

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Prayer: (Greek) Proseuchomai



• Matthew 14:23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.

Hebrews 9:7 But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people:

Pray: (Greek) Erotao "ask", "desire"



Matthew 3:15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.


- John 16:26 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:

Building a relationship



- Luke 10:39 And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.
- John 11:1 ¶Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.
- 2 (It was that Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.)

Receiving from God

Isaiah 30:21 - And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying,
This [is] the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Jeremiah 33:3 - Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

• John 16:13 - Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, [that] shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

1 Timothy 2:1 ¶I exhort therefore, that, first of all, *supplications*, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by *prayer and supplication* with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

According to the word history of supplication, it refers to a bending down and indicates a bowing or kneeling in submission. 1 Kings 8:34 states, "And it was so, that when Solomon had made an end of praying all this prayer and supplication unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD, from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven

Romans 8:26 ¶Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

1 Corinthians 14:14 For if I pray in an unknown tongue, *my spirit prayeth*, but my understanding is unfruitful.

Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator(Intercessor) between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

True intercessory prayer, is only accomplished when praying in the Spirit. Because it's the Spirit that is the intercessor

Matthew 20:20 ¶Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him.


John 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

James 4:7 *Submit yourselves therefore to God*. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.



Agreement: corporate prayer




Acts 16:25 ¶And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.


26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

20 Blessed be God, which hath not turned away my prayer, nor his mercy from me.




Psalms 66:17 For I cried out to him for help, praising him as I spoke.

20 Praise God, who did not ignore my prayer or withdraw his unfailing love from me.




Asking Amiss

- 3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

Proverbs 21:13 ¶Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard.

Matthew 18:35 So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

8 ¶Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:


Hinderances that others cause

Hinderances directly by Satan


