- III – Gives Powers to Judicial
- IV – Relations between states
- V- Amending the Constitution
- VI – Constitution is Supreme
- VII – Ratifying the Constitution

Human Government

- Section 1
 - All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives

- Section 1:



- 1 Timothy 1:17 Now unto the **King eternal, immortal,** invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

- Section 1:


Article 8: The Unchanging God!

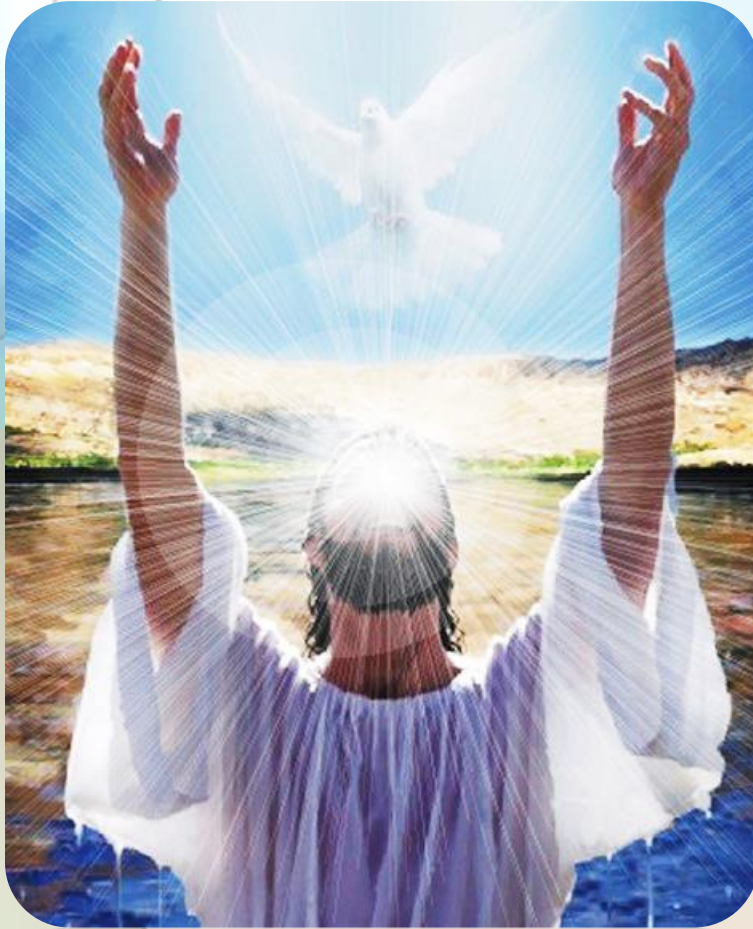

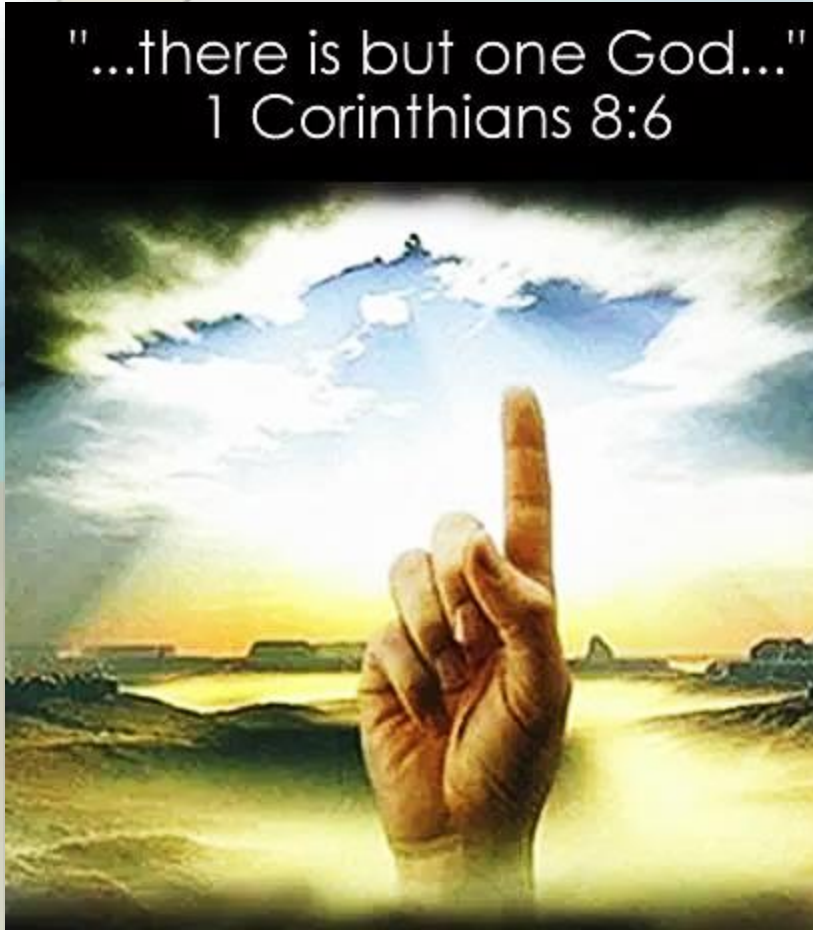
Section 2:
