- 5 **And God called** the light Day, and the darkness **he called** Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

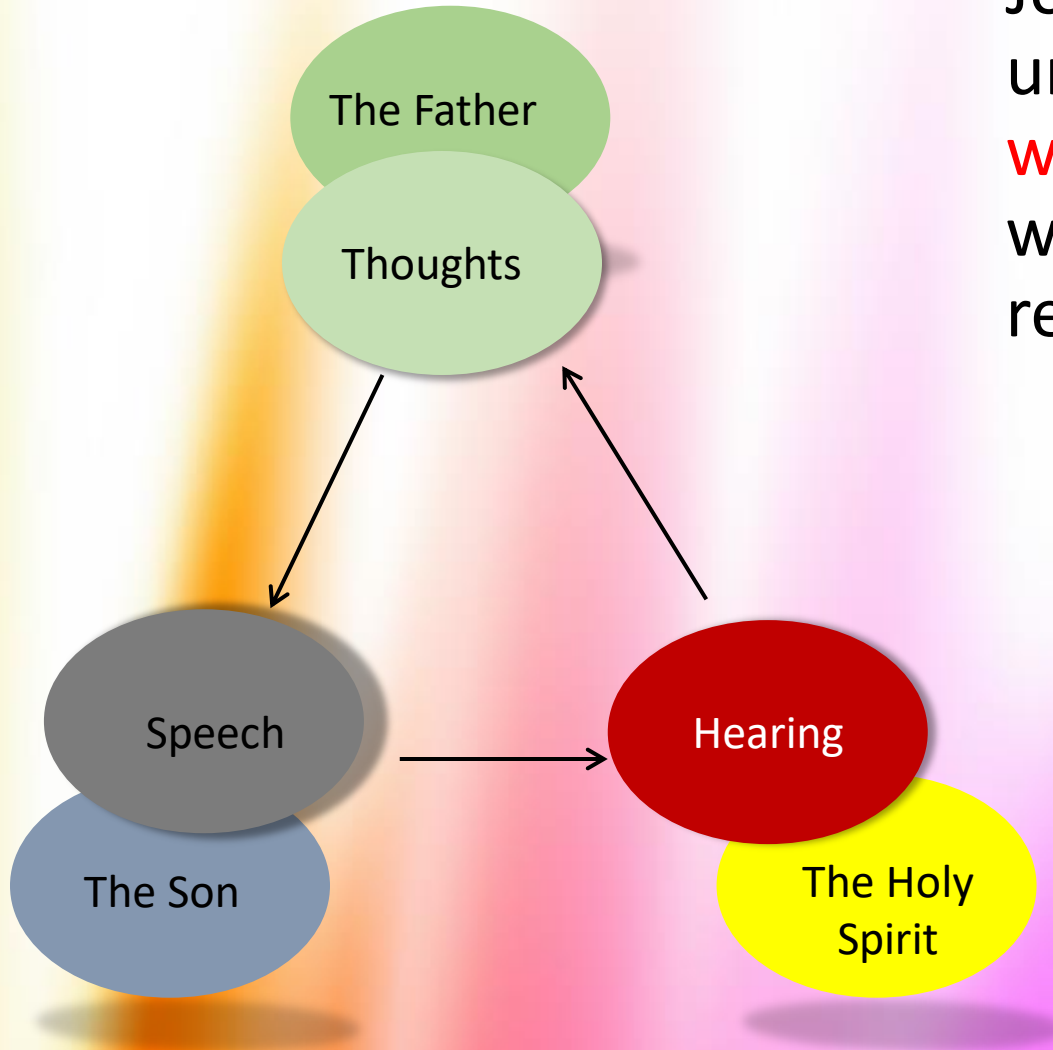
The Eternal things: His Word

- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, **but my words shall not pass away.**

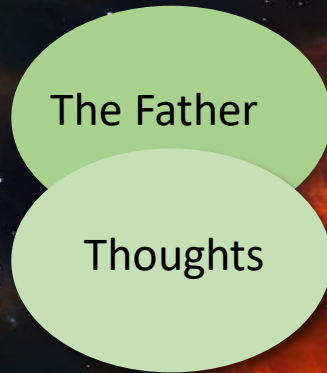

- John 3:11 Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **We speak that we do know**, and testify that we have seen; and ye receive not our witness.



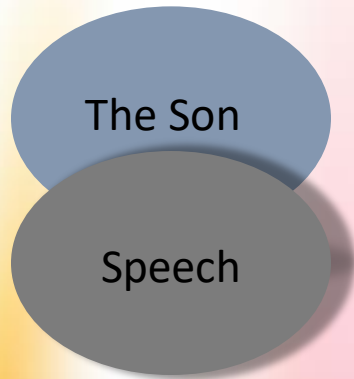
Thought(Logos): The Word



- Isaiah 55:8 **For my thoughts are not your thoughts**, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.
- 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

- John 1:1 ¶ In the beginning was the Word(Logos), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- Jeremiah 29:11 **For I know the thoughts that I think toward you**, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.
- 12 Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.

Genesis 15:1 ¶After these things **the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision**, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

Genesis 15:4 And, **behold, the word of the LORD came** unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.

5 **And he brought him forth abroad**, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.

The Word Precious



1 Samuel 3:1 ¶And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. **And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; there was no open vision.**

2 And it came to pass at that time, when Eli was laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, that he could not see;

3 And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep;

4 That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I.

5 And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down.

6 And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

7 **Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.**

Philippians 3:10 **That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection**, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

11 If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

Daniel 11:32 And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.



Before Christ: Word Came

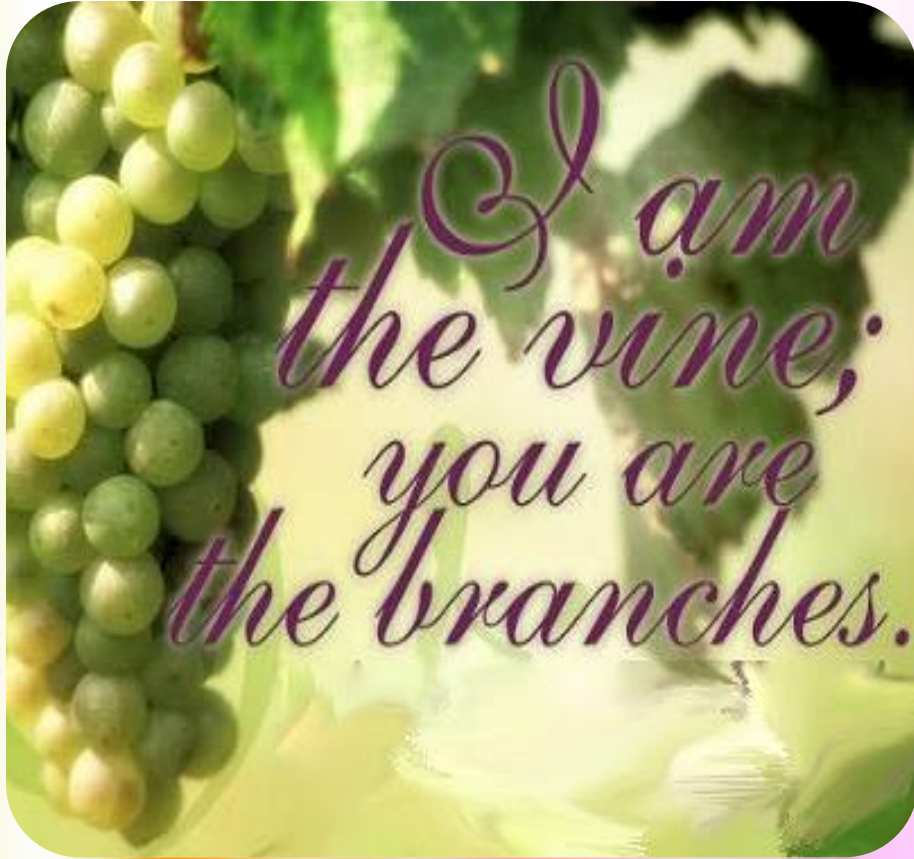
After Christ: Word Dwelt



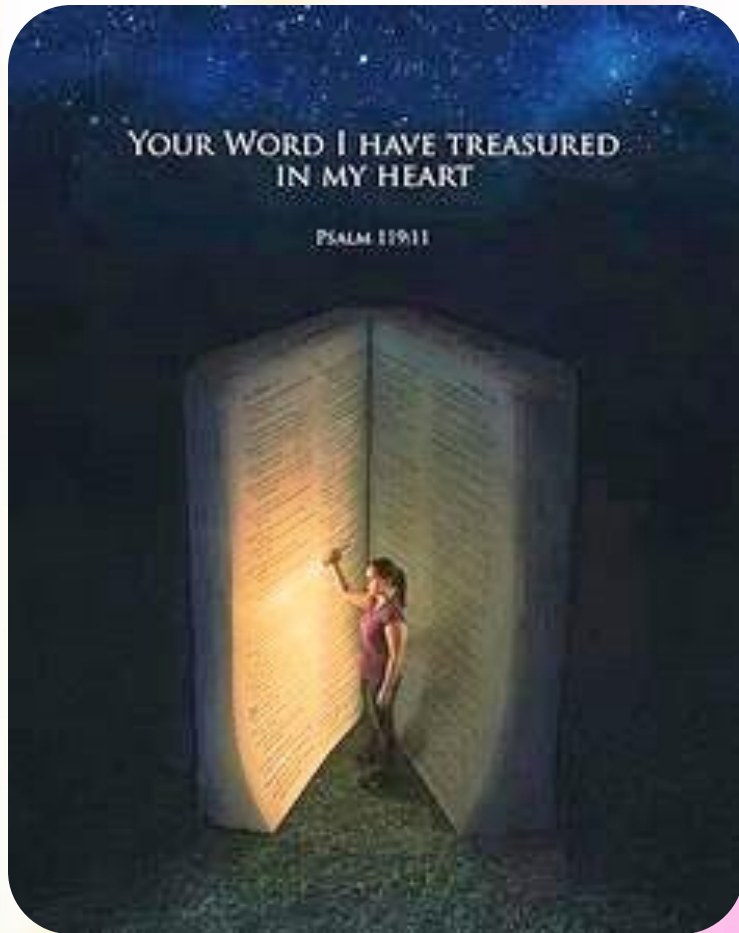
- John 17:17 ¶ Sanctify them through thy truth: **thy word is truth.**

- John 15:7 If ye abide in me, and **words abide in you**, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.




The word in the heart

Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.

The Weapon of Victory ?



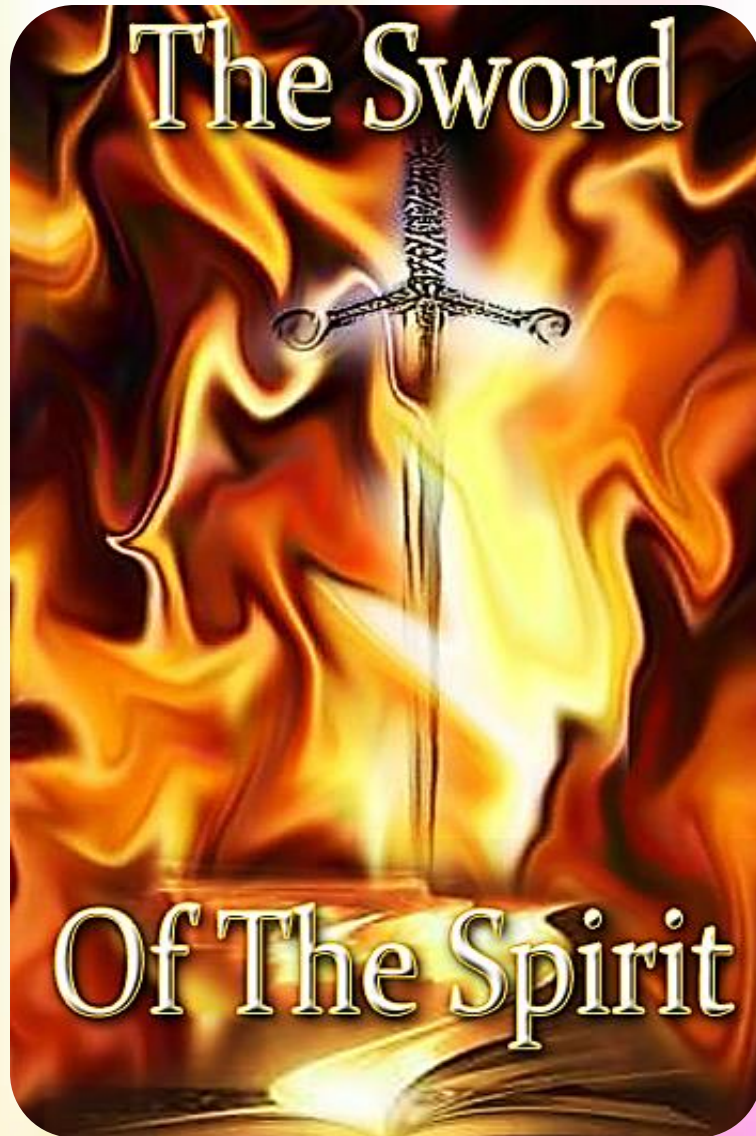

2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

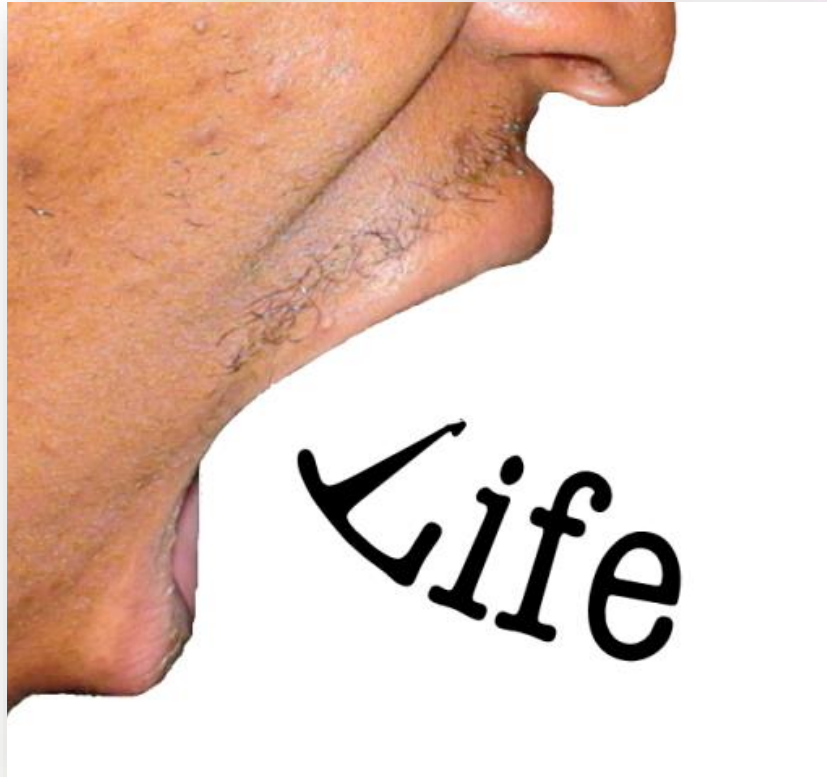
5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

The Spirit of Truth: The word of God



- Hebrews 4:12 **For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword**, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- 13 Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.

- Romans 10:8 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: **that is, the word of faith, which we preach;**
