John 1:29 ¶The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.



“In his Image”

- God created us Spirit, Soul, and Body

- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 ¶ And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole *spirit and soul and body* be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.



“Thou shall surely die”

- The Spirit Covering died immediately
- Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.



“Thou shall surely die”

- Next the flesh started dying
- Genesis 3:19 “..... for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.”



“Thou shall surely die”

- Finally the soul too, was destined to die in the Grave Hell
- Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy **both soul and body in hell.**



Guilt the first byproduct

- Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.



Loss of Dominion the second

Gen 1:28 “....**have dominion**
over the fish of the sea, and
over the fowl of the air, and
over **every living thing** that
moveth upon the earth.”



The Greatest Loss

- Dominion over the Flesh!
- Romans 7:23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.



How we became sinners!

- Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:



What was God to do?

- **Above all things God is bound by his word!**
- Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:
- Psalms 138:2 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: **for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.**



The Problems

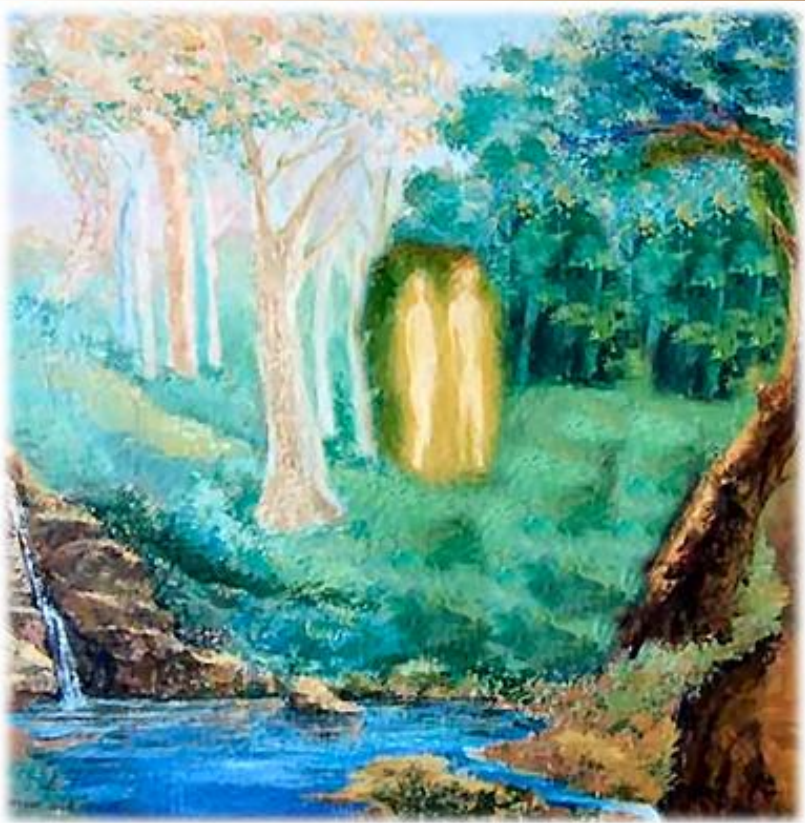
- Man had lost the spirit covering and had to leave the garden. God could no longer deal directly with man.
- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him **must worship him in spirit** and in truth.



The Problems

- Because of eating of the Tree, they now new wrong from right. This
 - **BROUGHT GUILT !**
- But because of the Loss of Dominion(mastery of the flesh) they could'nt do anything about it
 - **THEY TRIED**

Man fails to solve the guilt Problem !



- Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; **and they sewed fig leaves** together, and made themselves aprons.



The Problems

- How do you solve the Guilt problem ?
- Genesis 3:11 ".....Who told thee that thou wast naked? "
- 1 John 3:21 Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, **then have we confidence toward God.**



The Problems

- THE BODY, now belonged to Satan
- Romans 6:16 Know ye not, that to **whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey**; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?



The Problems

- If God allowed the body to Die, The most important part of our nature, THE SOUL would have to leave the physical realm. There was only one place it could go.
- The Soul, was going to be eternally separated from God and die in HELL!



The Problems

- **Guilt:** Makes man unable to trust God.
- **Loss of Dominion:** Man unable to be sinless
- **The Body:** Controlled by Satan
- **The Soul:** destined to die in Hell
- **The Spirit covering dead:** Unable to deal with God directly

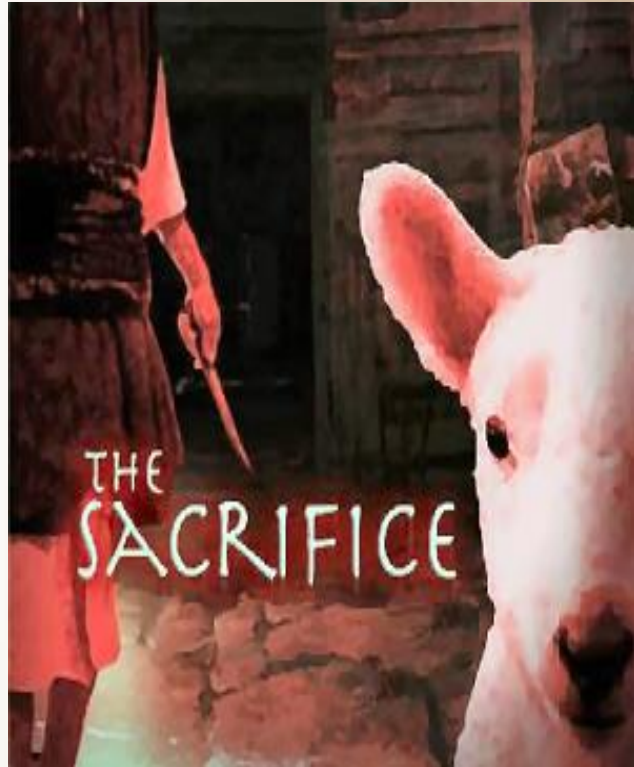


Gods Plan

- A blood atonement



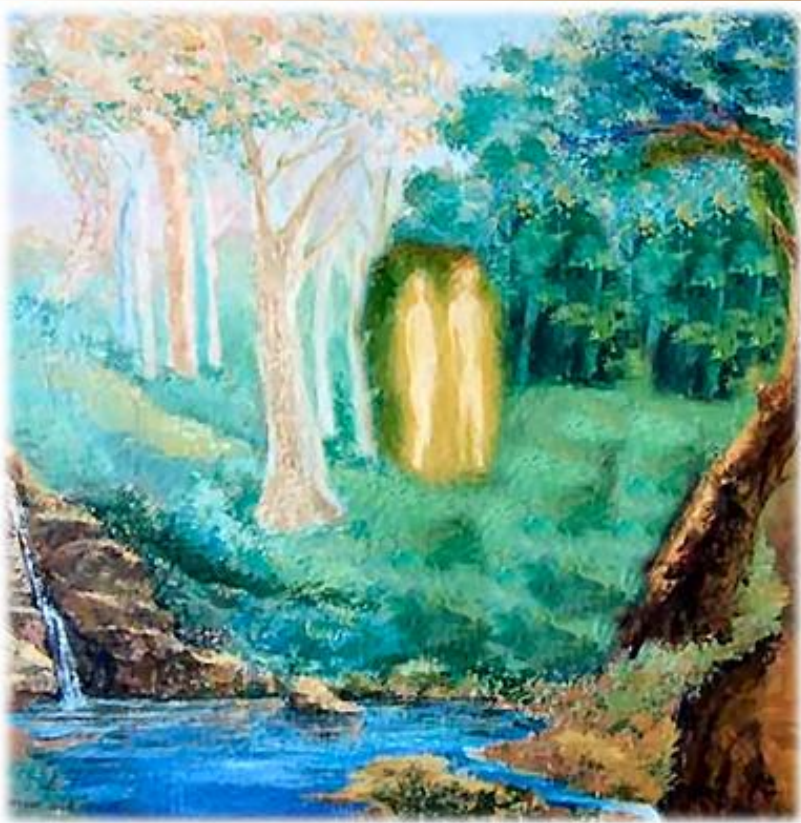
A life for a Life



- Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the **blood that maketh an atonement(covering) for the soul.**



Skin(light), for skin(animal died)

What to do about the Body?

- Genesis 3:22 ¶ And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, **and live for ever:**
- **Gods plan for the Body is DEATH**



- Psalms 8:4 What is **man**, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?
- Man (Hebrew enowsh :mortal man)



What to do about the Body?

- Psalms 8:4 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?
- 5 For thou hast **made him a little lower than the angels,**WHEN?
- WHEN HE SINNED! CHANGED FROM |
- ADAM son of God to
- ENOWSH Mortal son of man!



WHY let man Die ?

- Because of who controlled the body:
- SATAN
- Genesis 3:19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: **for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.**
- Genesis 3:14 ¶ And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, **and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:**



The Five Offerings



- The Burnt Offering
- The Meal Offering
- The Peace Offering
- The Sin Offering
- The Trespass Offering



Dealing with the Current Problem

Burnt offering: For the removal of Guilt towards GOD.

JUSTIFICATION

Sin offering: For forgiveness of **Unintentional** Sin against GOD.

ATONEMENT

Trespass offering: Removal of Sins(any kind) against our fellow man

FORGIVENESS

These all dealt with the current situation , day to day Living, They did not fix the problem,

THE SIN NATURE, and the death of the **SOUL!**



The Final Solution

- Redemption of the Soul:
- Fixing the sin Nature: Restoring Dominion
- Recreating: Sons of God



Old testament model

- Redeeming the Soul:

- The Passover lamb: **NOT A SACRIFICE FOR SIN**
- Not Killed by a priest
- Not Killed in the temple or Tabernacle.
- **It represents redemption of the Soul from Hell.**
 - NOT AN OFFERING BECAUSE
- IT SYMBOLIZED SOMETHING ONLY JESUS
COULD DO!



The lamb of God

The Lamb of redemption

- Exodus 12:3 Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every **man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:**
- 4 And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.
- 5 **Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year:** ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:
- 6 And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.
- 7 And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

The first lamb (Passover), symbolizes redemption of the soul (from the curse of death)



Hosea 13:14 I will ransom them from the power of the grave; **I will redeem them from death:** O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

- 1 Peter 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:
- Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: **for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood** out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

The model of Egypt Judgment against Osiris



- Hosea 13:14 I will ransom them from the power of the grave; **I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues;** O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

Osiris, god of the dead, was represented by the stars of the modern-day constellation Orion. Dead pharaohs supposedly became stars in Osiris as they joined the god. (UT Center for Middle Eastern Studies)



The Final Solution part 2

- Fixing the sin Nature: Restoring Dominion
- To fix the sin nature, we have to be given a new body and new dominion.
- We have to be BORN AGAIN.
 - The Plan was symbolized in the Atonement Ceremony
 - YOM KIPPUR



Two goats: One Body!

- God cannot fix the Sin nature as long as the body lives!
- The atonement Ceremony represents the death of the body.
- The two goats represent the remaining nature
 - **Body and Soul**
 - 1 Peter 4:1 ¶ Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;



The Atonement offering



The high priest
Pronounces all
the
Sin on the Goat
to
Azazel

- Leviticus 16:15 ¶ Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:
- Leviticus 16:21 And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all

- their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness.
- 22 And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.



Gods Symbolism

- (Old testament)
 - Sin not forgiven.....Sin covered
 - Hebrews 10:4 For **it is not possible** that the blood of bulls and of goats **should take away sins.**
 - Hebrews 10:11 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes **the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:**



Brass the metal of Judgment



Exodus 27:17 All the pillars round about the court shall be filleted with silver; their hooks shall be of silver, and **their sockets of brass.**

- Numbers 21:9 And Moses made a **serpent of brass**, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived
- The word for snake is NACHASH (bright and shining; adjective), which is directly connected to the word for brass (NECHESHETH). They are virtually the same word. So for brass read snake - and for snake read brass.

The Tabernacle Rested upon Gods Judgment



The symbolic place of Judgment

The altar of Burnt Offering

- The Brazen Altar....Brass the metal of Judgment
 - Exodus 38:30 And therewith he made the sockets to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and the **brassen altar, and the brassen grate** for it, and all the vessels of the altar,
 - Leviticus 6:12 And **the fire upon the altar shall be burning in it; it shall not be put out:** and the priest shall burn wood on it every morning, and lay the burnt offering in order upon it; and he shall burn thereon the fat of the peace offerings.



The literal place of Judgment



- 2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to **hell**, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but **after this the judgment:**

Hell : A place of burning



- Deuteronomy 32:22 For a fire is kindled in mine anger, **and shall burn unto the lowest hell**, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.
- Matthew 18:9 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be **cast into hell fire**.



The Brasen Altar

- Represented the place of Judgment

Hell

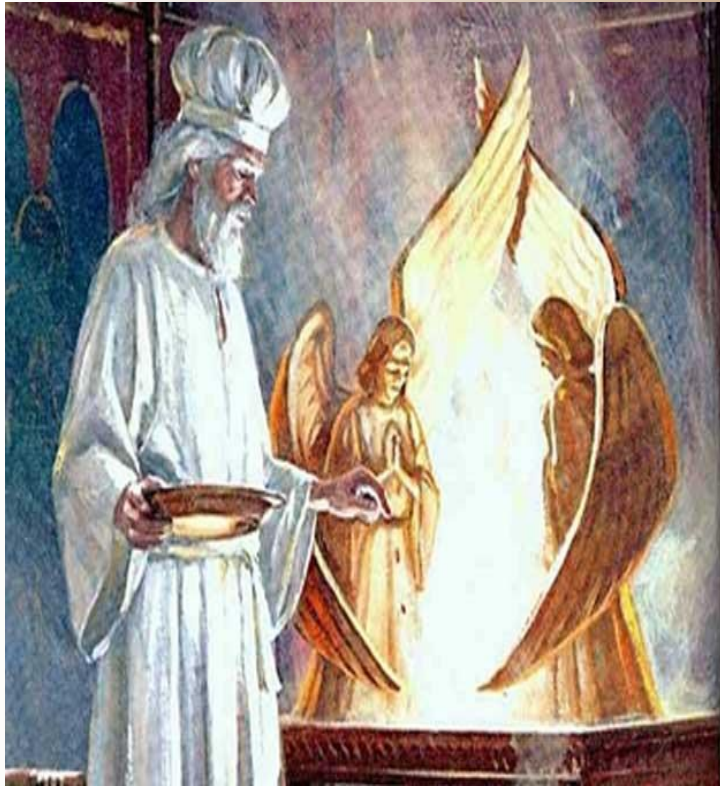


The place where Judgment & mercy starts

- Ezekiel 9:2 And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them was clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, and stood **beside the brasen altar.**

Jesus: The fulfillment of the levitical offerings

- Jesus in his death, was the literal fulfillment of the mosaic system of offerings
 - Matthew 5:17 ¶ Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, **but to fulfill.**

The Fulfillment of the Law

- Jesus is the Passover lamb

- 1 Corinthians 5:7 ¶ Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened **For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us:**

- Jesus is the Lamb of the Burnt Offering

- Genesis 22:7 And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?
8 And Abraham said, My son, **God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering:** so they went both of them together.

The Fulfillment of the Law



- **Jesus is the Lamb of The trespass Offering**

- Leviticus 14:25 And he shall **kill the lamb of the trespass offering**, and the priest shall take some of the blood of the trespass offering, and put it upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot:
- **2 Corinthians 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.**





The offering made by fire Hell the true place of judgment “Brasen altar”

- Isaiah 53:10 ¶ Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.
- Isaiah 53:12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.
- Acts 2:25 For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:
- 26 Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope:
- 27 Because **thou wilt not leave my soul in hell**, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

The One Offering



- Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
- 15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,
- 16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;
- 17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.
- 19 ¶ Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,
- 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;
- 21 And having an high priest over the house of God;
- 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.



The plan in progress



- Hebrews 9:24
- For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now **to appear in the presence of God for us:**



Ending the sin nature



Hebrews 9:25 Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;

26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world(end of the ages) hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

Revelation 5:6 ¶ And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints. 9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; 12 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
