
The Harvest part 3

The Symbolic Trees of Israel

- The Vine: Symbol of Israel's Spiritual Privileges
 - Psalms 80:8 ¶Thou hast brought a *vine* out of Egypt: thou hast cast out the heathen, and planted it.
- The Olive: Symbol of Israel's Religious Privileges
 - Psalms 52:8 But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.
- The Fig Tree: Symbol of Israel's National Privileges
 - Song of Songs 2:13 The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines with the tender grape give a good smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

As soon as the Jews settled in the Holy Land, they began to count and observe seven-year cycles. Every cycle would culminate in a Sabbatical year, known as Shmita, literally: "to release."

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The year following the destruction of the second Holy Temple was the first year of a seven-year Sabbatical cycle. In the Jewish calendar, counting from

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The Seven Year count mid point is right in the middle of the 50/70 year sequence31/2 years!

Creation, this was the year 3829, 68–69 CE on the secular calendar. By counting sevens from then, we see that the start of the current Shmita cycle was 5775 after Creation, which runs from Sept. 25, 2014, through Sept. 13, 2015.


