



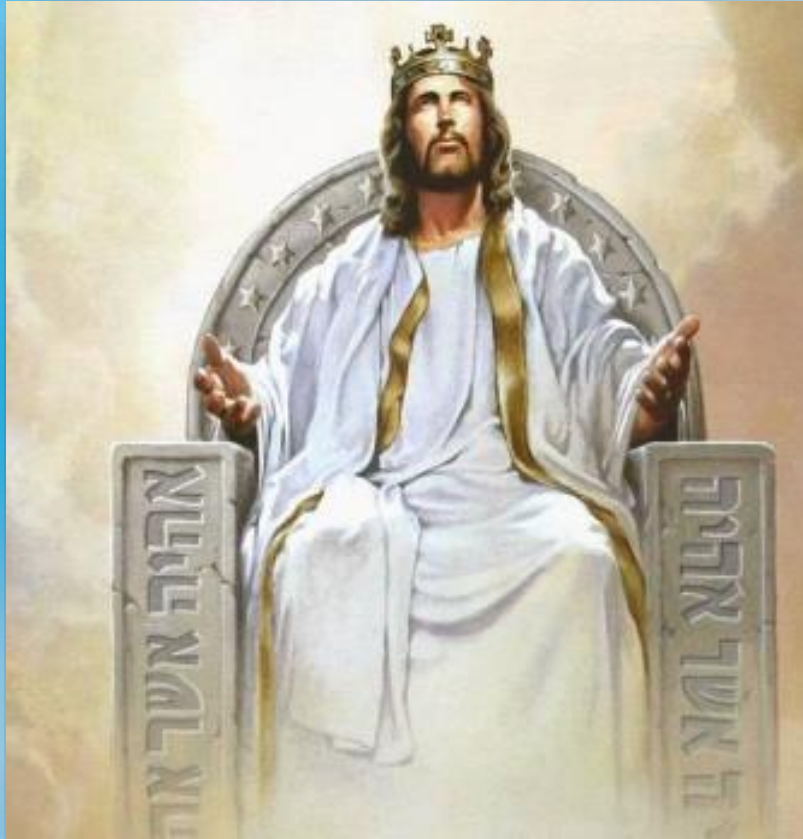

# The Sovereignty Of God & the Dominion of Man



John 5:27 And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, **because he is the Son of man.**

# Channels Of Action



- **As Son:** Whenever man acted within the covenant, God limited himself to the same delegated power he had given Adam the first son of God (because the covenant was with him).
- **As God:** Whenever man went outside the covenant(broke the covenant) **God was not limited by the covenant.**

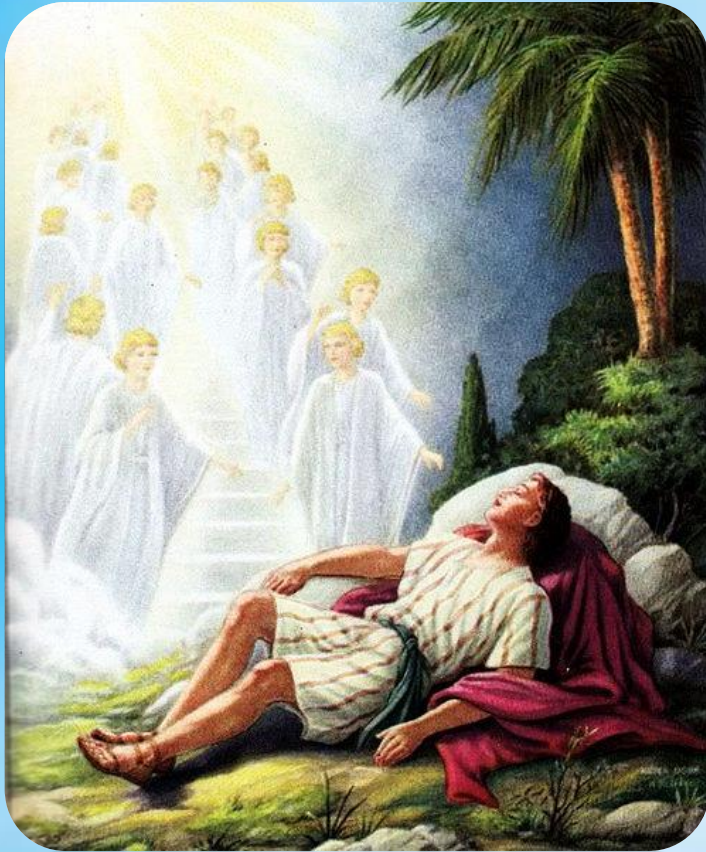
# The Powers of the Son under the Covenant!

Healed all diseases Matthew 9:35	<b>Dominion over the body.</b>
Cast out demons Luke 8:2	<b>Dominion over every creature.</b>
Knew their present thoughts Matthew 12:25	<b>Dominion of Knowledge.</b>

# Jacob receives a covenant



Genesis 28:10 ¶And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran.

11 And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep.

12 And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it.

13 And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

14 And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

15 And, behold, I am with thee, and will keep thee in all places whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done that which I have spoken to thee of.

16 ¶And Jacob awaked out of his sleep, and he said, Surely the LORD is in this place; and I knew it not.

# So Jacob has dominion!



Genesis 32:24 ¶And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day. **25 And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh;** and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him. 26 And he said, Let me go, for the day breaketh. And he said, I will not let thee go, except thou bless me. 27 And he said unto him, What is thy name? And he said, Jacob. 28 And he said, **Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.** 29 And Jacob asked him, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, thy name. And he said, Wherefore is it that thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there. 30 And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved.



# Israel Returns Dominion



Exodus 24:3 And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, **All the words which the LORD hath said will we do.**

7 And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, **All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient.**

8 And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

Luke 14:26 If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.

Luke 14:27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

Luke 14:33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.



# Sovereignty as God under the covenant

Ezekiel 16:8 Then I passed by you and saw you, and behold, you were at the time for love; so I spread My skirt (Covering) over you and covered your nakedness I also swore to you and entered into a covenant with you so that **you became Mine**, declares the Lord GOD

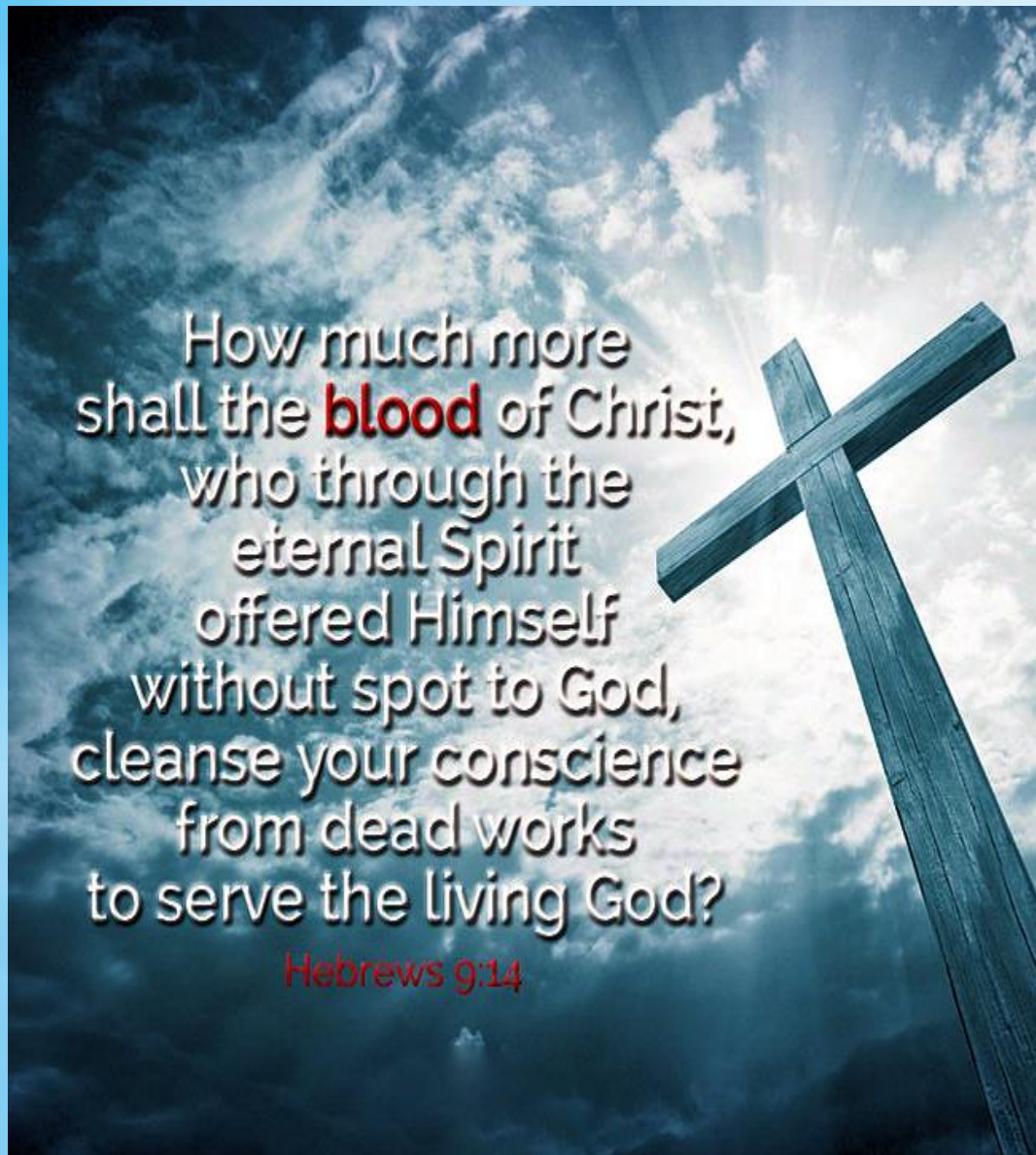
Leviticus 20:26 Thus you are to be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy; and **I have set you apart from the peoples to be Mine.**

Isaiah 43:1 But now, thus says the LORD, your Creator, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; **I have called you by name; you are Mine!**





# New Covenant: Dominion returned



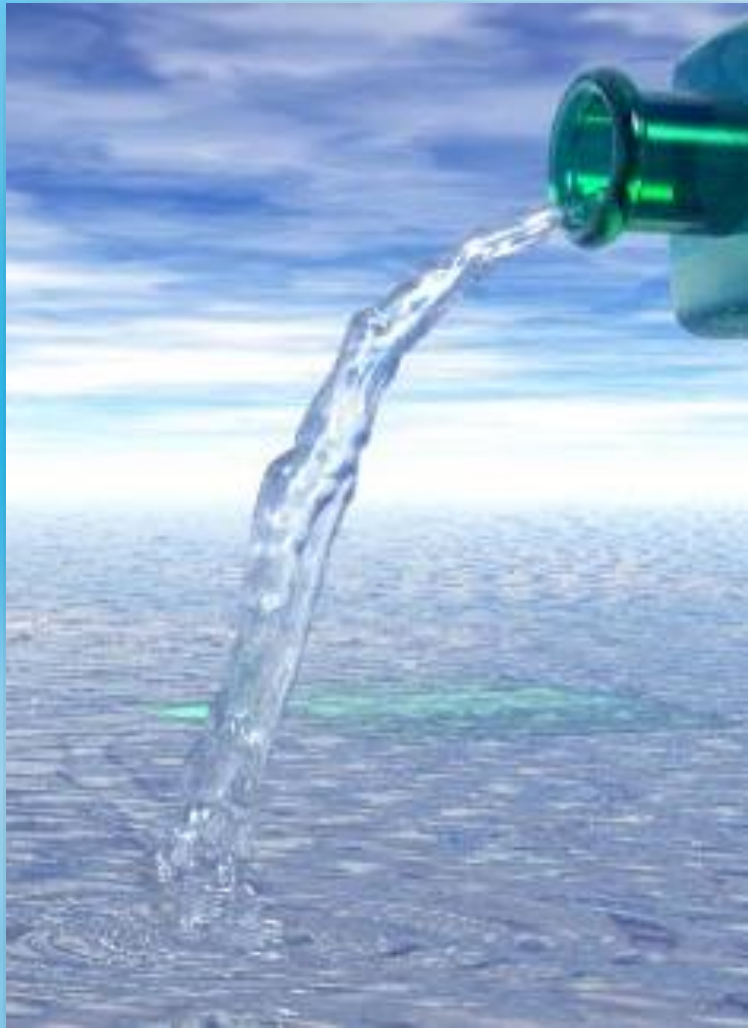

Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator **of the new testament**, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions *that were* under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

NIV

That is why he is the one who mediates **a new covenant** between God and people, so that all who are called can receive the eternal inheritance God has promised them. For Christ died to set them free from the penalty of the sins they had committed under that first covenant.

# But in his Humanity, Emptied(Limited ) himself!



Philippians 2:5 Have this mind in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: 6 **who, existing in the form of God, counted not the being on an equality with God** a thing to be grasped, 7 **but emptied himself**, taking the form of a servant, being made in the likeness of men; 8 and being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, becoming obedient [even] unto death, yea, the death of the cross.( ASV)




# But in his Humanity, Made Lower (Limited )



Hebrews 2:7 **Thou madest him a little lower than the angels;** thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands: 8 Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him. 9 **But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death,** crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

# Did the Son know everything all the time?



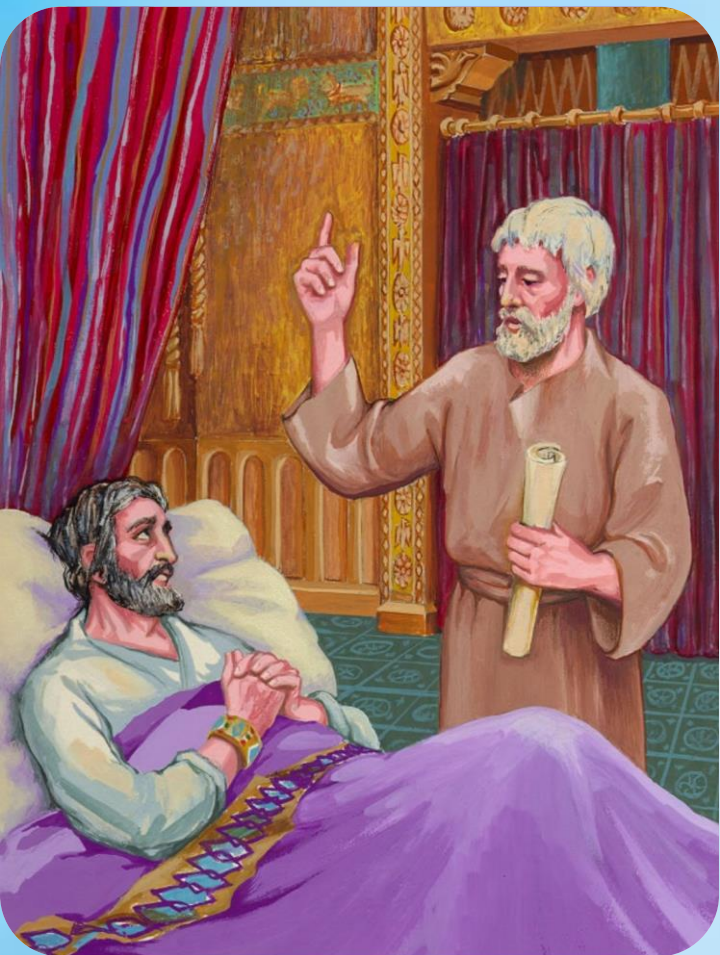
Mark 13:32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father

John 14:28 ¶Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: **for my Father is greater than I.**

- Matthew 12:14 Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him.
- 15 **But when Jesus knew it**, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;
- Mark 8:17 **And when Jesus knew it**, he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? have ye your heart yet hardened?
- John 6:61 **When Jesus knew in himself** that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?



# If Man has dominion what about Hezekiah?



Isaiah 38:1 ¶In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz came unto him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order: for thou shalt die, and not live.

2 Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and prayed unto the LORD,

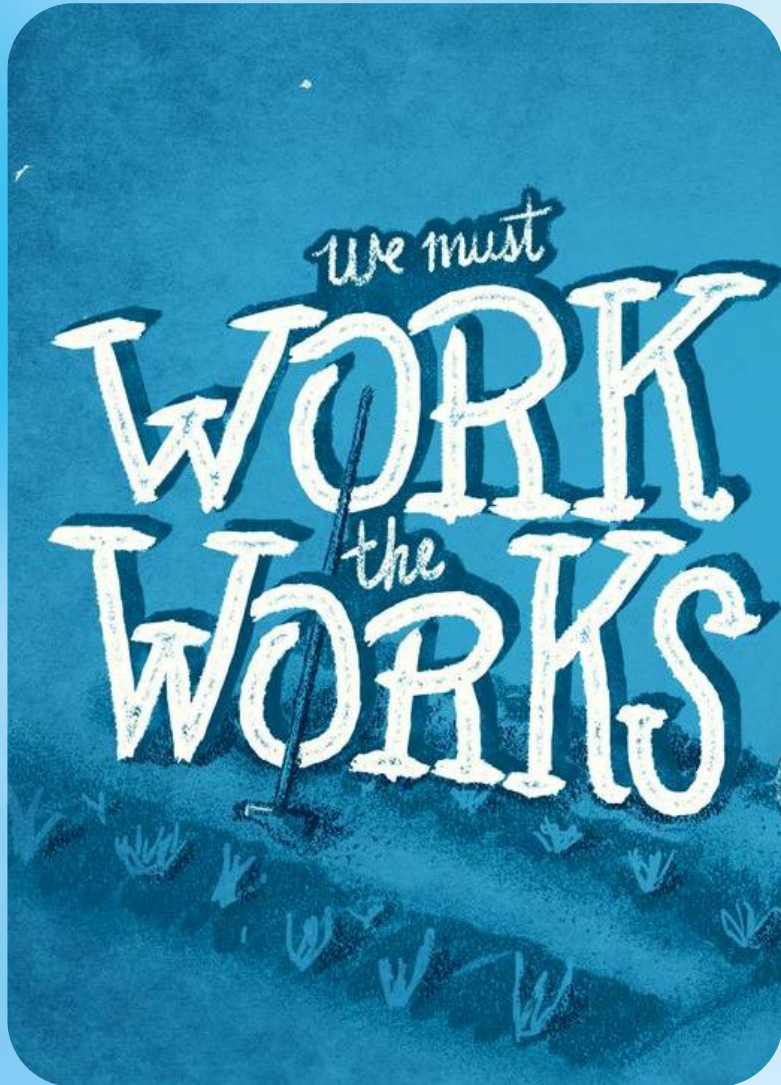
3 And said, Remember now, O LORD, I beseech thee, how **I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight.** And Hezekiah wept sore.

4 Then came the word of the LORD to Isaiah, saying,

5 Go, and say to Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, **I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears:** behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years.



# So how does God get his Will Done ? Through the Sons & Daughters



- Hebrews 2: 10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, **in bringing many sons to glory**, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
- John 9:4 “**I must work the works of him that sent me**, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.”

# Gods Covenant People

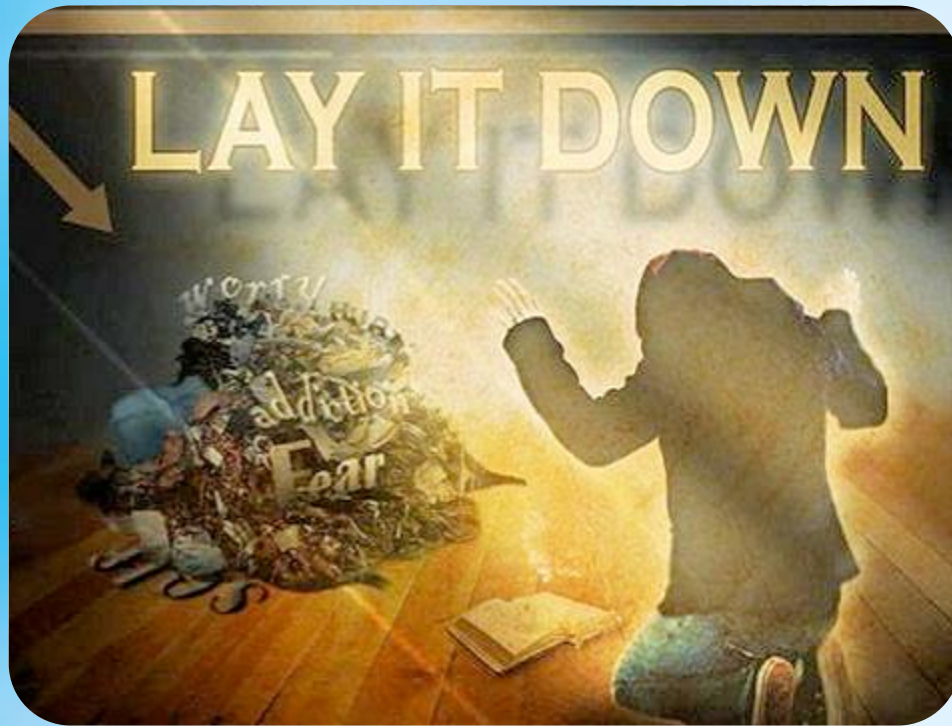


- Ex 32:14—Because of Moses' intercessory prayer, "the Lord changed his mind about the disaster he planned to bring on this people."
- 2 Chron 12:5-8—The Lord was going to allow the Israelites to be conquered because of King Rehoboam's rebellion. The king and his officers repent, so the Lord changes his plan.
- Jer 26:2-3—The Lord tells Jeremiah to prophesy to Israel that they should repent, saying, "I may change my mind about the disaster that I intend to bring on [Israel] because of their evil doings."
- Amos 7:1-6—The Lord revealed two judgments and two times Amos intercedes. Twice the Scriptures say, "The Lord relented concerning this ..."

- Matthew 12:50 For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.
- James 4:7 **Submit yourselves therefore to God.** Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
