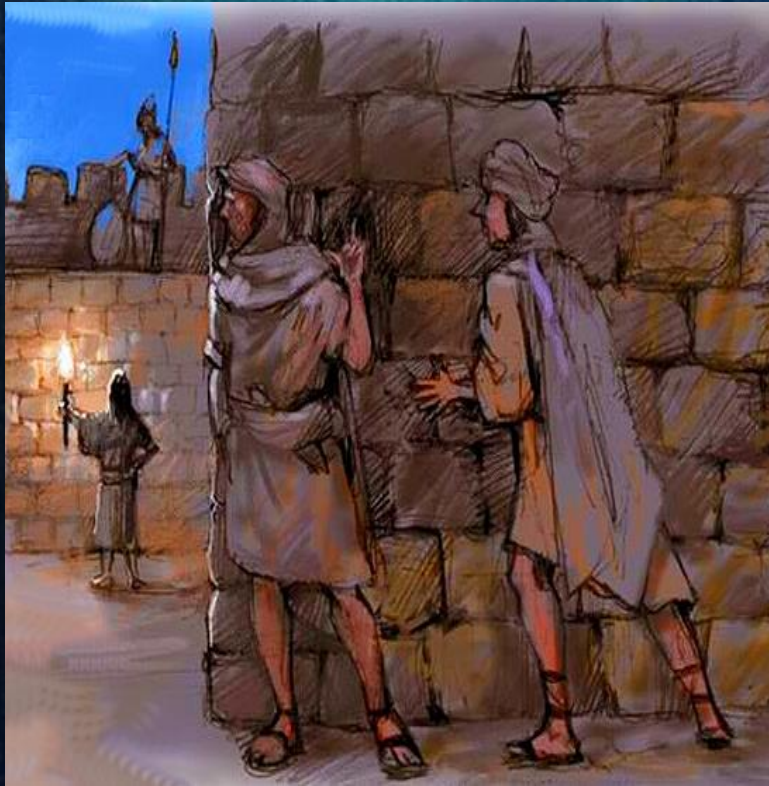
The Rapture I



1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: **and the dead in Christ shall rise first:** 17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

An Old Testament Model



- Joshua 2:1 ¶And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there.

- I have also spoken by the prophets, and I have multiplied visions, and **used similitudes**, by the ministry of the prophets.
- Hosea 12:10
- **Similitudes: “a likeness or model”**

Jericho “city of the moon God”

“Yerach” → Moon



"Stairway for the Gods," ziggurat of Ur dedicated to Sin, the moon-god,

- As a male deity, the moon was worshipped by the Sumerians and by the Semites in general. The moon-god was known as Sin among the eastern Semites and as Erah or Yerach in the "west." Throughout the Middle East the moon was regarded as a deity particularly in the Mesopotamian centers of Ur and Haran where Abraham the Patriarch spent its early years.

Joshua 5:13 ¶And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries?

13 While Joshua was near Jericho, he suddenly saw a man standing in front of him, holding a sword. Joshua went up to him and asked, "Are you one of our soldiers, or an enemy?" (*Good news translation*)



The day of Battle !

- 14 "Neither," he replied, "but as *commander of the army of the Lord I have now come.*" Then Joshua fell facedown to the ground in reverence, and asked him, "What message does my Lord have for his servant?" 15 *The commander of the Lord's army replied, "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy." And Joshua did*

Rachab: “wide, room”

- A gentile believer:
 - Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.
 - 10 For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.

The Two Spies/Witnesses

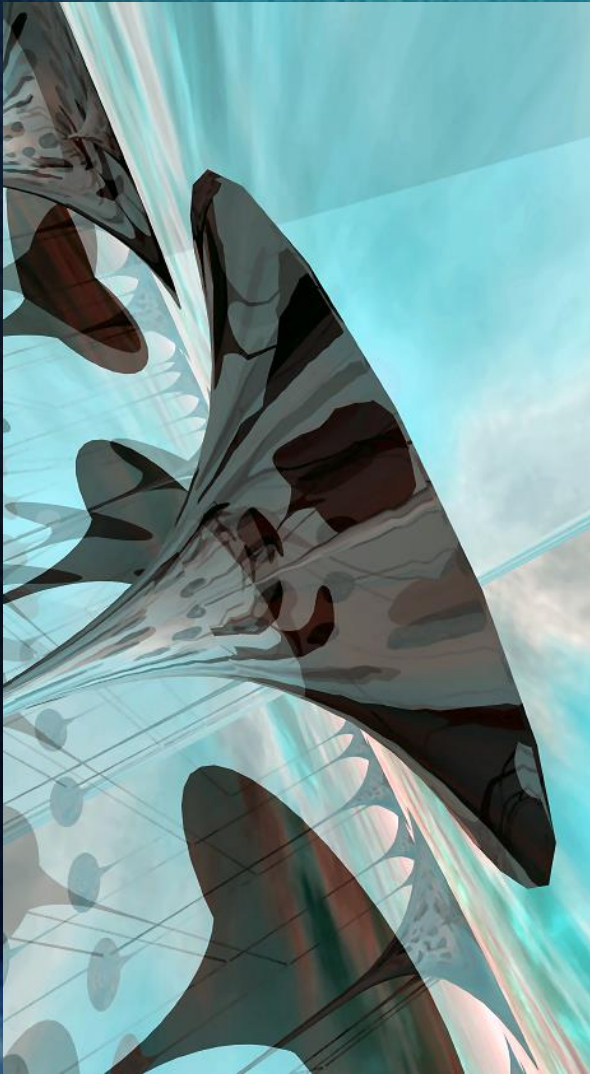
- Joshua 2:15 Then she let them down by a cord through the window: for her house was upon the town wall, and she dwelt upon the wall.
- 16 And she said unto them, Get you to the mountain, lest the pursuers meet you; and hide yourselves **there three days**, until the pursuers be returned: and afterward may ye go your way.
- Revelation 11:3 ¶And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall **prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

An Old Testament Model

- Deuteronomy 7:1 ¶When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, *seven nations greater and mightier than thou;*
- Revelation 13:1 ¶And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, *having seven heads* and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

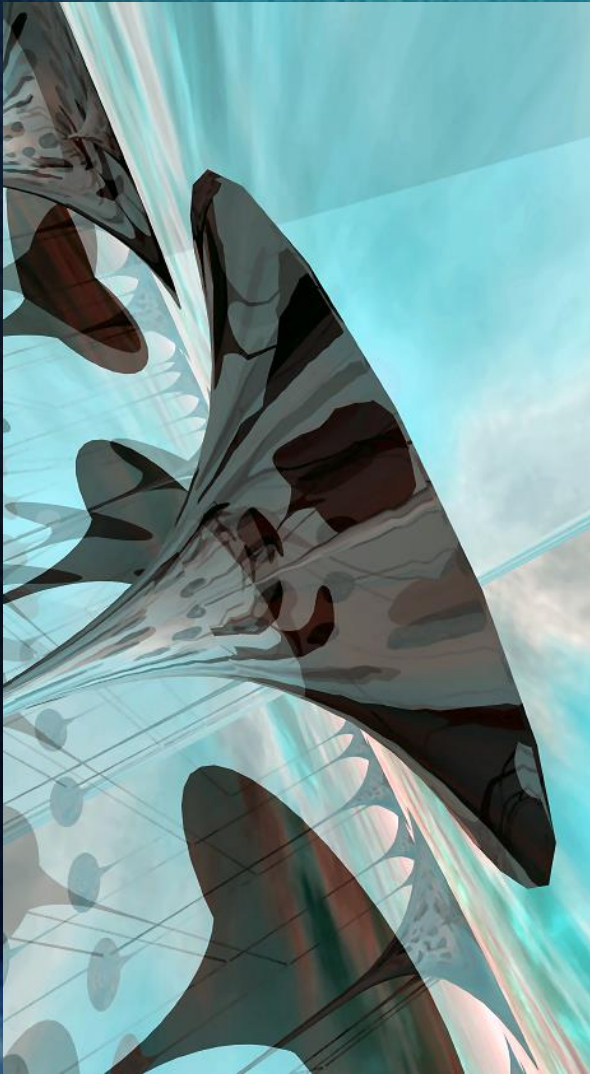


Silence in heaven



- Revelation 8:1 ¶ And when he had opened the seventh seal, *there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.*
- 2 And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were *given seven trumpets.*
- Joshua 6:10 And Joshua had commanded the people, saying, *Ye shall not shout, nor make any noise with your voice*, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout.

3 And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once. Thus shalt thou do six days.

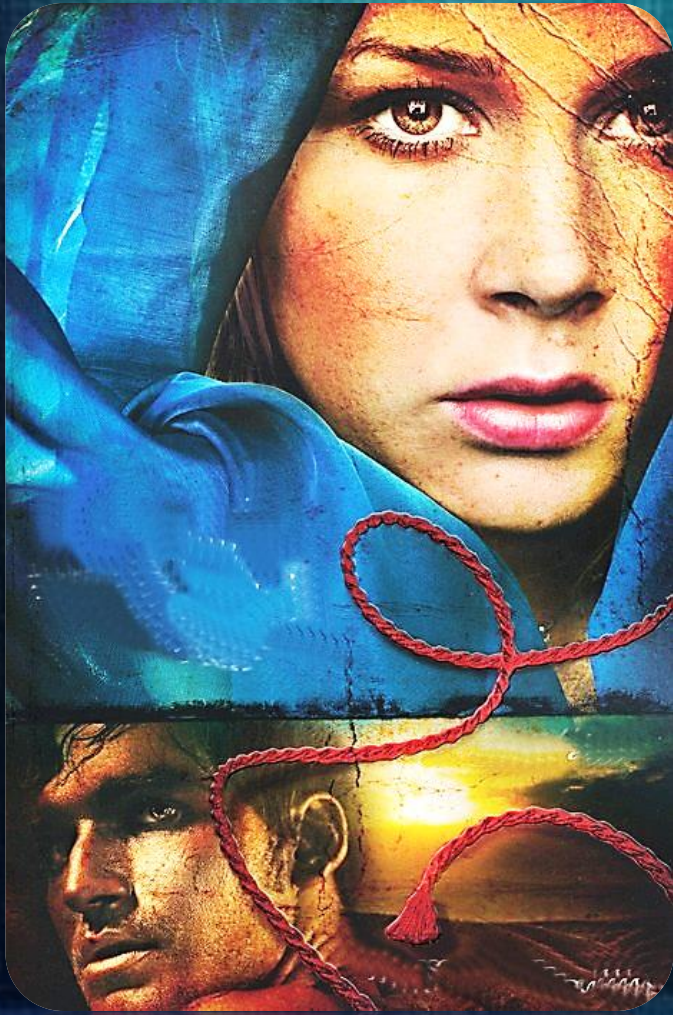

- 4 But thou shalt go unto my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife unto my son Isaac.

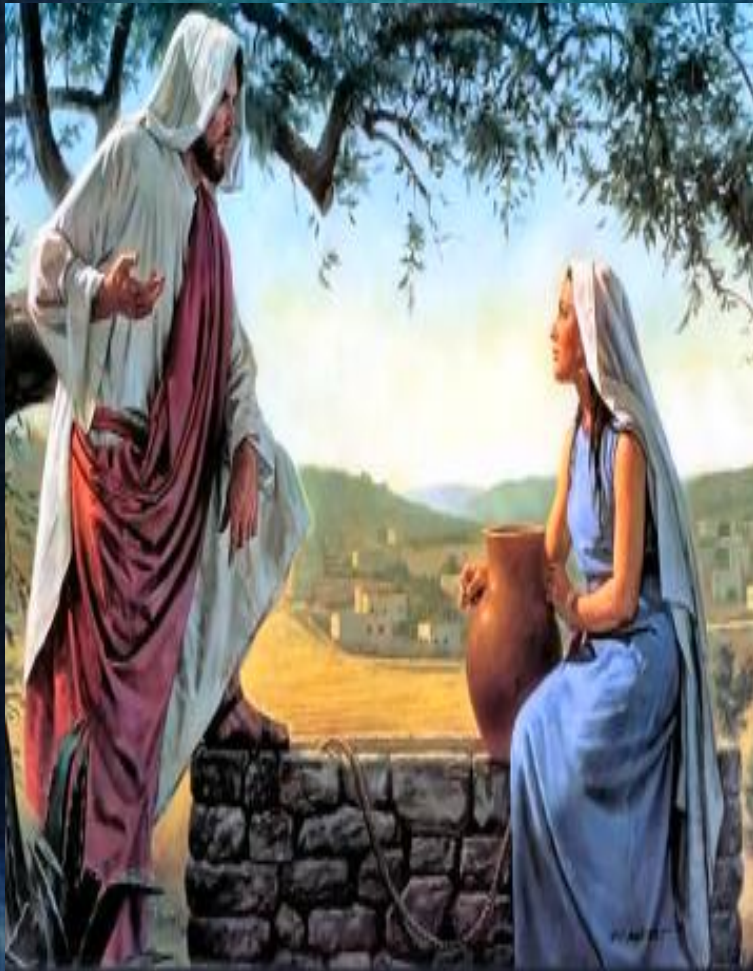
