




Citizenship is in heaven


We do not get entangled

What Happens When A Believer Dies





On the Journey, You Need A Tent!




- 2 Corinthians 4:7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.
- 4 For while we are in this tent, we groan, being burdened [often weighed down, oppressed], not that we want to be unclothed [separated by death from the body], but to be clothed, so that what is mortal [the body] will be swallowed up by life [after the resurrection]. 5 Now He who has made us and prepared us for this very purpose is God, who gave us the [Holy] Spirit as a pledge [a guarantee, a down payment on the fulfillment of His promise]. 
The Body Sleeps, But The Soul Goes To God


- 1 Corinthians 15:16 For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised:

Escorted By Angels







You Are Present with God




- 1 Corinthians 5:3 For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed,
- 2 Corinthians 5:6 Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

- Revelation 10:5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,
