

PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11

- Philippians 2:6
- Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him **a name which is above every name:**
- 10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

God has created through the divine inspiration of the bible a method of establishing its authorship. And one of the many textual ways he does this is the use of names and naming

NAMES

THE NAME OF GOD

"Adam"



- “RED EARTH
- “MANKIND”
- Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.
- Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

NAMES

THE NAME OF GOD

"Seth"



- “APPOINTED”
- Genesis 4:25 ¶ And Adam knew his wife again; and she bare a son, and called his name Seth: For God, said she, hath appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew.

Genesis 5:4 And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters:

THE NAME OF GOD

"Enos"



- “MORTAL” or “SICK”
- Genesis 5:6 ¶And Seth lived an hundred and five years, and begat Enos:
- 7 And Seth lived after he begat Enos eight hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters:
- 8 And all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years: and he died.
- Seth's son was called Enosh, which means "mortal," "frail," or "miserable." It is from the root anash: to be incurable; used of a wound, grief, woe, sickness, or wickedness. (It was in the days of Enosh that men began to defile the name of the Living God.¹)

THE NAME OF GOD

"Kenan"



- KJV "Cainan" "SORROW"
- Genesis 5:9 And Enos lived ninety years, and begat Cainan:
- 10 And Enos lived after he begat Cainan eight hundred and fifteen years, and begat sons and daughters:
- Enos's son was named Kenan, from which can mean "sorrow," "dirge," or "elegy."
- Balaam, looking down from the heights of Moab, employed a pun upon the name of the Kenites when he prophesied their destruction.

THE NAME OF GOD

"Ma ha la lel"



- “PRAISE OF GOD” or
- “THE BLESSED GOD”
- Genesis 5:12 And Cainan lived seventy years, and begat Mahalaleel:
- 13 And Cainan lived after he begat Mahalaleel eight hundred and forty years, and begat sons and daughters:
- Ma halel (Like halleluya: Praise of) El means God

NAMES

THE NAME OF GOD

"Jared"



- “TO DECEND” or
- “SHALL COM DOWN”
- Genesis 5:15 And Mahalaleel lived sixty and five years, and begat Jared:
- 16 And Mahalaleel lived after he begat Jared eight hundred and thirty years, and begat sons and daughters:
- It was in his days that the “Watchers” descended upon the earth

NAMES

THE NAME OF GOD

"Enoch"



- “TEACHING” Or
- “ANOINTED”
- Genesis 5:18 And Jared lived an hundred sixty and two years, and he begat **Enoch**:
- 19 And Jared lived after he begat Enoch eight hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:
- 23 And all the days of Enoch were three hundred sixty and five years:
- 24 And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

"Methusalah"

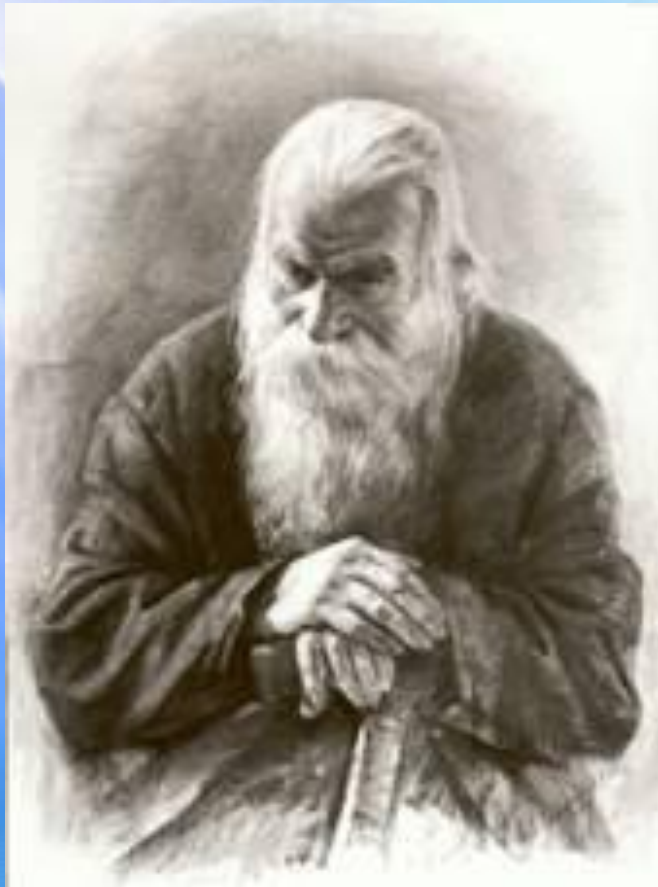


- "HIS DEATH SHALL BRING"
- Genesis 5:21 ¶ And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah:
- 22 And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:
- Methuselah comes from two roots: muth, a root that means "death"⁵ ; and from shalach, which means "to bring," or "to send forth." Thus, the name Methuselah signifies, "his death shall bring."

THE NAME OF GOD

"Lamech"



- “POOR” or
- “MADE LOW”
- Genesis 5:25 ¶ And Methuselah lived an hundred eighty and seven years, and begat Lamech:
- 28 ¶ And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son:
- A root sword till evident today in our own English word, "lament" or "lamentation." Lamech suggests "despairing."

NAMES

THE NAME OF GOD

"Noah"



- “COMFORT”
- Genesis 5:29 And he called his name Noah, saying, This same **shall comfort us** concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed.
- Noah which is derived from nacham , "to bring relief" or "comfort," as Lamech himself explains.

The first name

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning **God** created the **heaven** and the **earth**.
- God : Elohim
 - Plural Intensive
 - Singular in meaning when used with singular verbs!
 - “God of gods”
 - “Strong one”

When applying to YHWH, 'Elo·him' is used as a plural of majesty, dignity, or excellence.

The first “called” names

THE NAME OF GOD

- Genesis 1:5 And God called the light **Day**, and the darkness he called **Night**. And the evening and the morning were the first day.
- Called: Hebrew “Qara”
- Day: Hebrew “Yom”
- Night: Hebrew “Layil”



The Naming Event: Dominion Relationship

THE NAME OF GOD

Philippians 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, **and given him a name which is above every name:**

10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

- The act of naming defines a relationship!
- Ruler to Subjects
- Owner to that owned
- Superior to inferior
- Creator to Created
- Master to Disciples

God names the things that are his!

THE NAME OF GOD

- Genesis 1:8 And God called the firmament **Heaven**. And the evening and the morning were the second day.



10 And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that it was good.

God Calls!

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 5:2 Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

Man Given Dominion!

THE NAME OF GOD



Genesis 1:26 ¶And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Man, names names!

THE NAME OF GOD



Genesis 2:19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.

Adam names And again

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 2:23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.
- Genesis 3:20 And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

1 Timothy 2:15 Notwithstanding **she shall be saved in childbearing**, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

The “Call” of Abraham

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- Genesis 17:5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be **Abraham**; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

And “Sarai “ to Sarah

God Names.....

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 16:11 And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou art with child, and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name **Ishmael**; because the LORD hath heard thy affliction.
- Ishmael = "God will hear"

Thou shalt have a son and his name!

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 17:19 And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

Genesis 18:14 Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.

The change of name....becoming a prince!

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 32:27 And he said unto him, What is thy name? And he said, Jacob.
- Genesis 32:28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, **but Israel**: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

Joseph: “The Lord has added”

THE NAME OF GOD



- Genesis 30:24 And she called his name Joseph; and said, The LORD shall add to me another son.

Solomon?

THE NAME OF GOD



- 2 Samuel 12:24 And David comforted Bathsheba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her: and she bare a son, and he called his name Solomon: and the LORD loved him.

- 2 Samuel 12:25 And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet; and he called his name Jedidiah, because of the LORD.

Ha Shem

THE NAME OF GOD

- Throughout the Scriptures, God puts his personal name on certain places, objects or persons.
- This act implied several things: ownership, adoption, even marriage. It meant that that place or person would (should) demonstrate God's character, or would be a living demonstration of a particular principle that God wanted other human beings to observe.

The Devine Name!

THE NAME OF GOD



When the "Blessing of Aaron" (Numbers 6:24-26) is spoken over the people, the divine word follows: "So they shall invoke [lit. put] my Name on the children of Israel" (v. 27).

"כי לכו-נא אל-מקומי אשר בשילו אשר שכנתי שמי שם בראשונה..." ירמיהו יב
"...But go now to my place which was in Shilo, where I set my name at the first..." Jeremiah 7:12

The Place is named!

THE NAME OF GOD



- In time there is a narrowing of focus. God begins to put his name on one specific building on one specific hill in one specific town.
- [David] shall build a house for my Name. (2 Sam 7:13)
- YHVH has chosen Zion. (Psalm 132:13)

- YHVH said, "My Name shall be in Jerusalem forever." (2 Chron 33:4)
- In this city which I have chosen, and the temple of which I said,
"My Name shall be there." (2 Kings 23:27)

The New Family Name!

THE NAME OF GOD



- Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
- John 17:6 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.

The Family Name!

THE NAME OF GOD



- John 14:26 But the Comforter, [which is] the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- John 5:43 **I am come in my Father's name**, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

The change of name ceremony!

THE NAME OF GOD



- Colossians 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.
- Galatians 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

The vows !

THE NAME OF GOD



- Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

The command!

THE NAME OF GOD

- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Mark 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
