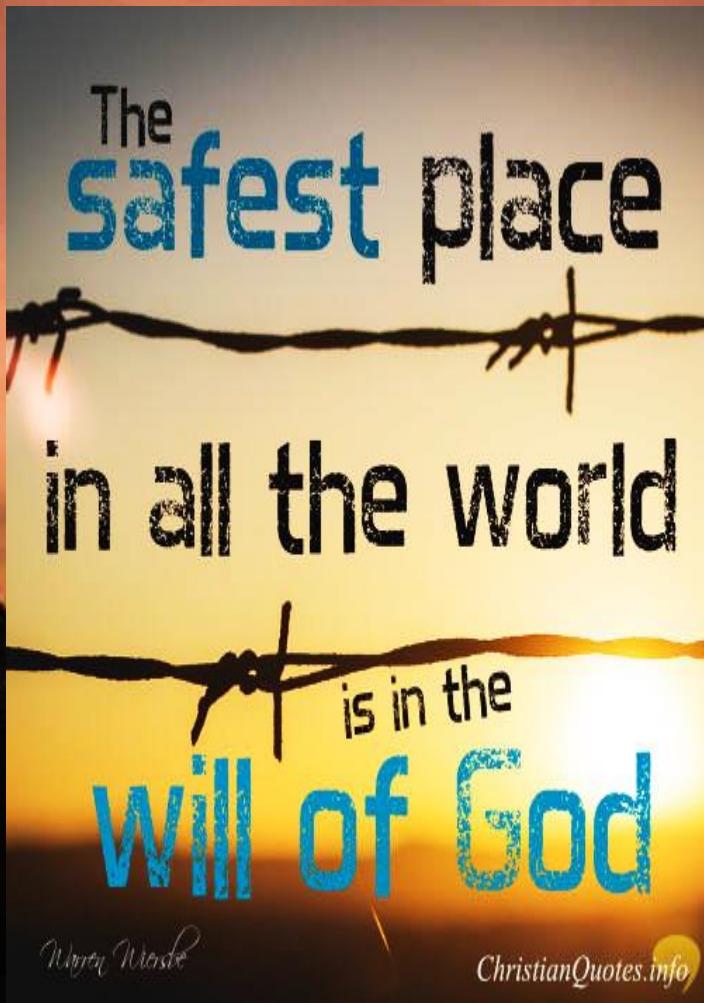

The Loss of Dominion

- **Loss of dominion of the Earth**
 - Luke 4:6 And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.
- **Loss of dominion over the animals**
 - Leviticus 26:22 I will also send wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children, and destroy your cattle, and make you few in number; and your high ways shall be desolate.

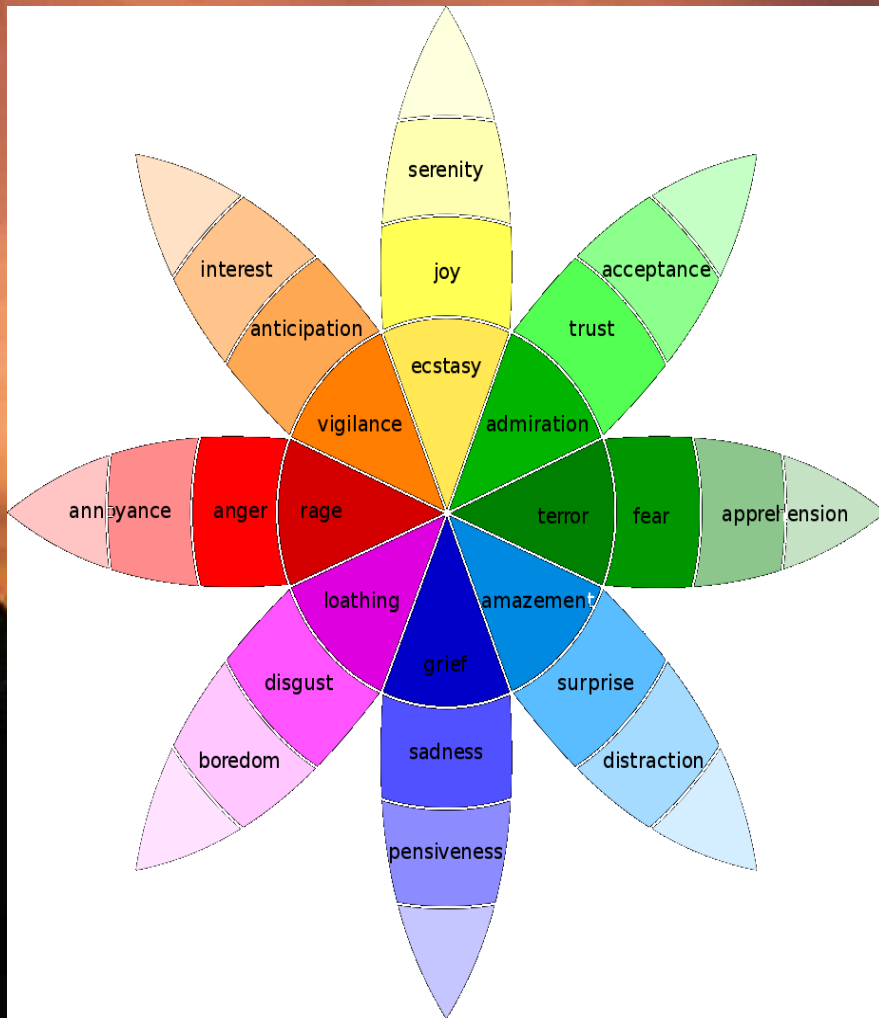

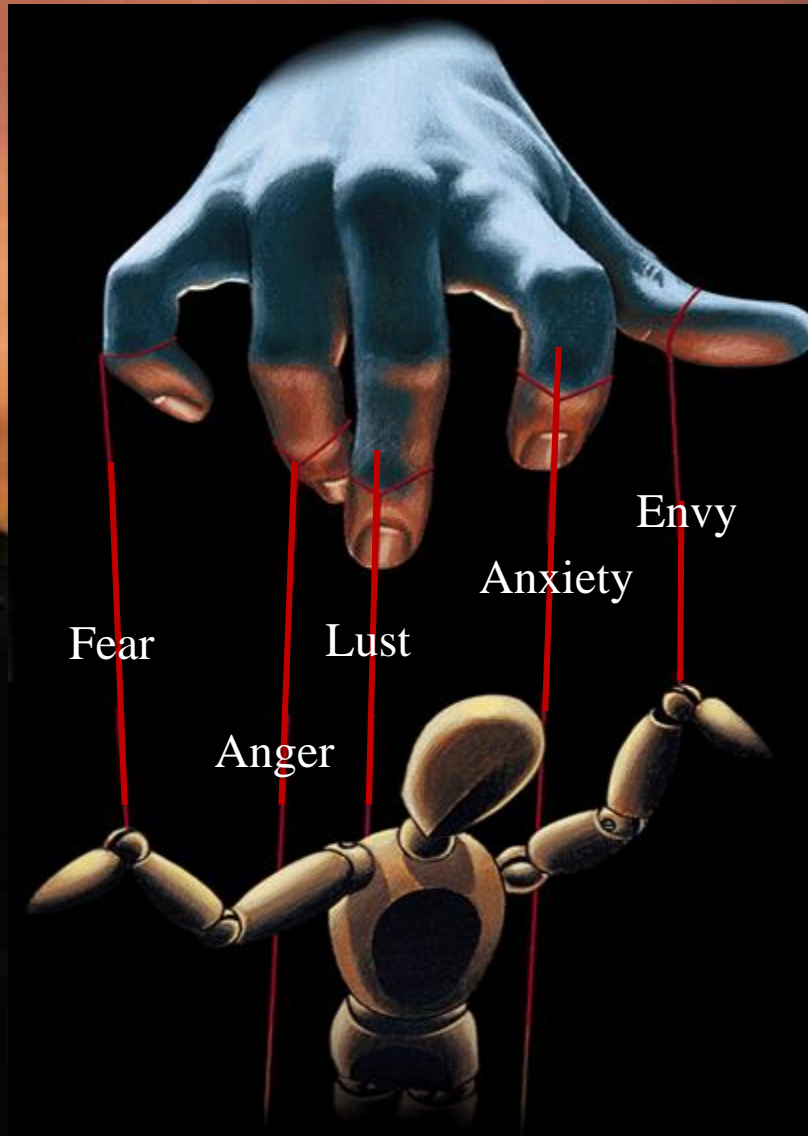

Strings of the Enemy



- Fear

- Matthew 25:24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:
- 25 **And I was afraid**, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

- Anger

- Genesis 4:6 ¶And the LORD said unto Cain, **Why art thou wroth (ANGRY)?** and why is thy countenance fallen?
- 7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door.

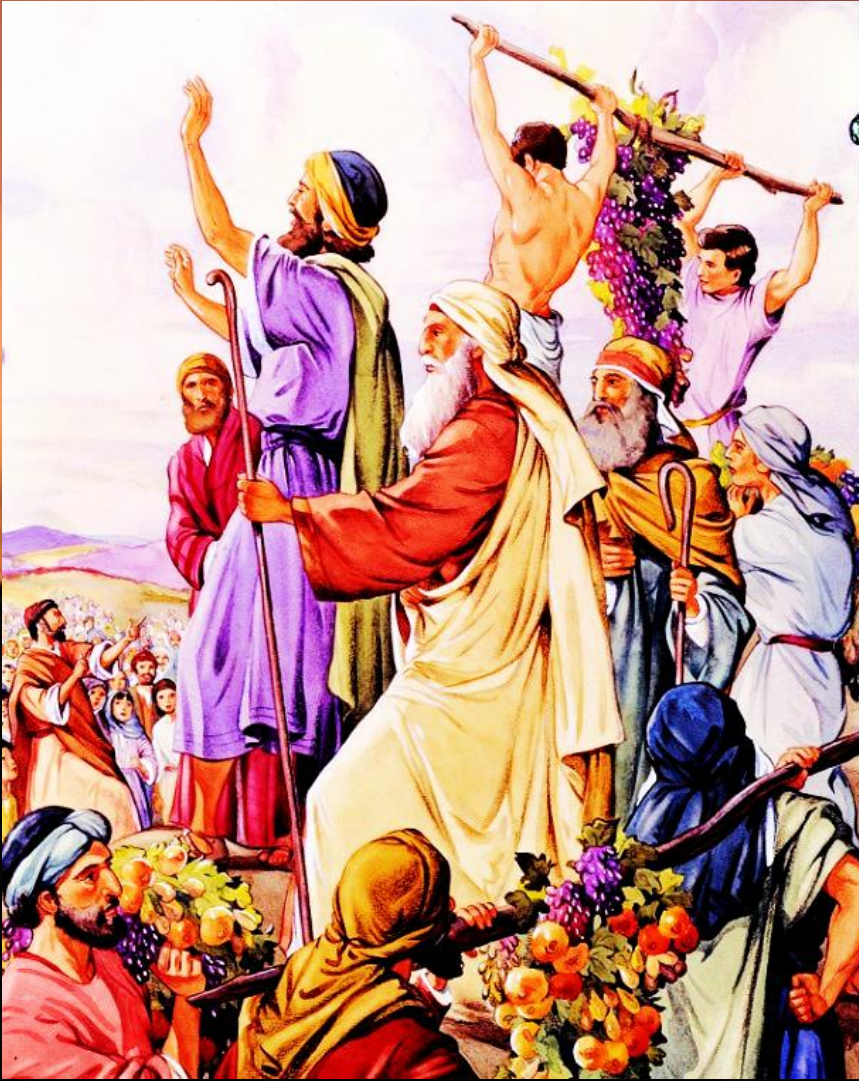
- Lust

- Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on **a woman to lust** after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Fear : Three Kinds

- **Reverential Fear**
 - This is a holy fear. It is really an awe and respect for the majesty and holiness of God. It is a godly reverence. Reverential fear is an awe for the heavenly Father. It is a fear of displeasing God.
- **Constitutional Fear**
 - This is a fear that is necessary for the preservation of the human race. Constitutional fear is a normal God-given emotion. God has built into each of us an instinctive alarm system which is designed to protect us from harm—from drunken drivers, rattlesnakes, hardened criminals, and fierce storms. These are normal fears which are necessary for our protection, and for the preservation of life. There is nothing wrong with holding these fears.
- **Carnal Fear**
 - Carnal fear is a senseless dread and a nagging anxiety. This is a fear that is always evil. It is a craven and base kind of fear. The Greek word carries with it the idea of an unhealthy, destructive kind of dread. Many examples of carnal fear are found in the Bible:

The Devils String: Carnal Fear



- Numbers 13:1 ¶And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 2 Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, every one a ruler among them.
- Numbers 13:25 And they returned from searching of the land after forty days.
- 26 ¶And they went and came to Moses, and to Aaron, and to all the congregation of the children of Israel, unto the wilderness of Paran, to Kadesh; and brought back word unto them, and unto all the congregation, and shewed them the fruit of the land.
- 27 And they told him, and said, We came unto the land whither thou sentest us, and surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it.

The Devils String: Carnal Fear



Joshua 14:8 My Countrymen who accompanied me frightened the people, but I remained loyal to the Lord my God (New English Translation)

- Numbers 13:31 But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we.
- 32 And they brought up an evil report of the land which they had searched unto the children of Israel, saying, The land, through which we have gone to search it, is a land that eateth up the inhabitants thereof; and all the people that we saw in it are men of a great stature.
- 33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

How Caleb Overcame Carnal Fear



- By Total Surrender (TRUST) in God
- 8 ... **but I wholly** (Completely Totally) **followed the LORD my God.**
- The Bible says that Caleb “completely followed the Lord”. The Hebrew word here is full of meaning. It describes a man who gives himself **entirely and completely to God**. He does this because he **loves God so much**. He wants to serve God only.

The Devils String: Carnal Fear



- Genesis 12:10 ¶And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine was grievous in the land.
- 11 And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that thou art a fair woman to look upon:
- 12 Therefore it shall come to pass, when the Egyptians shall see thee, that they shall say, This is his wife: and they will kill me, but they will save thee alive.
- 13 **Say, I pray thee, thou art my sister:** that it may be well with me for thy sake; and my soul shall live because of thee.

Carnal Fear makes us lean to our own understanding

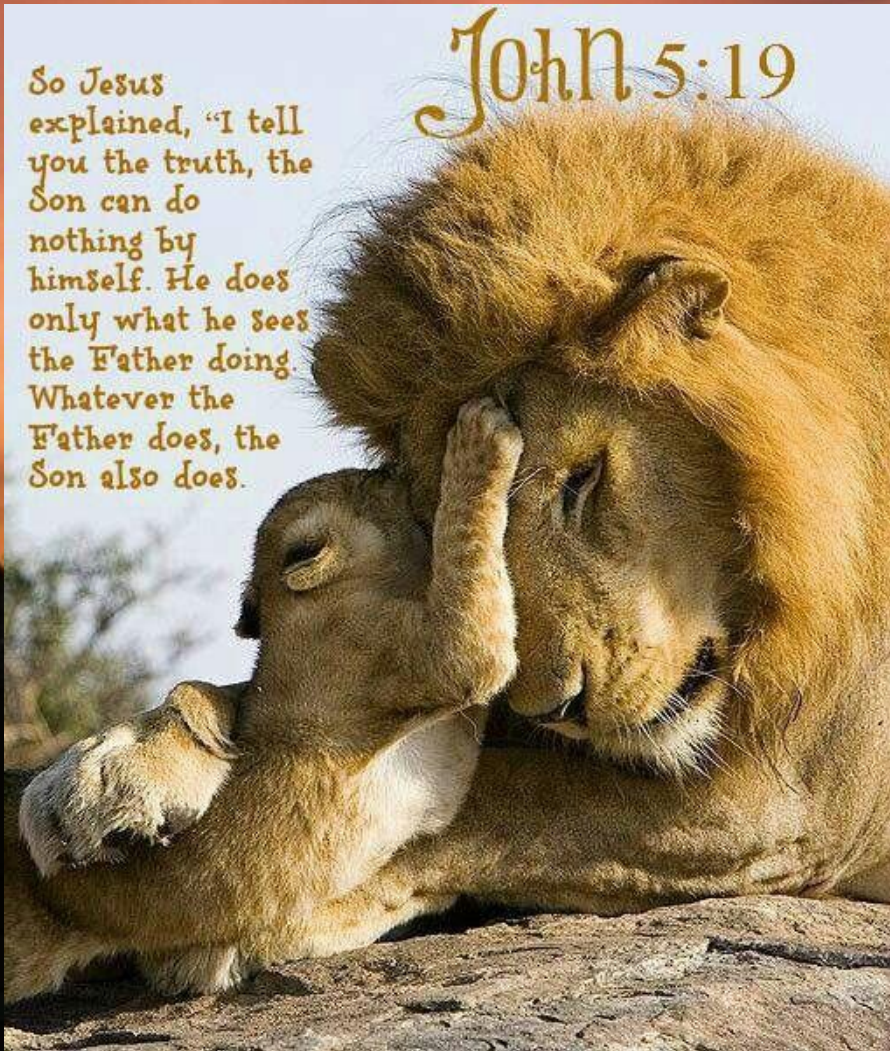


- Matthew 25:22 He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.
- 23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- 24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, **I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown,** and gathering where thou hast not strawed:
- 25 **And I was afraid,** and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

Doing only what the Father Does!

- 49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that **I must be about my Father's business?**

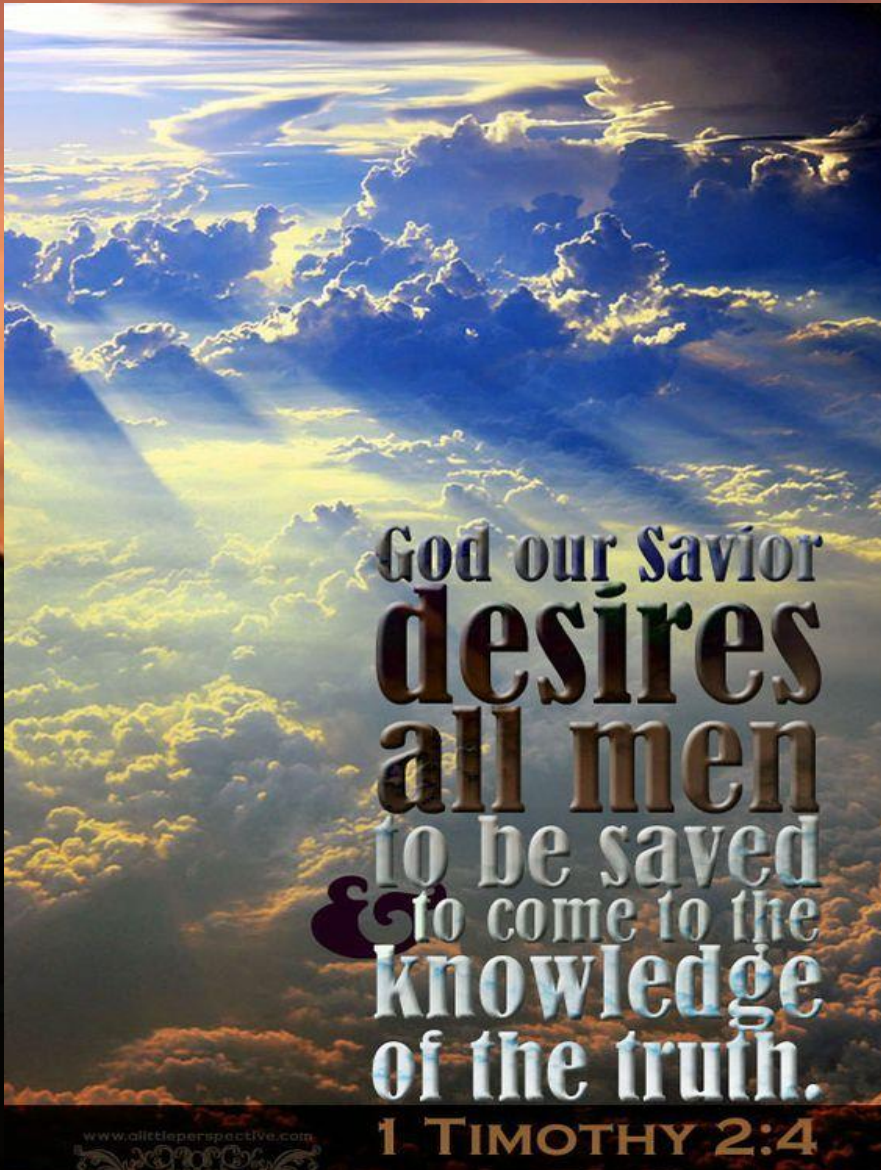
Seeking the Will
