






# Becoming Part of the Body





- 1 Corinthians 12:13 For **by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body**, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.
- Galatians 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ **have put on Christ**.
- 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.





# Building the Body: Apostles



2 Corinthians 12:12 Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.

## Personal commission

- 1 Corinthians 9:1 ¶Am I not an apostle? am I not free? ***have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord?*** are not ye my work in the Lord?
- 1 Paul, an apostle--***sent not from men nor by man, but by Jesus Christ*** and God the Father, who raised him from the dead-- NIV
- Luke 6:13 And when it was day, he called unto him his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, ***whom also HE named apostles;***

# Building the Body: Prophets



- Acts 11:26 And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.
- 27 ¶ And in these days came prophets from Jerusalem unto Antioch.
- 28 And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.
- 29 Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea:
- 30 Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

# Building the Body: Prophet, A Spirit commission!



PROPHECY IS FOR

- EDIFICATION
- EXHORTATION
- COMFORT

- 1 Corinthians 14:1 ¶ Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy.
- 2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.
- 3 But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to **edification, and exhortation, and comfort.**
- 4 He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.

# Building the Body: Prophets



*But he that prophesieth  
speaketh unto men to edification,  
and exhortation, and comfort.  
1 Corinthians 14:3 KJV*

- 1 Corinthians 14:5 I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, **that the church may receive edifying.**
- 6 ¶ Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?
