



Why did God have to become man



- Genesis 2:1 ¶Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.
- 2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.
- 3 And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

- Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.




• Created "Bara" A Soul Being

- 1 Peter 1: 9 Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.
- "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins."

John 6:69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

No other way



- John 11:42 And I knew that thou hearest me always:
- Matthew 26: 53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Matthew 26: 39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

Because only Jesus/God had the true permanent covering!



• Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

John 16:7 ¶Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

- 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.
- 18 ¶I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.
- Titus 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

The Visible Image of The Invisible God




Revelation 4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and **ONE** sat on the throne.

Christ's dual nature: Our High Priest



• Hebrews 4: 15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as [we are, yet] without sin.

- John 8: 56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.
- 57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?
- 58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I AM.

To be our (Human/Divine) mediator



1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

- Hebrews 9:15 ¶And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.
- Hebrews 12: 24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

The mercy seat: Propitiation

Jesus our mercy seat: propitiation

• John 20: 11 But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, and looked into the sepulchre, 12 And seeth two angels in white sitting, the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.



The Grace Equation

Romans 5:13 For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

(NO LAW, SIN NOT IMPUTED!)

Romans 5:14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, (FROM ADAM MEN STILL DIED)

+

Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

(Christ ENDS THE LAW for believers)

Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

IN CHRIST, SIN IS NOT IMPUTED AND ALL MADE ALIVE = GRACE!
