




Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:



- 6 That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.
- 7 For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

Doctrine, Traditions, & Guidelines

- *Traditions: Outward works, Justify us before men*
- *Faith: A sincere heart , justifies us before God*

Categories of teaching

- **Doctrine : Unchangeable Salvation Requirements**
 - Repentance, Baptism of water and spirit, Walking on in holiness to conform to the image of Christ.
- **Traditions(culture): Some good, Some bad**
 - Those that minister to the salvation of people who are weaker in faith so that our witness may be justified before men
- **Guidelines: As taught by the pastor**
 - Ordinances consistent with a Christian witness and to increase the respect and witness of the church in the community

So why do different pastors have different “ordinances”

- Why are there so many different denominations ? Even that believe the same salvation message?
- 1 Corinthians 12:5 And there are *differences of administrations*, but the same Lord.

Pastors guidelines for the Platform

- Goal to be an example and promote a positive appearance to visitors and to project leadership
- ***Men: Dress, business casual:***
 - Ties or turtleneck if you are going to speak
 - No Jeans, No piercings, Modest apparel, No long hair No chains, or visible necklaces. No dyeing of hair in unnatural colors, No makeup except for medical purposes (No makeup that draws attention, unnatural lip color etc)

Pastors Guidelines for the Platform

- Goal to be an example and promote a positive appearance to visitors and to project leadership
- ***Women: Dress, business casual:***
 - Skirts or dresses, that when seated , still cover below the knee.
 - Slits must not come above the knee, No cleavage, sleeves to at least the mid elbow. No transparent tops,
 - no nose rings or lip or brow piercings. Modest apparel, No dyeing of hair in unnatural colors, No makeup that draws undue attention, unnatural lip colors, extravagant rouged cheeks etc

Expectations of Leadership

- Baptized in Jesus name
- Filled with the Holy Ghost
- Faithful in attendance Punctual – at least 15 min before service
- Tithing – 10%
- Consecrated walk of prayer and fasting
- No smoking
- No drunkenness
- Modest clothing on and off platform
- Attend events/ support church activities
- Attend scheduled leadership meetings with pastor



Accountability: When does Grace apply?



- Knowledge : do we know what we are doing ?
- **Deuteronomy 1:39** Moreover your little ones, which ye said should be a prey, and your children, which in that day had no knowledge between good and evil, **they shall go in thither, and unto them will I give it, and they shall possess it.**

Accountability: When does Grace apply?



Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; **for they know not what they do.** And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

Accountability: When does Grace apply?



- Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

The two me's

Romans 18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find. 19 For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but the evil I will not to do, that I practice.

The Mind



- Romans 7:21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.
- **22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:**
- 23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

Do We Have Moral Choices?



John 8:3 And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,

4 They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act.

5 Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou?

John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and **sin no more.**

YES: And for those we are accountable!

Sins that involve knowledge and premeditation

THE MIND

GRACE

does not cover without confession &

True repentance!

Romans 6: 12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. 13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Grace covers our failures: Not cop outs!



You can only fail if you have fought, struggled!


1 Corinthians 9:27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

Sanctification Separation

- Ezekiel 22:26 Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.
- Ezekiel 44:23 And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

Sanctification is also a Choice!



1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.



- Being his disciples and witnessing


Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

The Blessing comes after Sanctification
