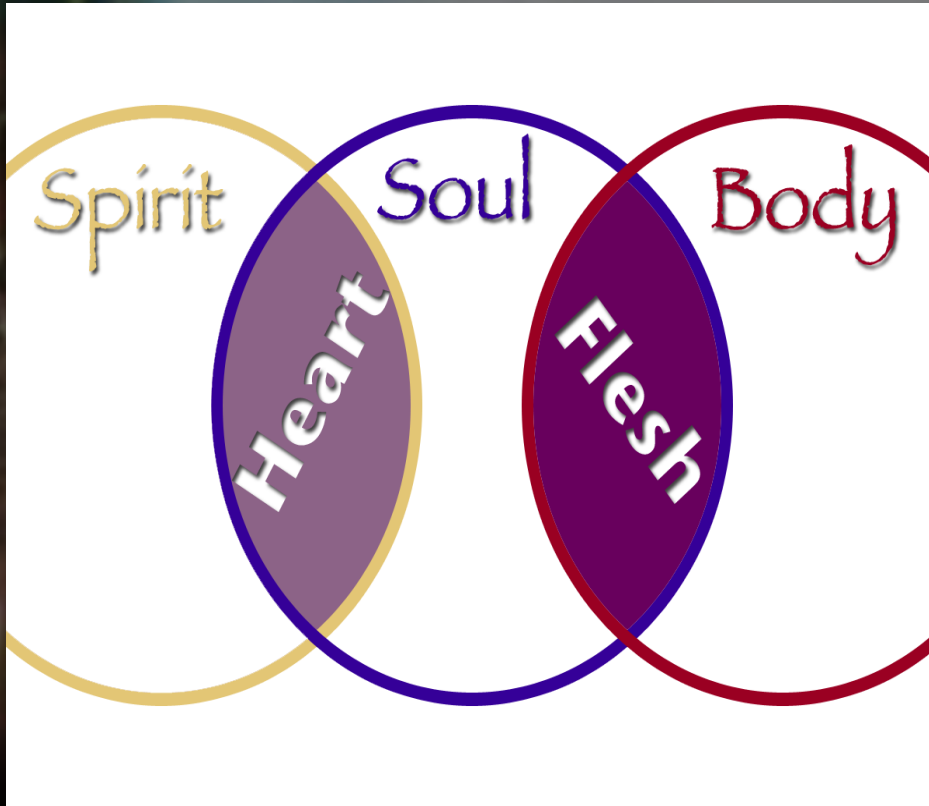

# Covered from Accusation

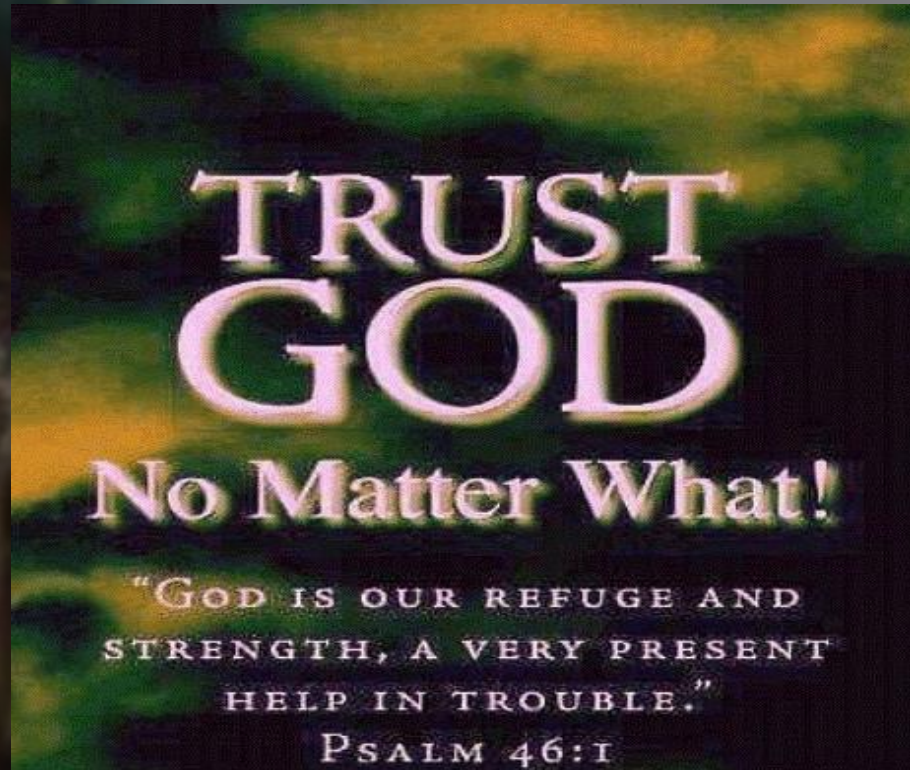


- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 ¶ And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be **preserved blameless** unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 24 Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.

# Covered During Trouble

# Covered from spiritual attack

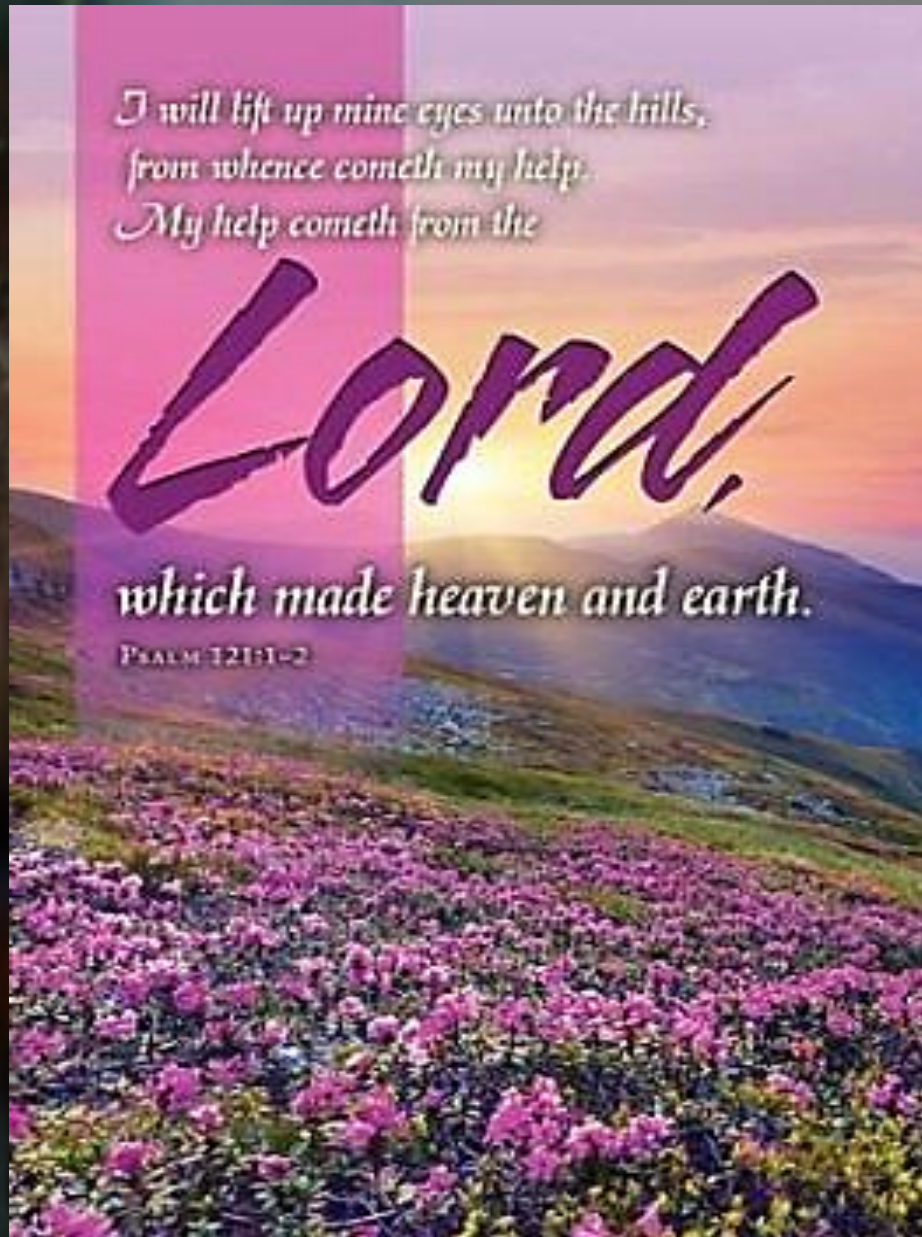


- John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- 28 And I give unto them eternal life; and **they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.**
- 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.



# Covered from fear



- Psalm 121:1 I lift up my eyes to the mountains— where does my help come from? 2 My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth. 3 He will not let your foot slip—he who watches over you will not slumber; 4 indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. 5 The LORD watches over you—the LORD is your shade at your right hand; 6 the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. 7 The LORD will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life; 8 the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.



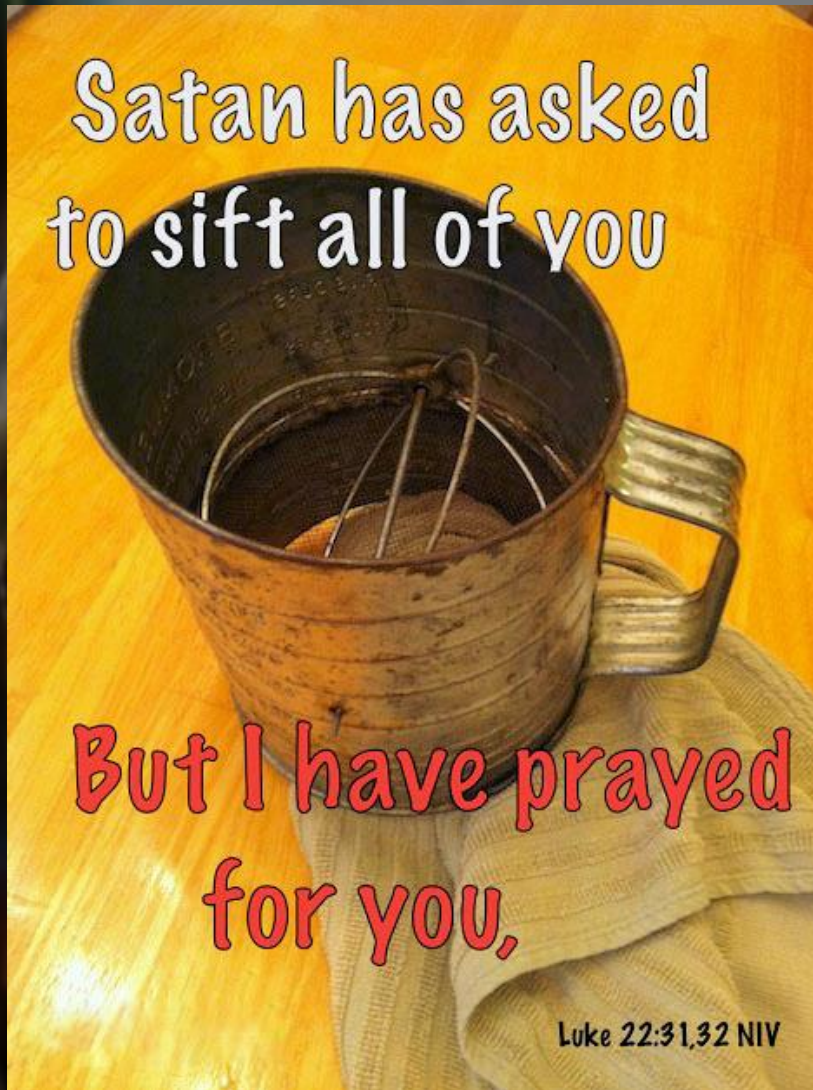
# Covered from Weakness



- 2 Corinthians 12:9 But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. 10 That is why, for Christ’s sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.



# Covered from loss of faith



- 2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. 17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. 18 So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.



# Covered by Grace



- 1 Peter 5:7
- Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. 8 Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. 9 Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings. 10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.



# Covered by his love



- 1 John 4:7 ¶ Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.
- 8 He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.
- 9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.
- 10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
- 11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.
- 12 No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

# The Body is Dead!



1 Peter 2:11 Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

- Romans 7:23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and **bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.**
- 24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

- Hebrews 2:14 ¶Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy **him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;**

## He now wants your Soul!



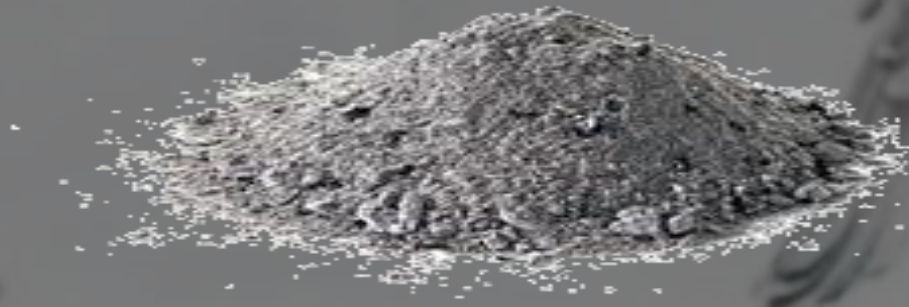
- Of his original threefold nature that he had been created with, **Only the soul remained his!**
- 
- Romans 7:22 For I delight in the law of God **after the inward man:**
- Ephesians 3:16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by **his Spirit in the inner man;**

- While the body still lived, The soul could remain. Once the body died it could not stay in the physical realm, it had to go to the place of the grave.



# The body needs to die!

- Genesis 3:19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: **for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.**



Romans 6:4 Therefore **we are buried with him by baptism into death**: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

# No naked soul can enter heaven

*Revelation 21:27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.*

- Revelation 3:17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, **and naked:**
- Isaiah 30:1 ¶Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that **cover with a covering, but not of my spirit**, that they may add sin to sin:
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby **ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.**  
**Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement(COVERING) for the soul.**

# The Three reasons for his death

- To Release the Prisoners. (Take back the Kingdom of the grave)
  - Isaiah 14:17 That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners?
  - Isaiah 61:1 ¶The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;



# The Three reasons for his death

- **To Give his blood as the temporary covering**

- Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
- Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
- Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
- 15 ¶ And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.



# The Three reasons for his death

- To Give his spirit as the permanent covering

- Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
- Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.
- Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
