Isaiah 43:6 I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth;


7 Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.

The Cherubim



- Ezekiel 10:14 And every one had four faces: the first face was the face of a cherub, and the second face was the face of a man, and the third the face of a lion, and the fourth the face of an eagle.
- 15 And the cherubims were lifted up. This is the living creature that I saw by the river of Chebar.
- 16 And when the cherubims went, the wheels went by them: and when the cherubims lifted up their wings to mount up from the earth, the same wheels also turned not from beside them.
- 17 When they stood, these stood; and when they were lifted up, these lifted up themselves also: for the spirit of the living creature was in them.
- 18 Then the glory of the LORD departed from off the threshold of the house, and stood over the cherubims.




2. To bring us to God

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.



The Man: Created a Son of God to showcase in man, Gods Glory!


- 1 Corinthians 11:7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God:

Called to Glory




- John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.




- Ephesians 2:4 ¶But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,
