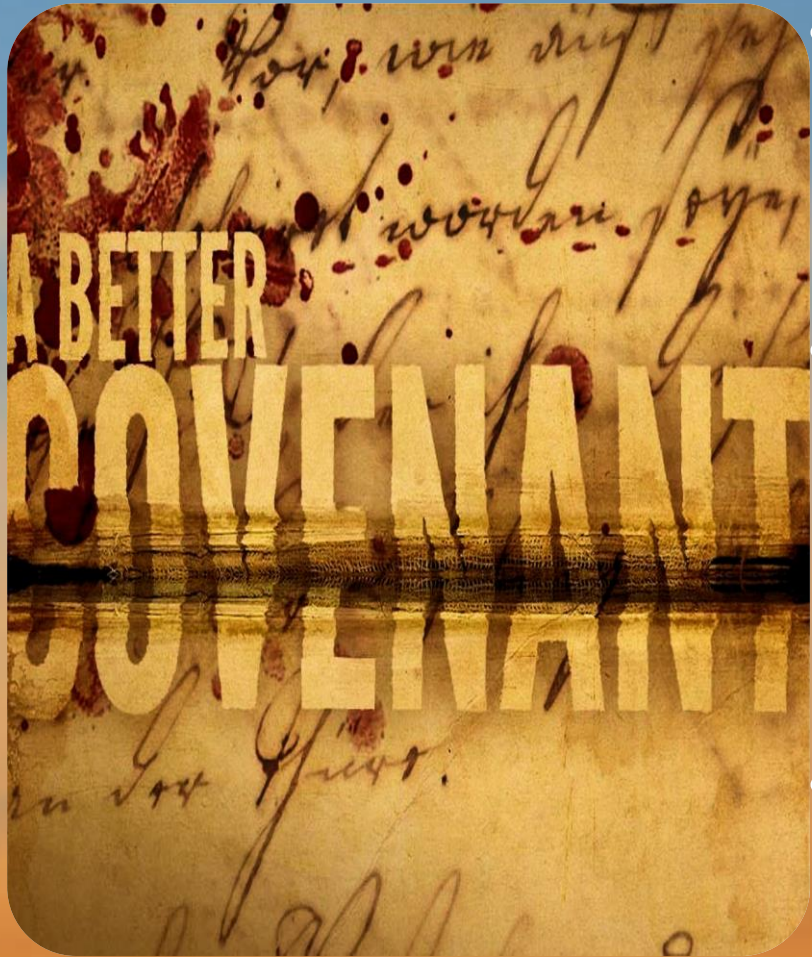


Part 3

Renewal

Isaiah 40:31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Renewal: By A New Covenant



- Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:
- 32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD:
- 33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Renewal: has to come from “the Inward parts” : The Heart!



- Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and **renew a right spirit within me.**
- 11 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
- 12 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit.

A Renewed Mind :What is it ?



Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed **by the renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

A renewed mind looks at things differently

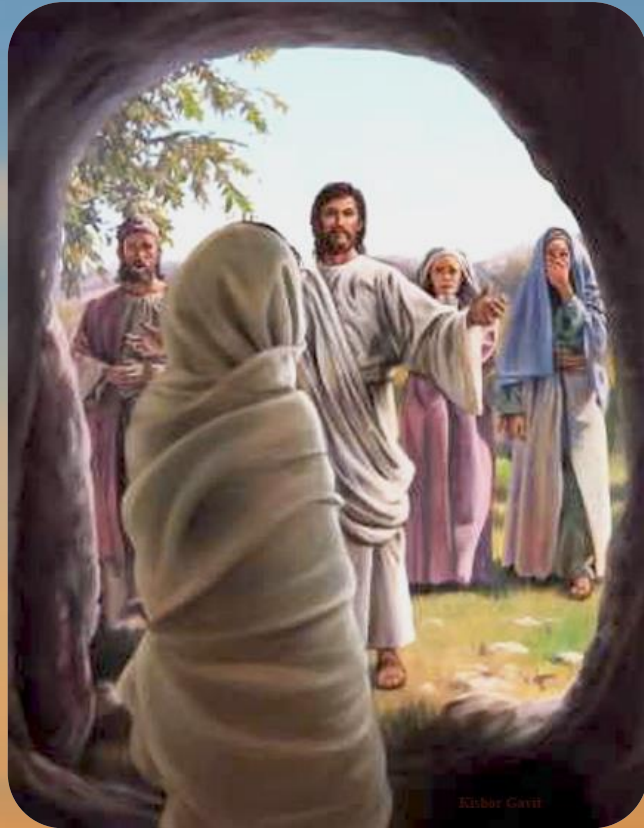
1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: **for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus** concerning you.

Renewed Mind: Transformation



- John 11:1 ¶ Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.
- 2 (It was that Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.)
- 3 Therefore his sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom thou lovest is sick.
- 4 When Jesus heard that, he said, **This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God,** that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.

A renewed mind:



John 11:5 Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus.

6 When he had heard therefore that he was sick, he abode two days **still in the same place where he was.**


John 11:11 These things said he: and after that he saith unto them, **Our friend Lazarus sleepeth;** but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.

12 Then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well.

13 Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep.

14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead.

- 11 If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.
- **12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect:** but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

- 2 Corinthians 5:17

- Therefore **if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature:** old things are passed away; behold, **all things** are become new.
- Lamentations 3:22 It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.
- 23 **They are new every morning:** great is thy faithfulness.

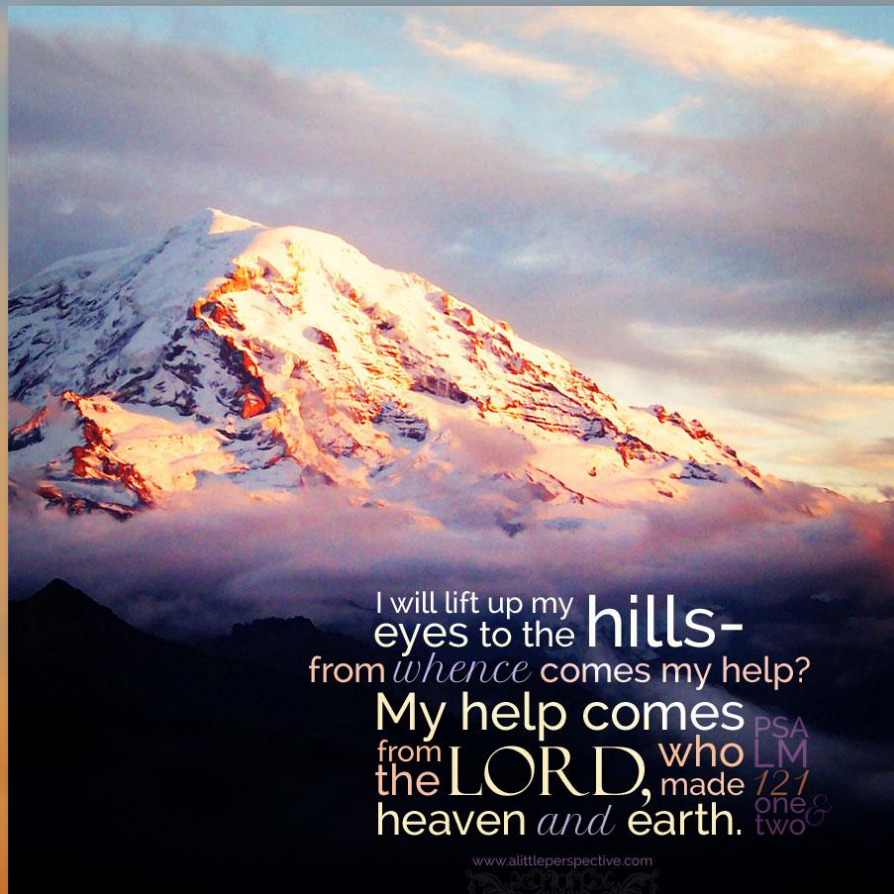
Renewed in Spirit



Sometimes God does not change your situation because He wants to change your heart.

- Ezekiel 36:26 **A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you:** and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- 27 And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

Renewed : A New heaven and a New Earth



- Revelation 21:1 ¶ And **I saw a new heaven and a new earth**: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.
- 2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
- 3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.
- 4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.
- 5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.
