




# Rapture will not come before the rebellion



- Leviticus 23:4 ¶These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.



Jesus Crucified "The Lamb of God"




John 1:29 ¶The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.
