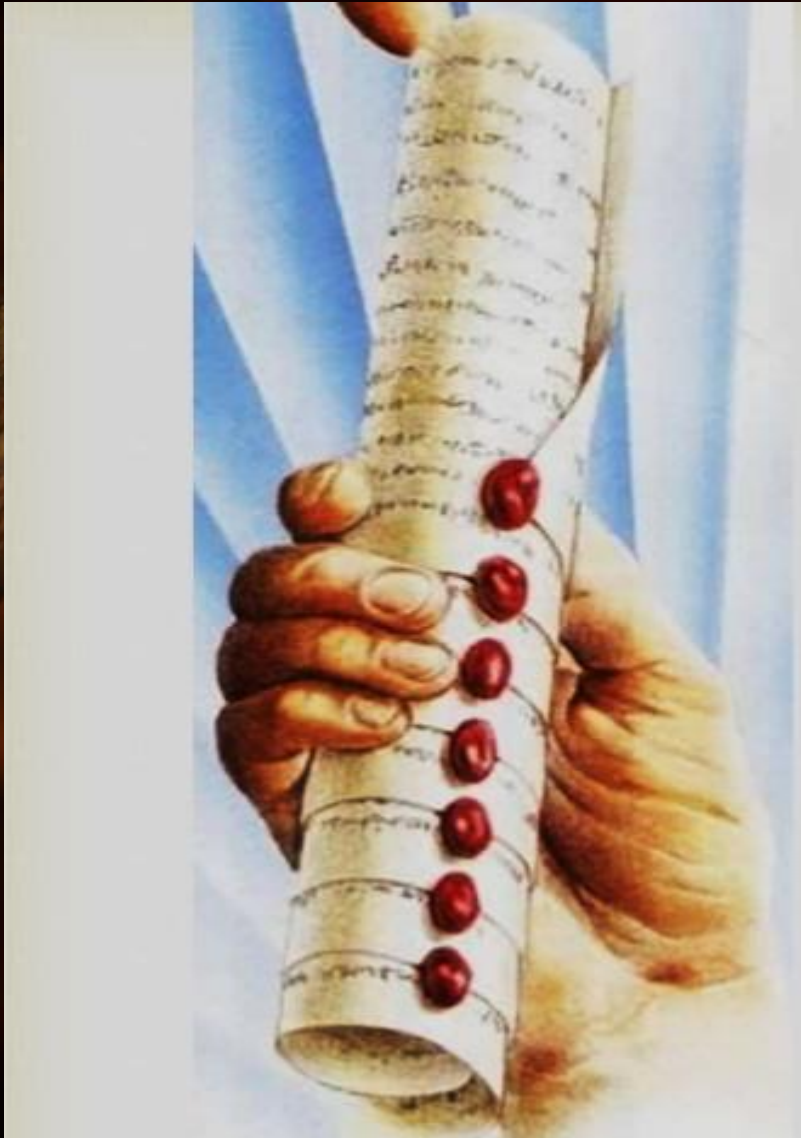

- Revelation 5:1 ¶ And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.
- 2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
- 3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
- 4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

The Book That Was Sealed



- Daniel 12:1 ¶ And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time **thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.**
- 2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.
- 3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.
- 4 But thou, O Daniel, **shut up the words, and seal the book,** even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

The Lions Atonement : Covering



Leviticus 17:11 For the life (Nephesh SOUL) of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement (COVERING) for the soul.

The Sevenfold Sprinkling



Leviticus 4:6 And the priest shall dip his finger in the blood, and sprinkle of **the blood seven times before the LORD**, before the vail of the sanctuary.

Leviticus 4:17 And the priest shall dip his finger in some of the blood, **and sprinkle it seven times before the LORD**, even before the vail.

Leviticus 16:14 And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat **shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.**

Leviticus 16:19 And **he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times**, and cleanse it, and hallow it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel.

Numbers 19:4 And Eleazar the priest shall take of her blood with his finger, and **sprinkle of her blood** directly before the tabernacle of the **congregation seven times:**

The Blood from his Sweat (1)



Luke 22:44

Hematidrosis

Hematidrosis is a condition in which capillary blood vessels that feed the sweat glands rupture, causing them to exude blood, occurring under conditions of extreme physical or emotional stress.^[4] Severe mental anxiety activates the sympathetic nervous system to invoke the stress-fight or flight reaction to such a degree as to cause hemorrhage of the vessels supplying the sweat glands into the ducts of the sweat glands.^[5] It has been suggested that acute fear and extreme stress can cause hematidrosis.^[6]

Blood from his feet and hands (5,6)



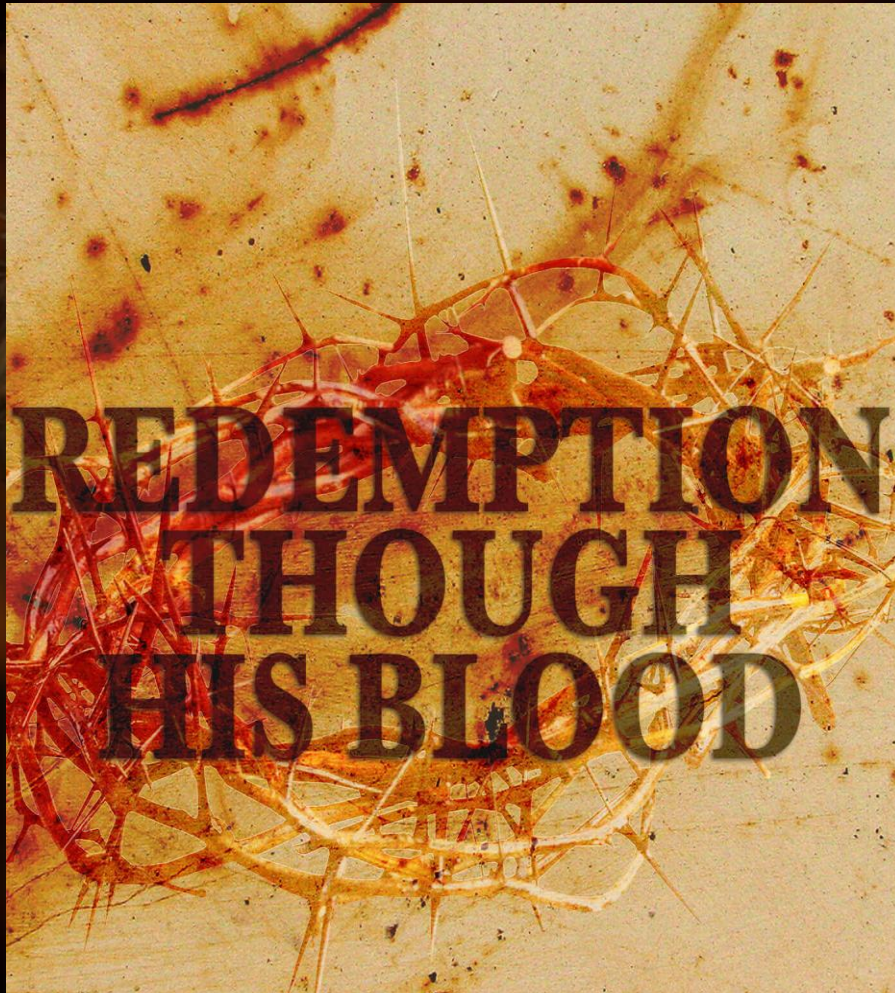
- Luke 23:33 And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left.

The Blood From His Side (7)



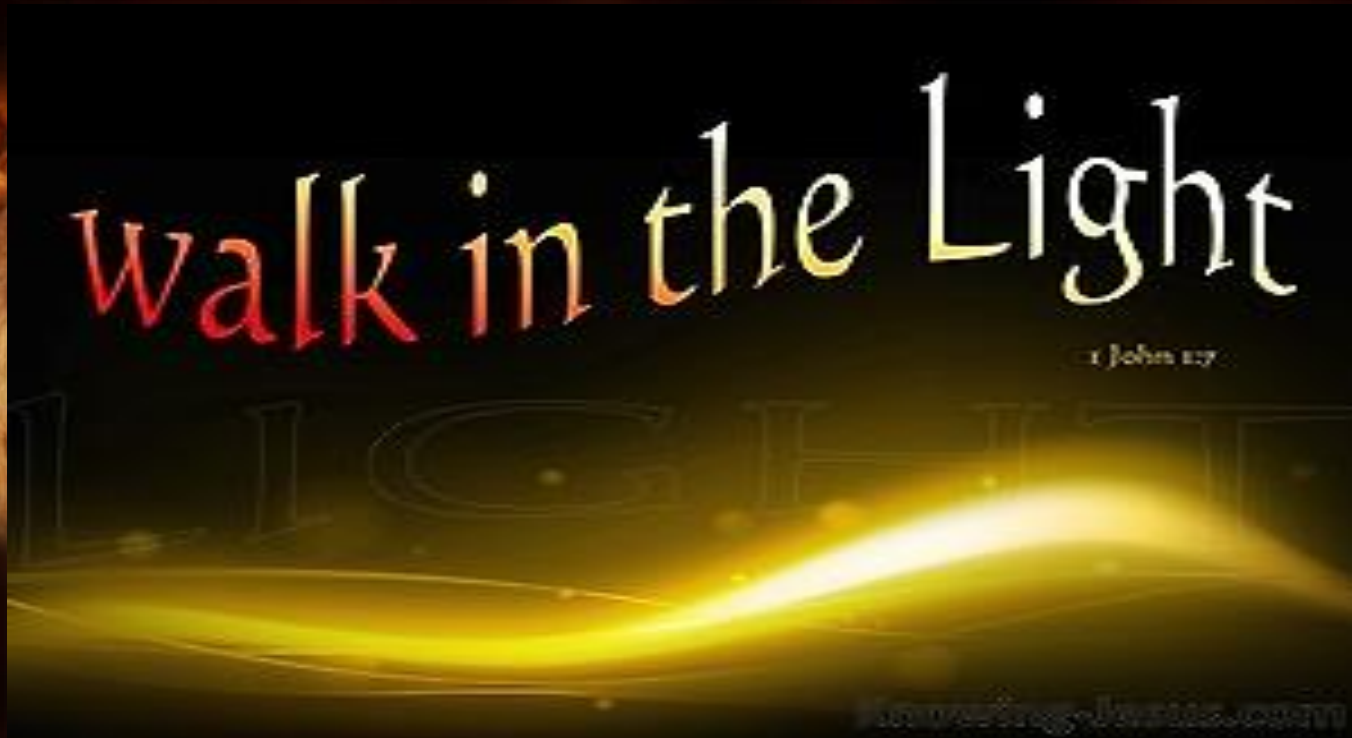
John 19:34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there **out blood** and water.

The Sevenfold Sprinkling Sanctification (4)

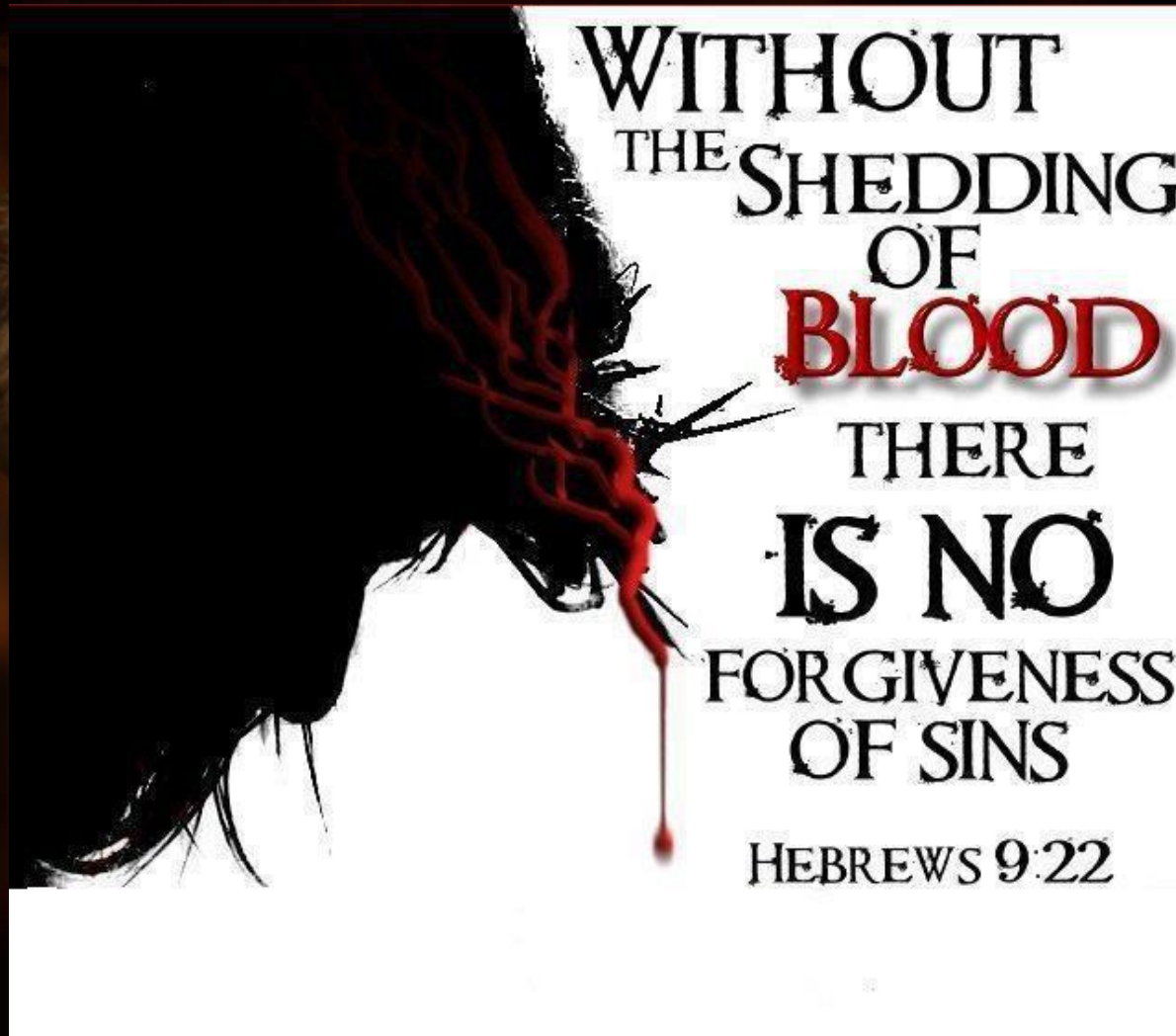


Hebrews 13:12 Wherefore Jesus also, that **he might sanctify the people with his own blood**, suffered without the gate.

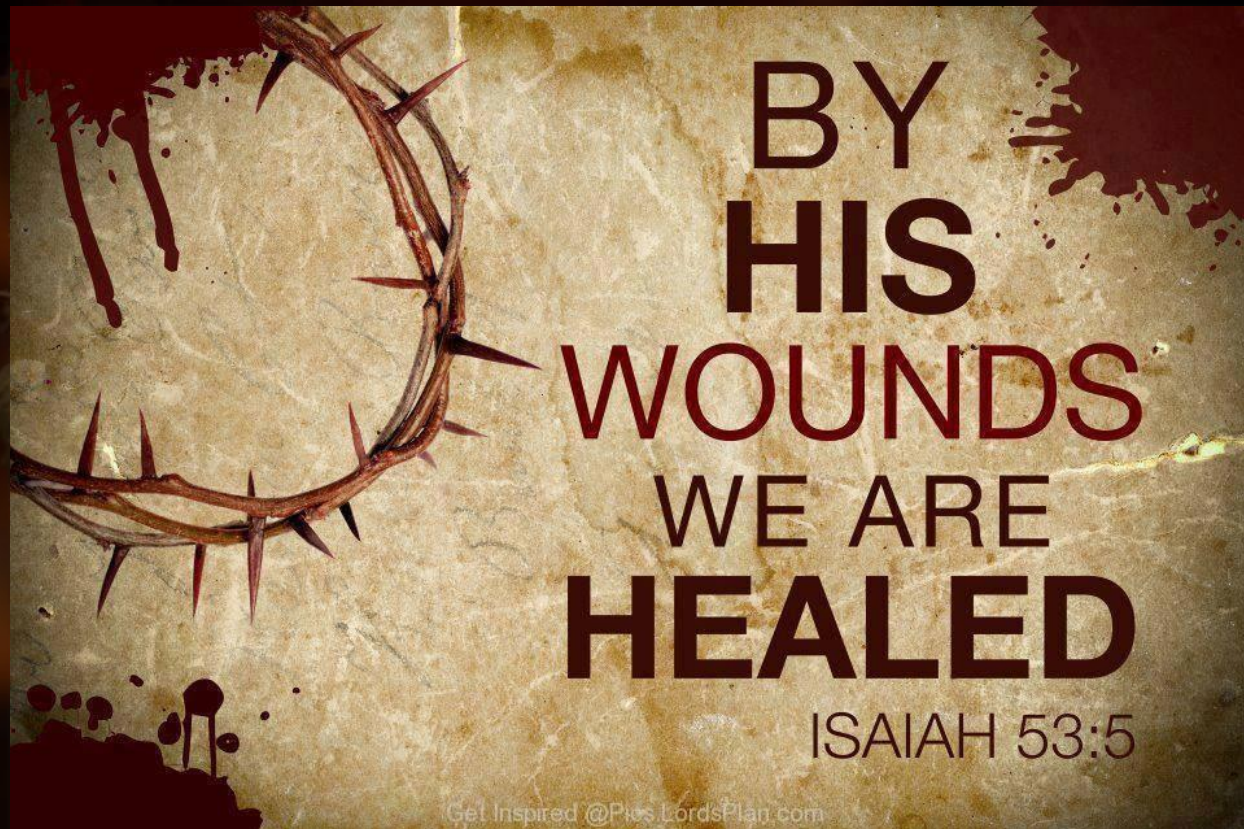

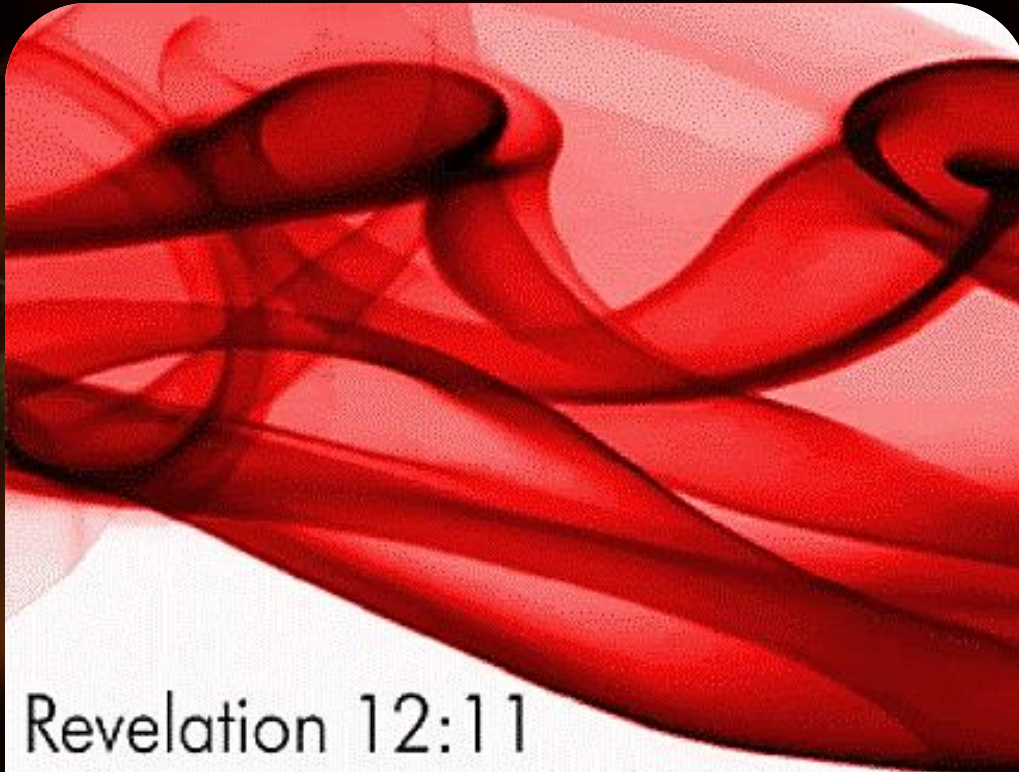
The Sevenfold Sprinkling Healing (6)

Baptism: Remission of Sin for the Body

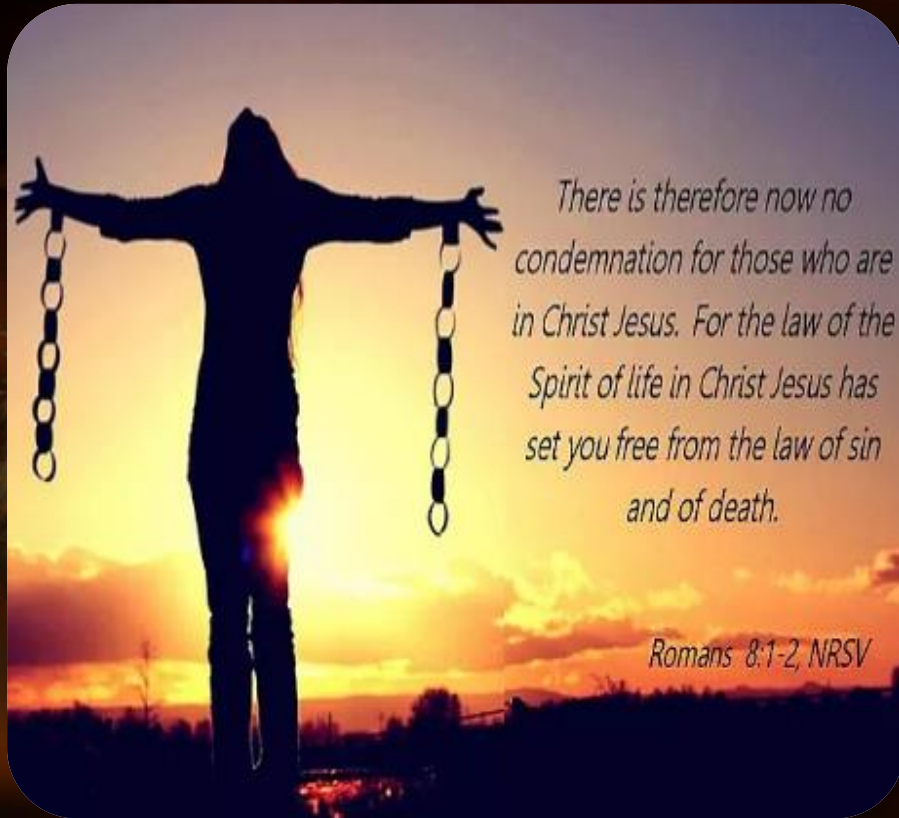
The Blood: Cleansing of Sin for the Soul



- Hebrews 9:19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,
- Hebrews 9:21 Moreover he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry.
- Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, **having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience**, and our bodies washed with pure water.

The Victory of Christ's blood ?
