The death of the spirit was immediate


 The death of the body was next

What is Our Salvation?

Three parts

- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 ¶And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 24 Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.



What is our Salvation



- Cleansing of Sins (Baptism)
 - Acts 22:16 And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
- Sealing of the Soul (Receiving the Holy Spirit)
 - 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- Redemption of the Body (Receiving a glorified body)
 - 1 Corinthians 15:51 ¶Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

God did not want to save the current body!

- Genesis 3:22 ¶And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:
- Romans 8:10 ¶...... the body is dead because of sin
- Romans 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.
- Romans 7:24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

But He does want to preserve it And keep it holy



Baptism with TRUE Repentance, Washes away all SINS!

- Acts 22:16 And now why tarriest(wait) thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
- It symbolises the death of the body....with death.....Taking away our sins!
- Colossians 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

What is our Salvation: Baptism, cleansing of the body




What is Salvation: Saving of the Soul!



A New Creation!

- The redemption project for the soul. The most important part of the original three part nature of man. At the appointed time God would take that soul and through a rebirthing process, make a new creation!
- Romans 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.
- 20 For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,

Leviticus 16:15 ¶Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat: Leviticus 16:21 And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of

the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: 22 And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.

What is Our Salvation: A new body!

- Philippians 3:21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 15:51 ¶Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
