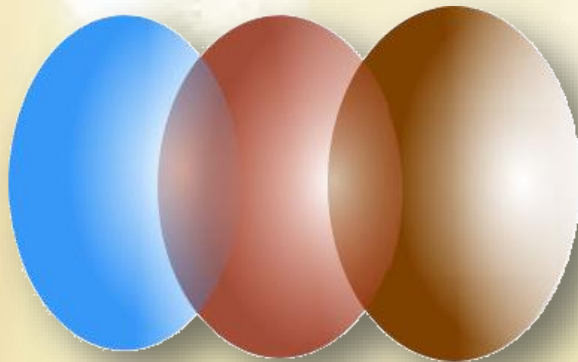
*Inward to outward transformation*

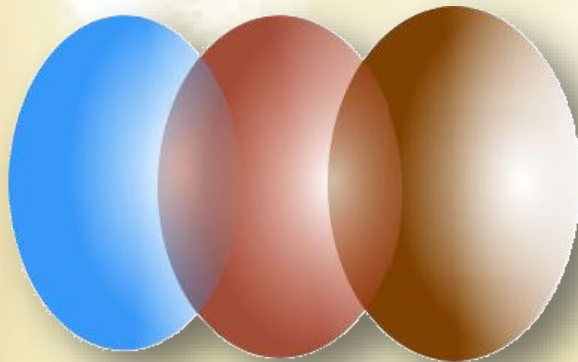

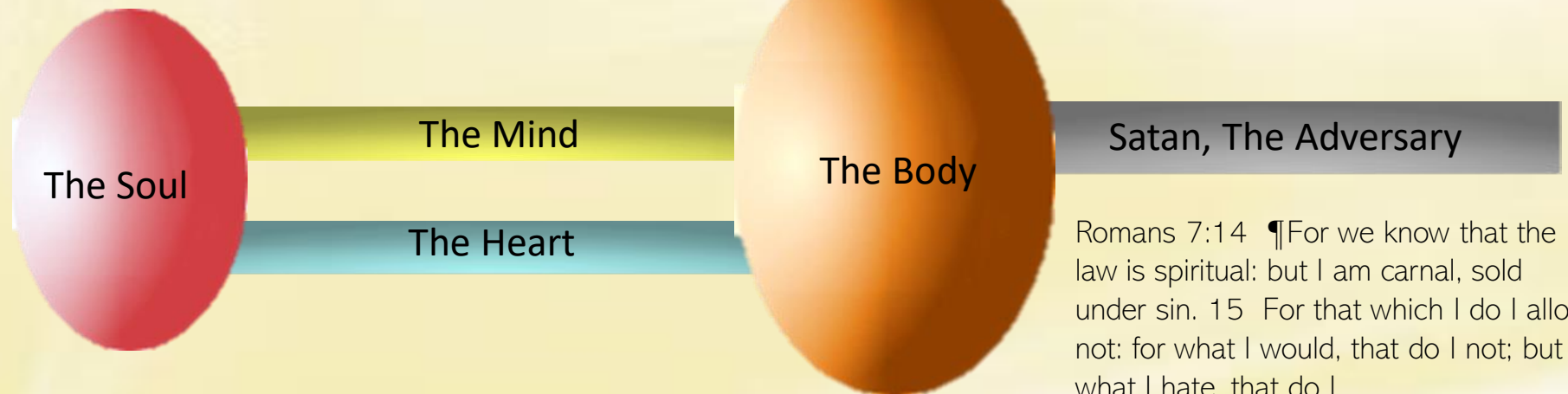
# *Body and Soul*

## **THE BODY**

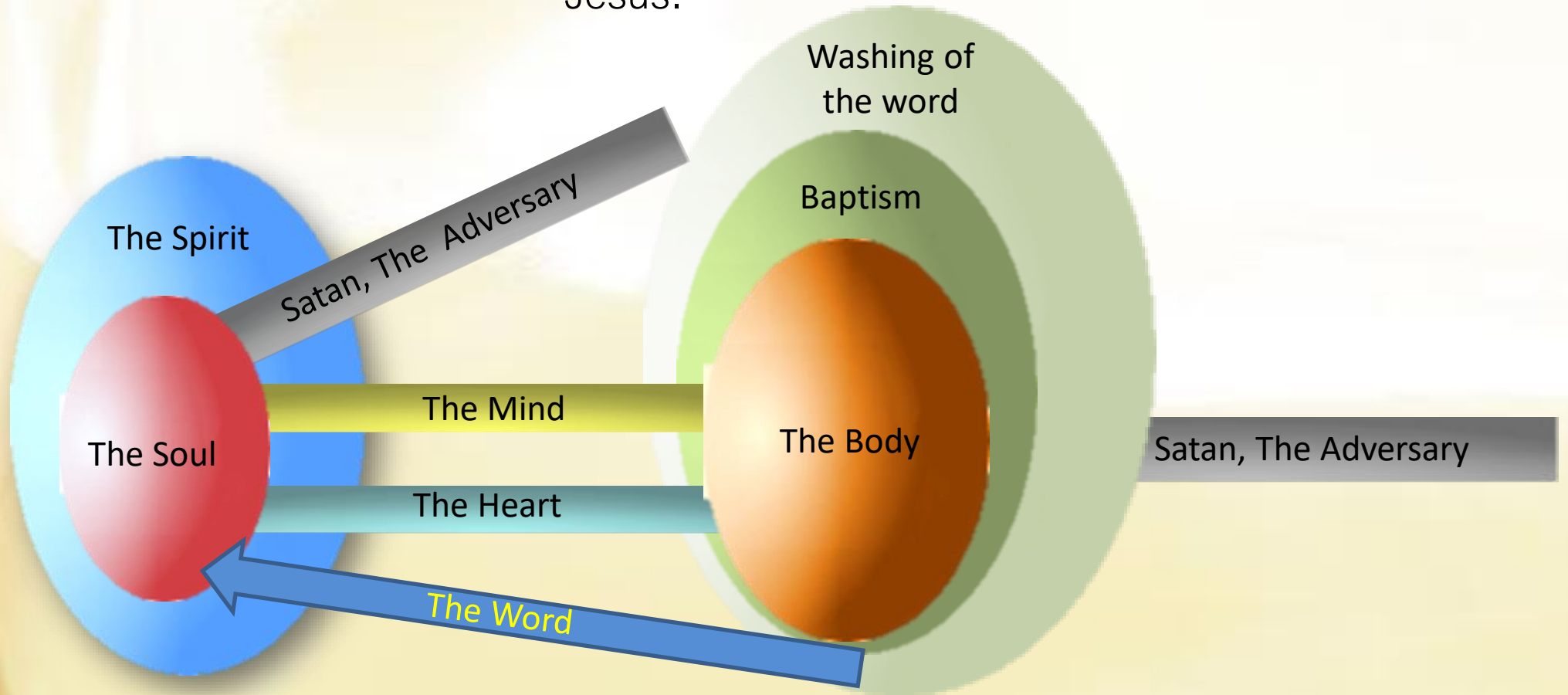
- The Physical Vessel that is our Temple, Container for our Souls

## *A covenant of love and Obedience*



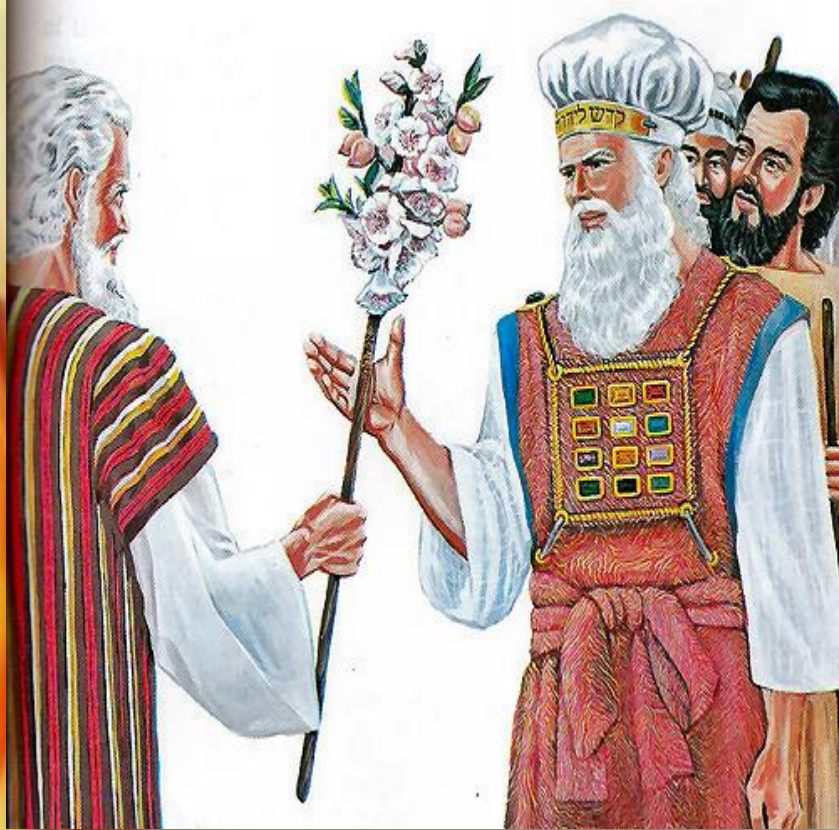
The Tablets: Symbols of  
Covenant Obedience

John 14:15 If ye  
love me, keep my  
commandments.

- Hebrews 10:16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, *I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds* will I write them.
- John 13:34 A new commandment I give unto you, *That ye love one another; as I have loved you*, that ye also love one another.

## *Sanctification 2: For the Heart*

### *A Covenant of Love and Obedience*



Numbers 17:8 ¶And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness; and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds.

1 Peter 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:



## *Sanctification 3: For the Heart & Mind*

### *A Covenant of Love and Obedience*



- Deuteronomy 8:3 *And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna*, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

Matthew 6:25 ¶Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?



# *Sanctification of the Mind:*

## *Block the Channel*



- Proverbs 23:7
- For as he thinks within himself, so he is.  
He says to you, "Eat and drink!" But his heart is not with you.
- Psalms 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

## How to block the channel



- Isaiah 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.
- Genesis 24:63 And Isaac went **out to meditate in the field at the eventide**: and he lifted up his eyes, and saw, and, behold, the camels were coming.

Gen 25:11 ¶And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac; and Isaac dwelt by the well Lahairoi.  
(The Well of Living Water)



## *Staying in the land of famine?*



- Genesis 26:1 ¶ **And there was a famine in the land**, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.
- 3 **Sojourn in this land**, and I will be with thee, and will bless thee; for unto thee, and unto thy seed, I will give all these countries, and I will perform the oath which I swear unto Abraham thy father;
- **6 And Isaac dwelt in Gerar:**



## *Sanctification: The Word hidden in the heart..*



- Gerar from Garar = To chew the cud. ...  
Symbolically to eat and chew Gods word ...To meditate!
- 12 ¶Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received **in the same year an hundredfold**: and the LORD blessed him.
- 22 And he removed from thence, and digged another well; and for that they strove not: **and he called the name of it Rehoboth**; and he said, For now the LORD hath made room for us, and we shall be fruitful in the land.

## *What does our way of living say about us?*



Leviticus 20:26 And ye shall be holy unto me: for I the LORD am holy, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be mine.

- 1 Peter 1:15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy **in all manner of conversation;**


## *Our Conversation: When our Lifestyle speaks*



- Relationship to God
  - 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
- A Witness to men.
  - Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.



## *How the lifestyle speaks*



LUKE 9:23 AND HE SAID TO THEM ALL, IF ANY MAN WILL COME AFTER ME, LET HIM **DENY HIMSELF**, AND TAKE UP HIS CROSS DAILY, AND FOLLOW ME.

- Love (What we do.. caring).
- Honesty(How we act.. Integrity).
- Language(What we say).
- How we dress (Image we project).
- Matthew 15:10 ¶And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand:
- Matthew 15:11 Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man.

## *What defiles and breaks Sanctification of the Body?*



- 1 Thessalonians 4:3 For **this is the will of God, even your sanctification**, that ye should abstain from fornication:  
4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;
- 1 Peter 2:1 ¶Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,

## *The same....but different*



- John 17:14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- 15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
- 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- 17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.



# *The Word sets us apart! Our Conversation: Lifestyle!*

## *1 Timothy 3 (the Lifestyle Chapter)*

1 Timothy 3:1 ¶ This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work.

2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;

3 Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

4 One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity;

5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil.

7 **Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without;** lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.



## *A Godly lifestyle!*

- 8 In the same way, deacons must be people who are respected and have integrity. They must not be heavy drinkers and must not be greedy for money.
- 9 They must be committed to the revealed truths of the Christian faith and must live with a clear conscience.
- 10 Before they are appointed as deacons, they should be given other responsibilities in the church as a test of their character and ability. If they do well, then they may serve as deacons.
- 11 In the same way, their wives must be respected and must not speak evil of others. They must exercise self-control and be faithful in everything they do.
- 12 A deacon must be faithful to his wife, and he must manage his children and household well.
- 13 Those who do well as deacons will be rewarded with respect from others and will have increased confidence in their faith in Christ Jesus.
