


A Most Evil King



- 2 Chronicles 33:1 ¶Manasseh was twelve years old when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and five years in Jerusalem:



Disobedience brings Judgment




- Chronicles 33:10 And the LORD spake to Manasseh, and to his people: but they would not hearken.

2 Kings 22:11 ¶And it came to pass, when the king had heard the words of the book of the law, that he rent his clothes.




True Repentance brings Revival


Godly Sorrow



Psalms 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.


2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.
