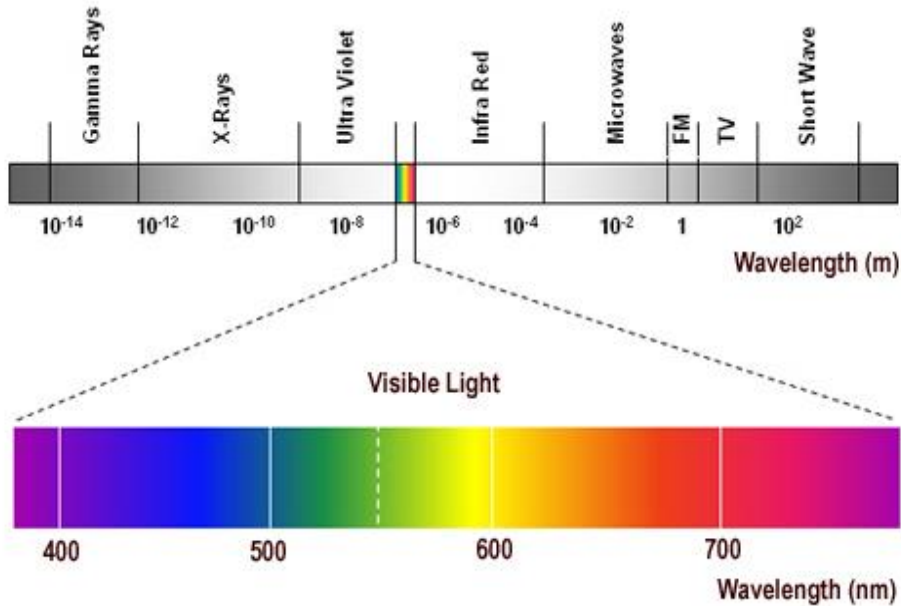


GOD IS

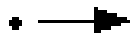
Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, **the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord**, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

The Creation of Flatland

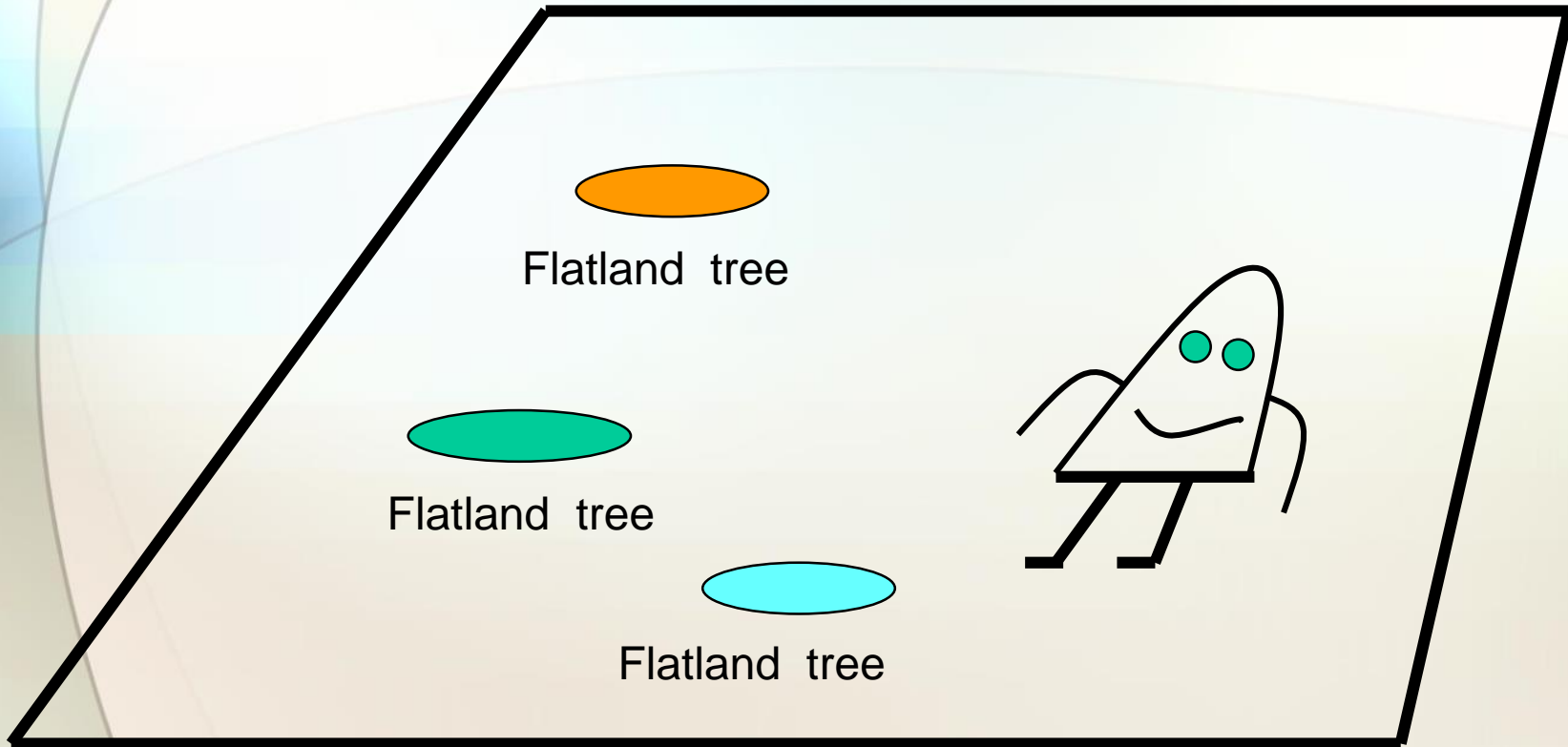


Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

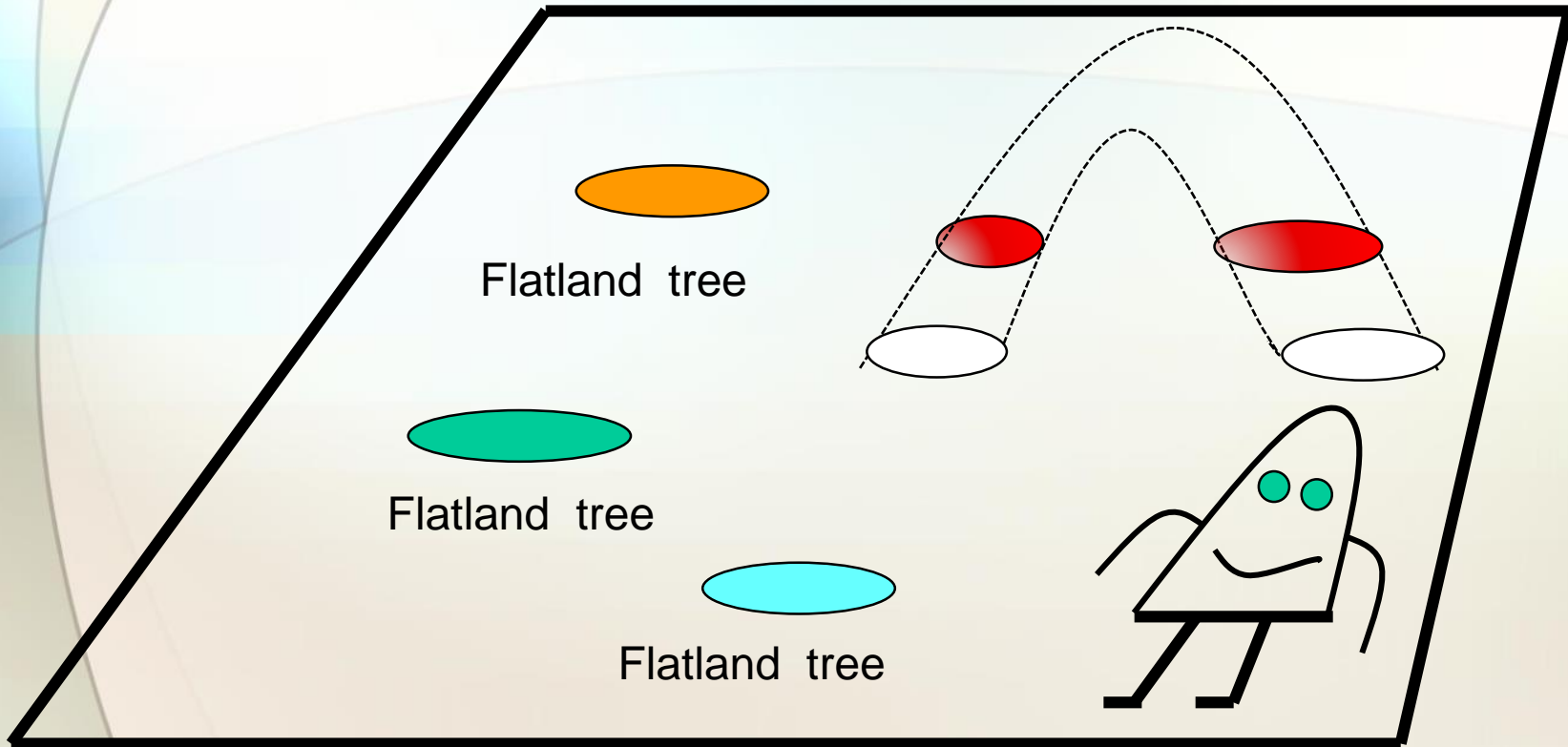
Garden Of Eden

Genesis 2:8 ¶And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

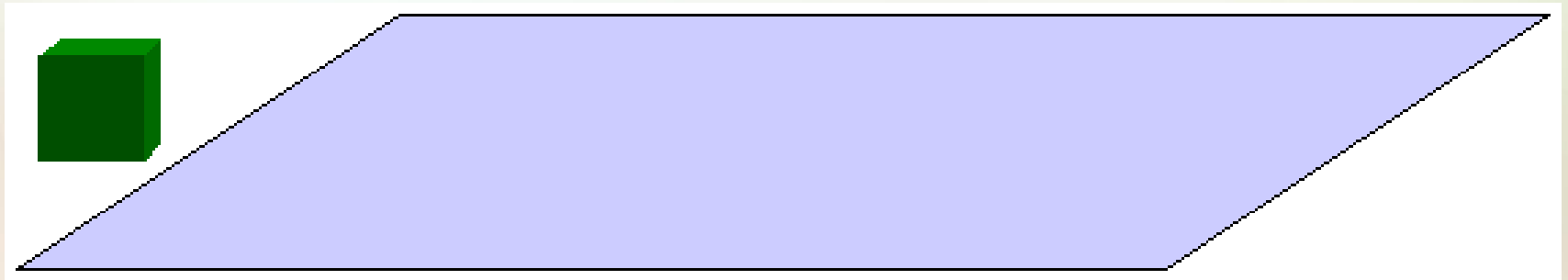


Garden Of Flatland(Eden)

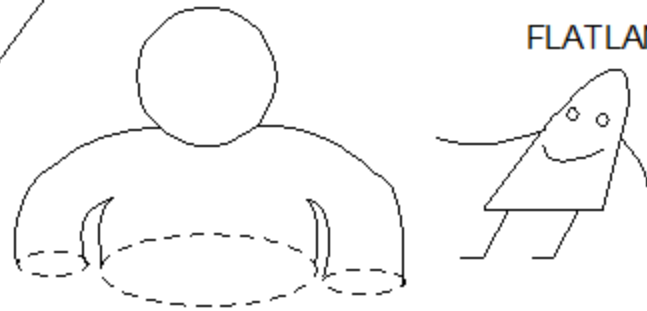

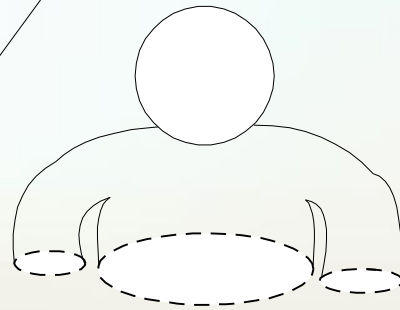

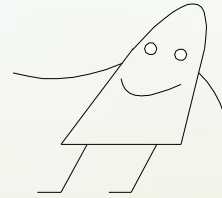

Who did Isaiah see ?



Isaiah 6:1 In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.

...Isaiah 6:3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, [is] the LORD of hosts: the whole earth [is] full of his **glory.**

Alpha and Omega first and last

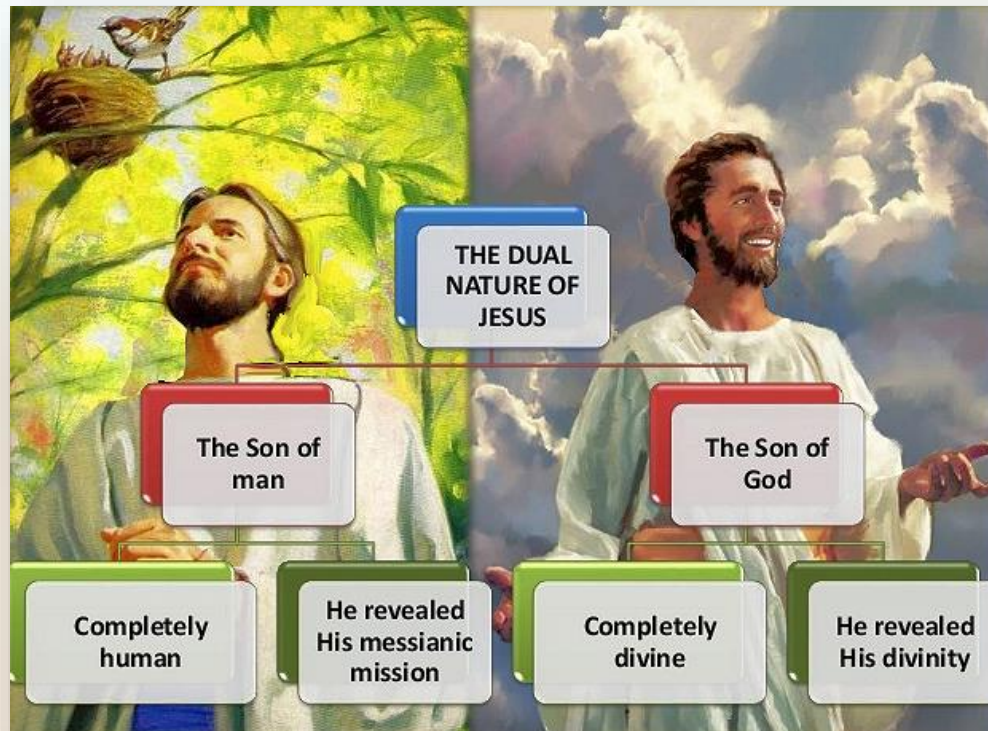
- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning **God created** the heaven and the earth.

Christ's dual nature

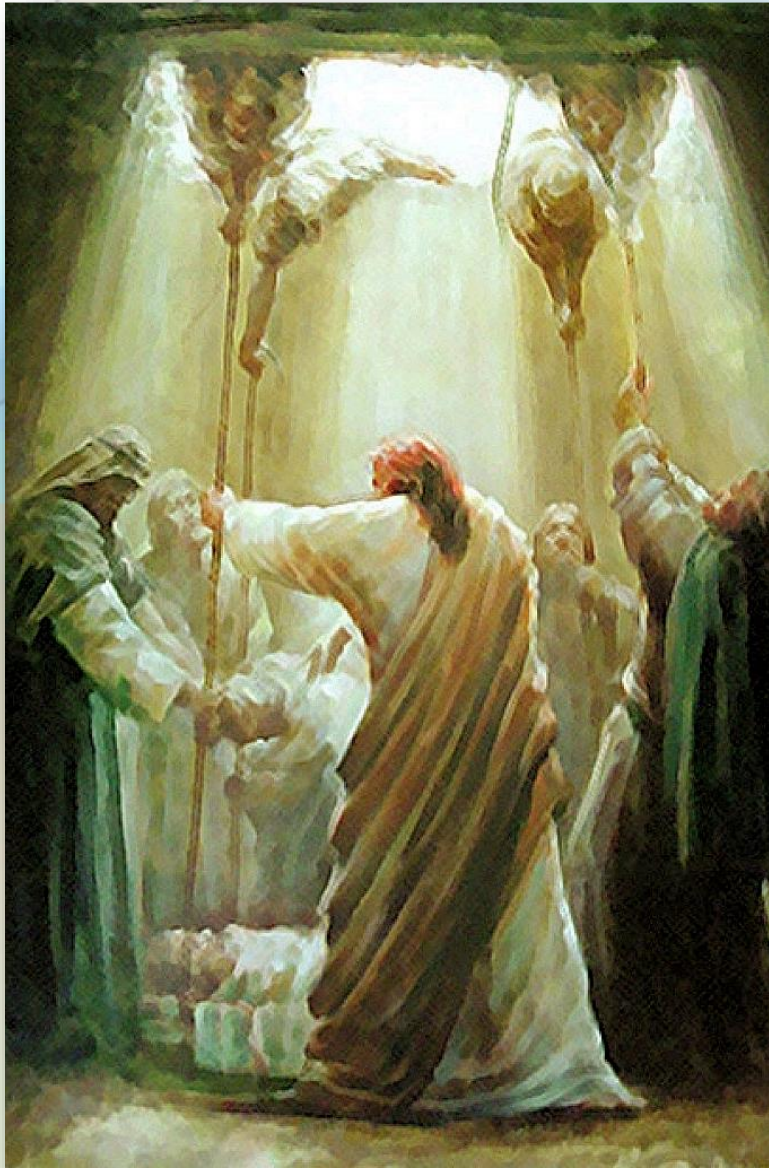
- Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as [we are, yet] without sin.



As man...

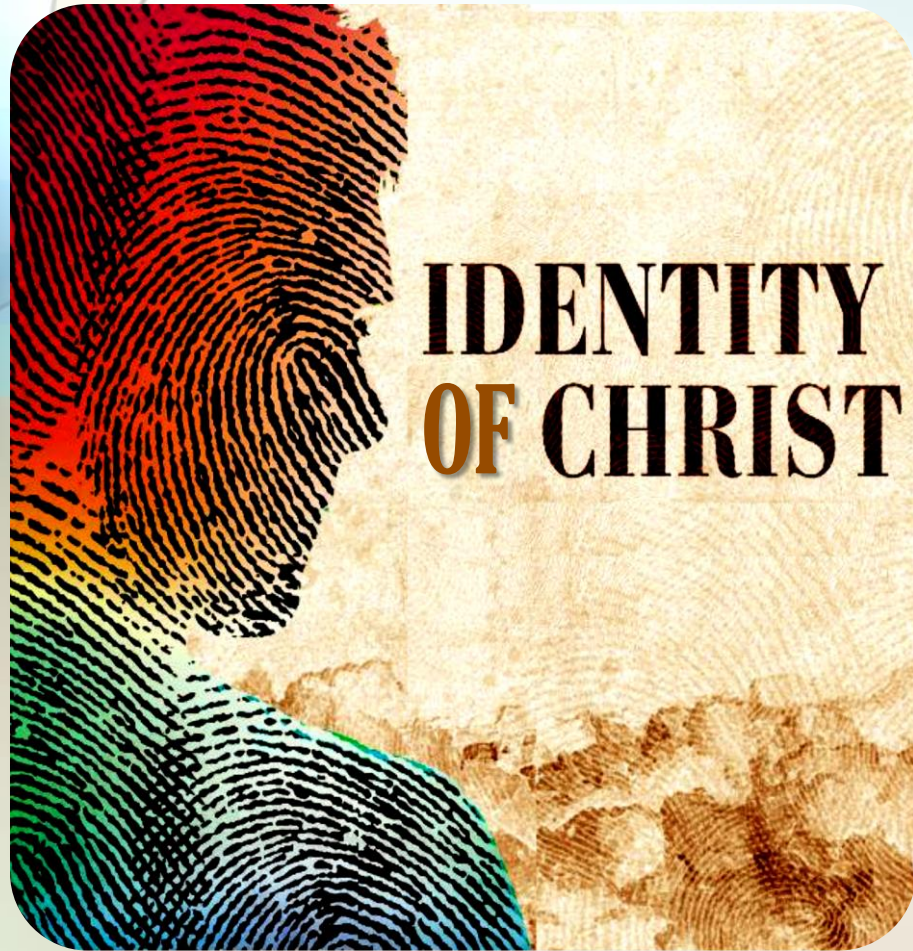
- Matthew 21:17 And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he lodged there.

The Mystery of The deity



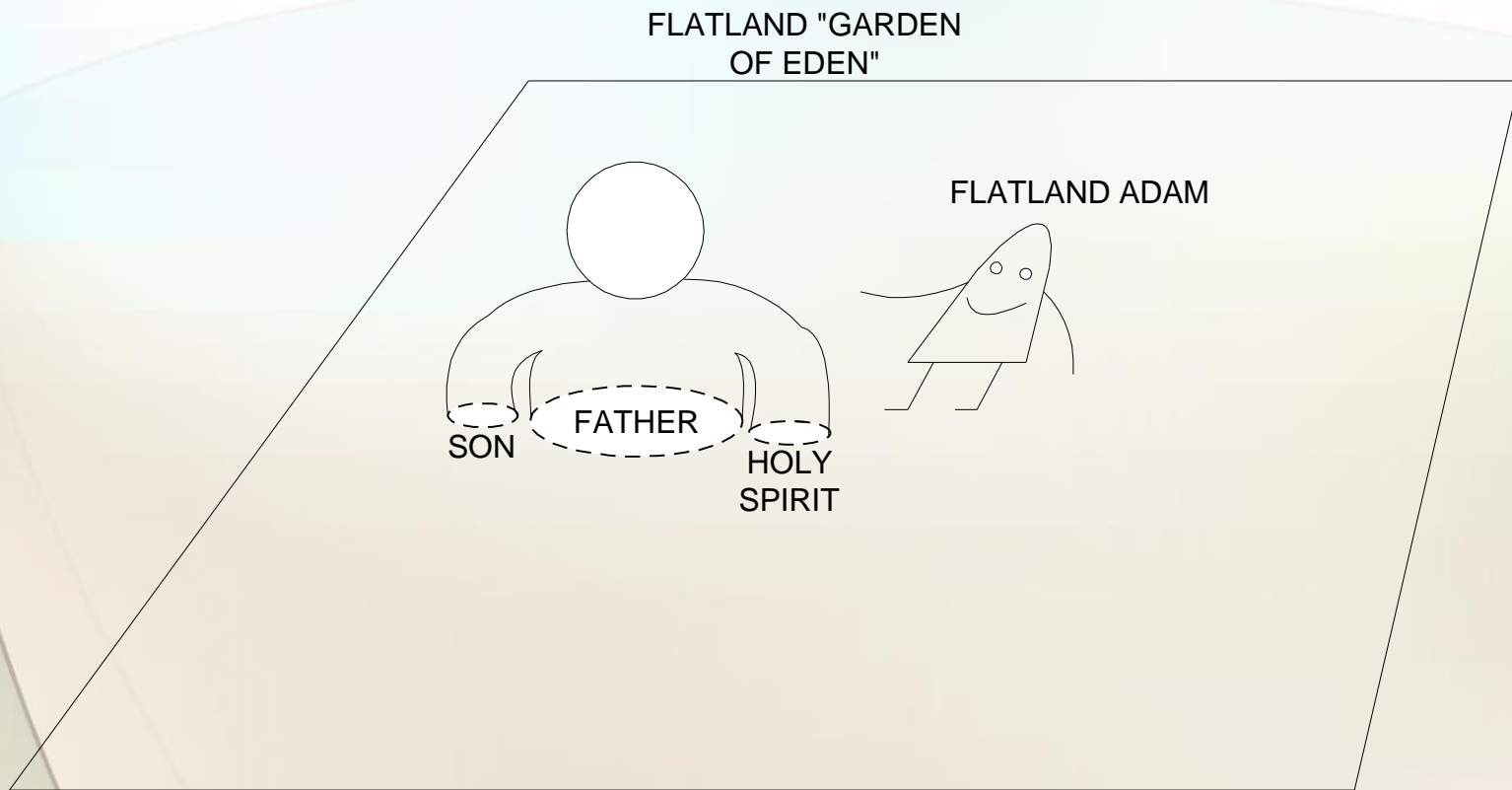
