The First Name



- Genesis 1:1 ¶In the beginning **God** created the heaven and the earth.

Elohim :

Means: God, Deity, Divinity

Means: God of Gods, Judge of Judges

The Lord God



LORD

Yod-Hei-Vav-Hei (YHVH)

YaHWeH = "the I AM"

Jehovah = "The Existing One"

- Genesis 2:4 ¶These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the *LORD God* made the earth and the heavens,
- **This Name is used in scripture when emphasizing God's might, His creative power, and His attributes of justice and rulership**

Adonai: Master, Lord



- Genesis 15:1 ¶After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.
- 2 ¶And Abram said, **Lord GOD**, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house is this Eliezer of Damascus?

El Shaddai: God Almighty



- Exodus 6:3 And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.

Putting on the name

Elohim :



- Numbers 6:23 Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, On this wise ye shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them,
- 24 The LORD bless thee, and keep thee:
- 25 The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee:
- 26 The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.
- 27 And they shall put my name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.

Change of relationship

- Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob Knew him as
 - God Almighty
 - Almighty to save (Lot from Sodom & Gomorrah)
 - Almighty to bless (Isaac & Rebekah)
 - Almighty to deliver(Jacob from Esau)

- Exodus 23:20 ¶Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared.
- 21 Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; *for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him.*

The LORD GOD : Jehovah(Yahweh) Elohim

Elohim As Judge: “My Name is in Him”

- Hebrews 2:2 For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward;
- Numbers 15:35 And the LORD said unto Moses, The man shall be surely put to death: all the congregation shall stone him with stones without the camp.
- Exodus 3:2 *And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush:* and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.

The Missing Name



Genesis 32:24 ¶ And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day.

Genesis 32:29 And Jacob asked him, and said, *Tell me, I pray thee, thy name*. And he said, Wherefore is it that thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there.

Hosea 12:4 *Yea, he had power over the angel*, and prevailed: he wept, and made supplication unto him: he found him in Bethel, and there he spake with us;

The Missing Name



- Judges 13:17 And Manoah said unto the angel of the LORD, What is thy name, that when thy sayings come to pass we may do thee honour?
- 18 And the angel of the LORD said unto him, Why askest thou thus after my name, seeing it is secret?
- *(Wonderful)*

The revelation of the Name



- Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

“Yashua” : He Shall Save
: Redeemer

Change of Name, Relationship

The relationship revealed by the Meaning of the Name



- Savior: Redeemer
- John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

Jesus is not your Judge

- John 12:47 And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.
- Genesis 48:16 *The Angel which redeemed me from all evil*, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.

Jesus is Not your Judge



- Jesus is Your redeemer!
—Job 19:25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

THE WORD OF GOD WILL BE YOUR JUDGE

- John 12:48 He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.
- 49 For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.

The Judge: The Word of God

- Revelation 19:11 ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.
- 13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.
