Yom kippurim: The day of Atonements



Leviticus 16:21 And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all.



Leviticus 16:29

¶ And this shall be a statute for ever unto you: that in **the seventh month, on the tenth day** of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, whether it be one of your own country,

or a stranger that sojourneth among you:30 For **on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD.** 31 It shall be a sabbath of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever.

The Fourth Appointment: Pentecost!

Redemption of the Soul!



- 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also **sealed us**, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, **ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise**,
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby **ye are sealed unto the day of redemption**.

The purpose of the “At onement ceremony”

19 The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of God to be revealed. 20 For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope

21 that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the glorious freedom of the children of God.

22 We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.

23 Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption as sons, the **redemption of our bodies.**

The Redemption of the Body!

Body Soul and Covering Spirit



- The Son of man is born just a body and soul
- Then God Gives his covering Spirit
- But we still have a problem. The Flesh
- The atonement ceremony represents death !
- The separation of the body from the soul for the purpose of fixing the problem
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of **soul(Psuche)** and **spirit(Pneuma)**, and of the **joints and marrow(Body)**, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Revelation 4:1 ¶ After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and **I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.**

The Clues



- Exodus 30:10 And Aaron shall make an atonement upon the horns of it **once in a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonements:** once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD.

Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

The Clues



- Revelation 8:3 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints **upon the golden altar which was before the throne.** 7 ¶The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and **fire mingled with blood,** and they were cast upon the earth.....

The Clues



- Revelation 5:6 ¶ And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns** and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Azazel (Hebrew: עֲזָזֵל, *Azazel*, Aramaic: רמסנאל, *[citation needed]* Arabic: عزازيل *Azazil*) is the enigmatic name of a character in Hebrew mythology found in the Hebrew scriptures and Apocrypha. The word's first appearance is in [Leviticus 16](#), where a goat is designated "for Azazel" and outcast in the desert as part of [Yom Kippur](#).

He is considered by many to be a supernatural being mentioned in connection with the ritual of the [Day of Atonement](#) (Lev. xvi.).

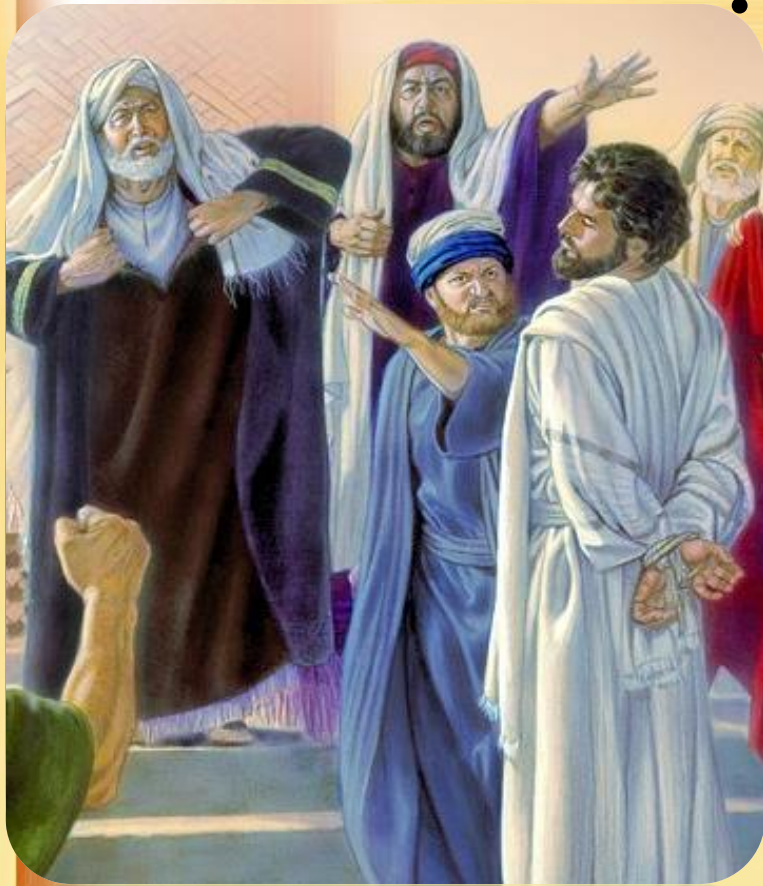
The Atonement Ceremony

The Fulfilment of the Ceremony



John 1:29 ¶The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

- John 11:49 And one of them, named Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year, said unto them, Ye know nothing at all,

50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, **that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.**

51 And this spake he not of himself: but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation;

52 And not for that nation only, but that also he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad.

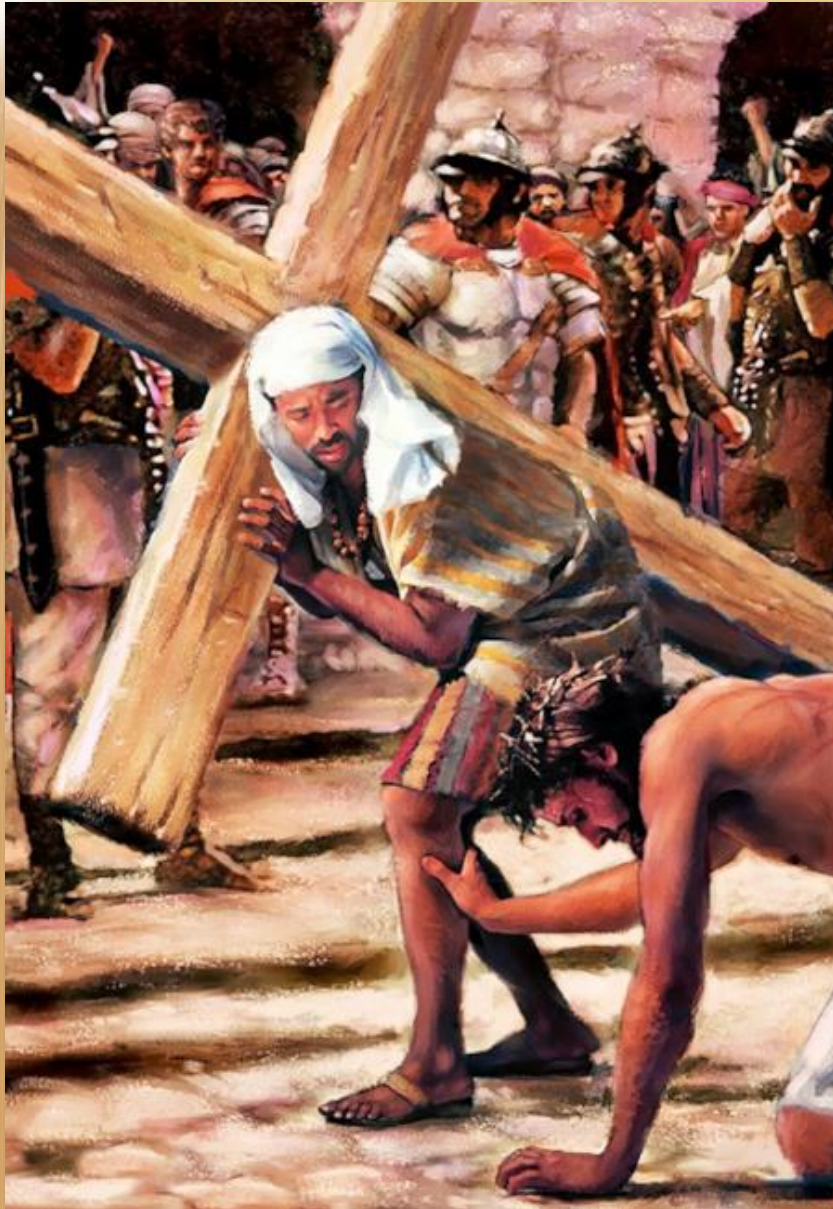
Isaiah 53:10 ¶Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: **when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin,**
